<u>Ukraine 5th Column Shoots, Burns & Poisons Deep Inside Russia</u>/By James Brooke – New York Sun

Partisan attacks inside Russia have been a long-time subject of these emails. This article takes a more detailed approach. As we have stated in earlier emails, Ukrainian 5th Columnists have been active in the Russian Federation since the end of the Revolution of Dignity in 2014, primarily in sowing unrest in the non-Russian regions like Karelia along the border with Finland, in the southern Caucuses, and in the Russian Far East like Buryatia. Most of their work has been non-violent, such as helping minorities evede the Russian draft, or helping them retain their native languages that have been suppressed by the Russian government. Since the start of the war, these groups individuals have been augmented by groups such as Rospartizan, described below, whose objective is sabotage and assassinations.

Some excerpts:

"Fallen out of fashion among English-speakers, the phrase "fifth column" dates back to 1936, when Spain's Francisco Franco said four of his rebel columns were approaching Madrid — and a fifth column would attack the capital from inside. Mr. Putin adapts the phrase to his own family history. In 1944, the future president's father, also Vladimir, was parachuted into Nazi-occupied Germany with a 28-member NKVD unit. Estonian farmers "betrayed" the Soviets. Mr. Putin's father was one of only four survivors. Now, after almost two

years of war, Mr. Putin's prediction about "fifth columnists" is coming true."

- "Today, there are two "fifth column" groups operating in Russia and in Russia-occupied Ukraine. Rospartizan is an anti-Putin Russian group that conducts and reports on bombings, arson attacks, poisonings and train derailments across Russia. The Rospartizan Telegram channel <u>features</u> these attacks from the last week alone: destruction by arson of the headquarters building in Chechnya of the 70th Guards Motorized Rifle Regiment, the largest Chechen unit fighting in Ukraine; an arson attack on the St. Petersburg apartment of Trofim Tatarenkov, a pro-war propagandist on Sputnik radio; and two attacks on militarily strategic rail lines."
- "Inside Russia, many attacks are carried out by disgruntled "lone wolves" with no formal connection to a resistance organization. Last Sunday, a 16-year-old boy was detained on suspicion of breaking into an airfield in Chelyabinsk and setting fire to a Su-34 fighter bomber. Russia's most modern war jet, the Su-34 has a NATO reporting name of 'Fullback' and a price tag of \$50 million. Video clips posted online appear to show the cockpit in flames. Although the unnamed suspect has no criminal record, he is believed to have set fire to two railroad facilities in his native Dagestan, reports Chelyabinsk news site 74.ru."
- "The other main "fifth columnist" group, Atesh, was set up in 2022 by a new Ukrainian military unit, the <u>National Resistance Center</u>. Meaning "fire" in Crimean Tatar, Atesh was originally centered in Crimea. In recent months, it has aggressively expanded across Russia and now claims it has over 1,000 collaborators. Imagine France's World War II resistance movement with a national Telegram <u>channel</u>, eight regional Telegram channels, and three sign up email addresses."
- "Poisoning is a favorite tactic used by pro-Ukraine resisters. A group called "Crimea Combat Seagulls" claimed in a Telegram post last month to have poisoned and killed 46 Russian soldiers in Crimea. Two young women allegedly delivered to a Russian base food and drink adulterated with arsenic and rat poison. "Two cute girls came to the checkpoint of the military unit and introduced themselves as local residents," the post states. "They brought seven bottles of vodka and

some snacks — fish, sausage, bread, cheese. They told the guards that they wanted to thank our boys for everything, for protecting them." "

"State media propagandists are also targets for poisoning. Last weekend state television director Zoya Konovalova was found poisoned to death in her home. Ms. Konovalova, aged 48, was editor-in-chief of Russian state TV in Kuban, a region neighboring Ukraine. Last month, Anna Tsareva, deputy editor-in-chief of Komsomolskaya Pravda news site, was found dead in her Moscow apartment at age 35." (NOTE: My fondest hope is that Margarita Simonyan, Head of "Russia Today," is found dead, poisoned by adulterated New Hampshire maple syrup, from the State where she spent a year as an exchange student)

Ukraine Should Thank North Korea

For its deliveries of defective artillery ammunition to the Russian Federation.

In yesterday's "Latest Denys," at 11:30 into the video, Denys discusses the reliability, or lack thereof, of the artillery shells being supplied to the Russian Federation by North Korea, for use in Ukraine. At great fanfare, North Korea shipped approximately 1 million artillery shells to Russia. According to Russian sources, the North Korean shells are defective, and Russia now uses them only sparingly.

There are two potential problems when firing projectiles. The first is called a "hot gun," where the shell casing expands due to the heat inside the gun barrel, with the result being that the gun jams. In the Navy, with unlimited supply of seawater, the problem is usually resolved by sticking a fire hose into the barrel, thus cooling the barrel. The projectile is then ejected using compressed air. This becomes more difficult, without a significant supply of water, an available firehose, and the use of older Soviet-era artillery.

The second problem, that is likely the case with the North Korean ammunition, is that there is a problem with the propellant, resulting in the projectile "hanging" inside the barrel. Often, the result is that the projectile explodes prematurely, destroying the gun and ruining the entire day of the crew. In the same video, at 10:40, there is evidently renewed discussion about the U.S. providing the A-10 "Warthog," with its gatling gun and depleted uranium bullets, to Ukraine. As Denys stated, this is likely dependent on Ukraine's ability to provide adequate air cover, as is recently the case in Kherson Oblast when Ukraine moved a Patriot Missile battery there, and Ukraine proceeded to shoot down 3 Russian Su-34 bombers in 1 day.

Bradleys Rule

In the most recent "<u>Latest Denys</u>," he covers recent encounters near Avdiivka, between a Bradley Fighting vehicle and a Russian T-90 tank. Denys stated that the Bradley took out the T-90 with a "lucky shot" from its 25mm gun.

It was likely no "lucky shot." It is likely that the Bradley took out the T-90 with a TOW wire guided missile, instead of its 25mm gun. In Operation Desert Storm, Bradleys took out more Iraqui T-72 tanks than did the Abrams tanks.

SITUATION UPDATE OF THE GENERAL STAFF OF UKRAINIAN ARMED FORCES JANUARY 12, 2024

During the day of January 12, there were 68 combat engagements. The enemy launched a total of 2 missile and 43 air strikes, carried out 25 MLRS attacks at the positions of Ukrainian troops and various settlements.

Sivershchyna and Slobozhanshchyna axes: the adversary maintains its military presence in the areas of Russia bordering Ukraine. The enemy launched an air strike near Vovchansk (Kharkiv oblast). More than 30 settlements came under enemy artillery and mortar fire, including Sosnivka, Karpovychi, Semenivka, Hremyach (Chernihiv oblast), Marchykhyna Buda, Iskryskivshchyna, Basivka, Pokrovka, Ryasne, Velyka Pysarivka (Sumy oblast), Huriv Kozachok, Udy, Zybyne, Budarky, Dvorichanske (Kharkiv oblast).

Kupyansk axis: the Ukrainian defenders repelled 6 attacks in the vicinity of Synkivka (Kharkiv oblast), where the occupiers made attempts to breach Ukrainian defense. The invaders launched air strikes in the vicinities of Synkivka and Ivanivka (Kharkiv oblast). The invaders fired artillery and mortars at around 10 settlements, including Dvorichna, Synkivka, Petropavlivka, Ivanivka, Berestove (Kharkiv oblast).

Lyman axis: the Ukrainian defenders repelled 4 assaults near Makiyivka (Luhansk oblast), Hryhorivka, Vesele (Donetsk oblast), where the occupiers made attempts to improve their tactical situation. The vicinities of settlements of Novojehorivka (Luhansk oblast), Zelena Dolyna, Kolodyazi (Donetsk oblast) were under air strikes. The enemy fired artillery and mortars at more than 15 settlements, including Nevske, Bilohorivka (Luhansk oblast), Tors'ke, Serebryanka, Verkhniokamyanske, Spirne, Rozdolivka (Donetsk oblast).

Bakhmut axis: the Ukrainian Defense Forces repelled 4 attacks in the vicinities of Andriyivka and Klishchiyivka (Donetsk oblast). The invaders launched an air strike near Bohdanivka (Donetsk oblast). More than 10 settlements came under artillery and mortar fire, including Vasyukivka, Bohdanivka, Ivanivske, Klishchiyivka, Andriyivka, New York (Donetsk oblast).

Avdiyivka axis: the Ukrainian defenders repelled 4 enemy attacks near Avdiyivka, and 16 more attacks in the vicinities of Pervomaiske and Nevelske (Donetsk oblast). The occupiers launched air strikes in the vicinities of the settlements of Oleksandropil, Novobakhmutivka and Avdiyivka (Donetsk oblast). The invaders fired artillery and mortars at around 15 settlements, including Novobakhmutivka, Berdychi, Stepove, Avdiyivka, Pervomaiske (Donetsk oblast).

Maryinka axis: the Ukrainian Defense Forces continue to hold back the invaders in the vicinities of Krasnohorivka, Heorhiyivka, Marinka and Novomykhailivka (Donetsk oblast). In that area, the adversary, with air

support, made 15 attempts to breach Ukrainian defense. The settlements of Krasnohorivka, Kurakhove, Heorhiyivka, Pobjeda, Novomykhailivka, Katerynivka were under artillery and mortar fire of the occupiers.

Shakhtarske axis: the Ukrainian defenders repelled 3 assaults south of Zolota Nyva and west of Staromaiorske (Donetsk oblast). The adversary fired artillery and mortars at more than 10 settlements, including Vuhledar, Staromaiorske, Rivnopil (Donetsk oblast).

Zaporizhzhia axis: the Ukrainian defenders repelled 5 assaults near Robotyne (Zaporizhzhia oblast). In that area, the enemy made unsuccessful attempts to regain lost ground. Around 20 settlements, including Zaliznychne, Charivne, Mala Tokmachka, Robotyne, Novoandriyivka (Zaporizhzhia oblast), came under enemy artillery and mortar fire.

Odesa operational-strategic group, Kherson axis: the adversary fired artillery at the city of Kherson, the settlements of Zolota Balka, Tyahynka, Ivanivka (Kherson oblast), as well as Dmytrivka, Ivanivka, Yaselka (Mykolaiv oblast).

The occupiers do not abandon their intention to drive Ukrainian units out of their footholds on the left bank of the Dnipro. Thus, during the day, the enemy made 8 unsuccessful assaults.

During the day of January 12, the Ukrainian Air Force launched air strikes on 21 concentrations of troops, weapons and military equipment, 4 air defense systems of the occupiers.

The Ukrainian missile troops hit 6 concentrations of troops, weapons and military equipment, 1 command post, 1 artillery system, 2 air defense systems, 1 ammunition depot, 1 radar station of the russian invaders.

• Sunak allegedly informed his cabinet about the inevitability of a military strike against the Houthis, and Biden will soon make a speech on the topic of the Houthis.

1:03 AM: Yemeni airspace has been emptied amid reports of strikes being prepared on Houthi targets in the country.

• At the same time, intensive flights of British-American fighter jets are observed near the airspace of Yemen, reports the Saudi Al Arabiya.

1:40 AM: An attack was launched from British Navy ships and USAF aircraft.

• Numerous explosions are heard in the cities of Hodeidah and Sanaa, local media reported.

1:45 AM: The US attacked more than 10 facilities in Yemen used to store weapons and train the Houthis - Al Arabia.

2:20 AM USA and a big Britain for support Australia, of the Netherlands, Bahrain and of Canada today at night inflicted common blows by about'projects the Houthis V Yemen, — official representative Pentagon.

2:25 AM: Embassy USA V Iraq suffered bombing, — The Jerusalem Post.

2:51 AM: President USA Joe Biden confirmed attack United of the states and Great Britain on Yemen for support Australia, of Canada, of the Netherlands and Bahrain.

• __"Today, at my direction, US military forces — together with the United Kingdom and with the support of Australia, Bahrain, Canada and the Netherlands — successfully struck a number of targets in Yemen that were being used by the Houthi rebels to threaten freedom of navigation in one of the world's most important waterways," says the message.

3:29 AM: a big Britain inflicted blows by Yemen V of order self-defense, — Prime Minister Great Britain Rishi Sunak.

• "We have taken limited, necessary and proportionate self-defense actions with the United States, supported by the Netherlands, Canada,

and Bahrain, against targets associated with ship attacks to weaken the Houthis' military capabilities and protect global shipping," he said. Sunak

8:02 AM: U sunday, 14 January, in Swiss Davos will take place the fourth meeting advisors chapters of states for discussion Ukrainian Formulas to the world.

8:02 AM: US Defense Secretary Lloyd Austin ordered and supervised strikes on Houthi targets in Yemen from a hospital "using a full suite of secure communications," CNN.

8:02 AM: Ukraine provided unprecedented access to information about weapons received, Pentagon.

9:10 AM: US aid to Ukraine is on hold until Congress approves new funding, US National Security Council coordinator John Kirby said.

- Russian Ashuluk missile range.

4:40 PM: Four Ukrainian sailors are captured by the Houthis, — Volodymyr Zelenskyi.

- The president also commented on the draft law on mobilization:
- "_I know that the military worked with the deputies. I did not see the final version. For me, the most important thing is that this law is fair. When I see all the details, then I will be able to say_".

6:21 PM: Documents on technical, financial and defense cooperation between Ukraine and Latvia were signed in Riga, — Ministry of Strategy and Industry.

- "_Support for the implementation of joint projects in the field of defense technologies (DefenceTech), including projects for the development and production of drones, EW devices, land and sea mine clearance and other defense products is provided for_", the message reads.
- Cooperation will also cover areas of cyber protection, means of communication and integrated solutions.

6:49 PM: New French Foreign Minister Stephane Sejournay is on his way to Kyiv on a working visit, Le Figaro.

• According to the publication, the minister is scheduled to meet with the President of Ukraine, Volodymyr Zelenskyi.

7:12 PM: Japan launches satellite to collect information on North Korea, Associated Press.

7:12 PM: US and UK strikes against Houthi forces in Yemen were defensive, aimed at preserving freedom of navigation on one of the world's most important waterways, Reuters

7:12 PM: Microsoft overtakes Apple as world's most valuable company, Reuters

7:12 PM: China, US set up working group on climate change, — Xinhua.

9:55 PM: The US has already held two rounds of negotiations with Ukraine regarding security commitments, US Ambassador to Ukraine Bridget Brink said.

• _"We have already started bilateral consultations with your government, with the Office of the President, with government agencies, and we are discussing with them what the security commitments from our side might be. Now two rounds have passed and the negotiations will continue, the Biden administration wants this agreements," she said.

10:17 PM: NATO assumed that the war in Ukraine will not end even in 2025.

- The main thing from the speech of NATO Deputy Secretary General Mircea Joane on the Romanian TV channel:
- NATO expects a protracted war with small offensives, counteroffensives, with the conquest and loss of territory.
- Neither side currently has the military capability to win.
- NATO needs Ukraine to survive, the Republic of Moldova to join Europe, and Georgia to join the Euro-Atlantic community.
- With the support of the alliance, the Ukrainians managed to return 50% of the territory originally occupied by the Russians. There is a problem with industrial capacity in Europe, for all 30 years Europeans thought that time would be quiet and peaceful after the end of the Cold War. At that time, the military-industrial complex of Russia "meets today's needs." In addition, the DPRK and Iran send weapons to the Russian Federation.

11:00 PM: Finnish MEP Petri Sarvamaa has collected 120 signatures on a petition to deprive Hungary of its right to vote in the EU Council.

• _"The signatures have been collected! We are one step closer to depriving Orbán of the right to vote,"_ he announced on his X page.

11:15 PM: Yemeni Houthi terrorists accidentally attacked a tanker carrying Russian oil today.

• This was reported by Reuters with reference to the British maritime security firm Ambrey.

11:55 PM: 22-year-old Ukrainian figure skater Ivan Shmuratko performed with a "blood stain" on his shirt in the free program of the 2024 European Championships.

 In his speech, he wanted to show the state between life and death, and the shirt with a red stain symbolized the death of people from missiles.

11:38 AM: Ukraine needs more shells and artillery systems, in particular old, not only new technologies.

• This was stated by the head of the Ministry of Defense of Ukraine, Lieutenant General Kyrylo Budanov, in an interview with Le Monde.

12:38 PM: The northern part of the Black Sea is under the control of Ukraine, the Russian fleet has been pushed to the southeast.

- This was stated by the head of the GUR of the IOU, Kyrylo Budanov, in an interview with Le Monde.
- He added that neither Ukraine nor Russia can conduct an offensive through mining and the active use of UAVs.

12:55 PM: British Prime Minister Rishi Sunak arrived in Kyiv.

• He should announce new military aid to Ukraine.

3:19 PM: The second person involved in the case of tax evasion of UAH 767 million was given a preventive measure in the form of a bail amounting to more than UAH 121 million, — BEB of Ukraine.

- The suspect is the head of one of the companies under the control of a known converter.
- According to preliminary information, the "king of embezzlement" coordinated the criminal activities of enterprises while abroad.

3:47 PM: Volodymyr Zelensky met with Prime Minister of Great Britain Rishi Sunak.

4:02 PM: Volodymyr Zelenskyi and Rishi Sunak signed an agreement on cooperation between the countries in the field of security, — Suspilne.

4:11 PM: Great Britain will provide Ukraine with the largest package of defense aid since the beginning of the war at 2.5 billion pounds.

- This was stated by British Prime Minister Rishi Sunak after the meeting in Kyiv.
- "_This means more security, anti-tank weapons, missiles, hundreds of thousands of new artillery shells, training for thousands of Ukrainian military personnel_," added Sunak.

4:26 PM: The agreement on security cooperation between Ukraine and Britain will be valid until Ukraine joins NATO.

- According to the agreement: London will exchange _intelligence_ with Kyiv, help with _cyber security, military training_ and strengthen _defense-industrial cooperation._
- The agreement became the first in the field of security agreements to implement the agreements agreed upon during the NATO summit in Vilnius between Ukraine, G7 members and other countries.

4:57 PM: The Ministry of Defense of Ukraine is currently conducting an audit of all contracts, including those with companies that may be related to the Hrynkevich family.

- This was announced by the Deputy Minister of Defense of Ukraine Dmytro Klimenkov.
- According to him, the companies disrupted supplies for the Armed Forces under 23 contracts, and preliminary losses amount to more than 1.5 billion hryvnias.

5:40 PM: In the fall of 2023, PepsiCo was looking for a new PR agency in Ukraine, among the conditions being the exclusion of any mention of the war in Ukraine.

- This is reported by the B4Ukraine coalition.
- "_NO: mentions of war, hostilities, aggression of military personnel, the Armed Forces of Ukraine. NO: support of Ukraine and the army. NO: a negative connotation that creates a feeling of "danger"_," the "Pepsi Restrictions" section of the briefing stated.

5:51 PM: US Special Representative for Economic Recovery Penny Pritzker arrived in Kyiv today.

- Prime Minister of Ukraine Denys Shmyhal has already held a meeting with her.
- The key topic is the strengthening of the Ukrainian economy, its shortterm recovery and long-term development.

6:06 PM: British Prime Minister Rishi Sunak spoke at the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine.

7:39 PM: The departure of the Tu-22m3 from Shaykovka (Kaluga region) was recorded — PS ZSU.

7:46 PM: Summary of the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine as of 18:00 on January 12:

- •During the day _68 combat clashes took place._
- Aviation of the Defense Forces struck 21 areas of concentration of personnel, weapons and military equipment, as well as 4 anti-aircraft missile systems of the enemy.
- Units of the missile forces hit 6 areas of concentration of personnel, weapons and military equipment, 1 control post, 1 artillery, _2 anti-aircraft defenses, 1 ammunition depot and 1 radar station_ of the enemy.

8:40 PM: Over the past six months, representatives of the IT Army of Ukraine hacked 200 GB of private data from 3,000 Russian organizations.

• This is reported by the Ministry of Digital Transformation of Ukraine.

8:59 PM: Volodymyr Zelenskyi met with Penny Pritzker, the US special representative for the economic recovery of Ukraine.

• _"Last year was a record-breaking year for the development of Ukrainian-American relations. We are determined to continue to support such dynamics, it significantly helps Ukraine to fight against the aggressor", - noted the President of Ukraine.

9:18 PM: Residents of Prykarpattia are offered work on the construction of fortifications in the Donetsk region as a reprieve from mobilization.

- The salary will be 20 thousand hryvnias, people will be provided with housing and food.
- Those who agree to help with the construction of defense structures will receive a deferment from the draft for the period of construction.

9:24 PM: The Air Force reports the flight of an unmanned aerial vehicle over Sumy Oblast in the direction of Chernihiv Oblast.

• The air alert in the Kharkiv region is related to the activity of enemy tactical aviation.

10:36 PM: A man tried to cross the border across the Dniester River on a rubber boat, — DPSU.

- _"His movement from the Moldovan to the Ukrainian side of the river was recorded by the border guards with the help of a thermal imager. There, a Ukrainian "client" was waiting for the citizen of Moldova," the border service writes.
- Law enforcement officers went to meet the boatman and detained him.

10:37 PM: Kharkiv region - missile danger, - PS ZSU.

• Kyiv region - the threat of attack UAVs.

MORDOR – ruZZia

9:26 AM: The Russian Federation has announced its intention to start serial production of Drel flying bombs.

- It is indicated that the latest "Drel" glide bomb, the creation of which was announced back in 2016, has already passed all the tests specified by the Ministry of Defense.
- According to rosZMI, an aerial bomb can destroy armored vehicles, ground radar stations, power plant control points and anti-aircraft missile systems. It is allegedly almost impossible to recognize on radars.

10:33 AM: Russia condemns the US and UK strikes on Yemen, said the spokeswoman of the Russian Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Maria Sakharova.

• The aggressor country (which, let's recall, has been waging a full-scale war against Ukraine for almost 2 years) calls on the international community to condemn the attack on Yemen and intensify efforts to prevent escalation.

11:55 AM: Fan blackouts begin in Moscow and the region and blackout schedules are introduced, — rosZMI.

• Outages of up to 12 hours a day are possible.

2:39 PM: China's two-way trade with Russia in 2023 reached a record \$240 billion.

- This is evidenced by the data of the General Administration of Customs of the People's Republic of China.
- Chinese exports to the Russian Federation in 2023 reached \$111 billion, jumping by 46.9% compared to the previous year.

5:13 PM: Russia has increased the production of ammunition, but the quality of these shells is getting worse.

• This was stated by the head of the GUR of the Ministry of Defense of Ukraine, Kyrylo Budanov, in an interview with Le Monde.

9:36 PM: Russia prepares to go to court to avoid confiscation of \$300 billion of its central bank's frozen assets, Bloomberg.

- According to the publication's sources, confiscation of Russian frozen reserves is "unlikely" in general.
- But the Central Bank of Russia is negotiating with international law firms to represent its interests in international courts in case of confiscation.

• This was announced by the mayor of Kyiv Vitaliy

Klitschko.

 "_The main advantages of the provided heating pads are self-heating, size 10 by 13 cm (which allows you to place them in shoes, inner pockets) and high heating temperature_," Klitschko writes.

11:21 PM: Air defense forces are operating in the Kyiv region, RMA reported.

11:23 PM: The UAV in the northern part of the Kyiv region changed its course in the direction of Irpin, the Air Force reports.

• An air alert has been announced in Kyiv.

SITUATION UPDATE OF THE GENERAL STAFF OF UKRAINIAN ARMED FORCES JANUARY 13, 2024

During the past 24 hours, 61 combat clashes took place. In total, the enemy launched 32 rocket and 91 air strikes, fired 82 rocket salvo fire systems at the positions of our troops and populated areas.

Airstrikes took place in: Vovchansk, Vesele, Pischane, Ivanivka of the Kharkiv region; Nevske, Bilogorivka, Serebryansk forestry of Luhansk region; Kolodyazi, Terny, Bohdanivka, Hryhorivka, Keramik, Tonenke, Avdiivka, Ocheretine, Novomykhailivka, Vodyane of the Donetsk region; Novoandriyivka, Zaporizhzhia region; Red Lighthouse, Zmiivka, Beryslav, Shlyahove, Kherson region.

More than 120 settlements in the Chernihiv, Sumy, Kharkiv, Luhansk, Donetsk, Zaporizhzhya, Dnipropetrovsk, Kherson, and Mykolaiv regions came under artillery fire.

In the area of responsibility of OSUV**"Khortytsia" in the Kupyansk direction** Ukrainian defenders repelled 4 enemy attacks near Sinkivka, Kharkiv region.

On**Lyman direction** our defenders repelled 4 attacks by occupiers in the districts of Makiivka, Luhansk region, and Terni, Donetsk region.

On **Bakhmut direction** our soldiers repelled 2 enemy attacks near Klishchiivka and Andriivka, Donetsk region.

In the area of responsibility of OSUV**"Tavria"** on**Avdiiv direction** Ukrainian defenders continue to restrain the enemy, who does not stop trying to surround Avdiivka. Our soldiers firmly hold the defense, inflicting significant losses on the invaders. Thus, during the past day, the Defense Forces repelled 5 enemy attacks in the Novobakhmutivka, Avdiivka districts, and another 15 attacks near Severny, Pervomaisky, and Nevelsky, Donetsk region.

On **Marinsky direction** our units continue to deter the enemy near Krasnohorivka and Novomykhailivka, Donetsk region, where 17 attacks were repelled.

On Shakhtarske **direction** the defense forces repelled 4 enemy attacks south of Prechistivka, west of Staromayorsky, and south of Rivnopol, Donetsk region.

On**Zaporozhye direction** Ukrainian defenders repelled 2 attacks by the occupiers in the Robotyn district of the Zaporizhzhia region.

In the area of responsibility of OSUV "Odesa" on **Kherson direction** The Defense Forces will continue measures to expand the bridgehead. Despite significant losses, the enemy does not stop trying to knock our units out of their positions. During the past day, the enemy carried out 5 unsuccessful assaults on the positions of the Ukrainian defenders.

During the past day, the Air Force of the Defense Forces struck 11 areas where the enemy's personnel, weapons and military equipment were concentrated. Also, 7 Kh-101/Kh-555/Kh-55 cruise missiles and one Kh-59 cruise missile were destroyed by air defense forces and means.

Units of the missile forces hit 3 areas of concentration of personnel, weapons and military equipment, 9 artillery means, 4 air defense means, an ammunition depot and an enemy radio-electronic warfare station.

7:55 PM: In Colombia, heavy downpour triggered a landslide in the mountains, killing at least 17 people and injuring 35 others, Daily Mail.

- "_Today we discussed further deliveries of systems and missiles to protect the Ukrainian sky, as well as the delivery of drones to Ukraine_," Kuleba said during a joint statement to the press.
- The ministers coordinated steps on the way to the Washington NATO summit.

7:16 PM: Summary of the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine as of 18:00 on January 13:

1:47 PM: The Russians did not use Kalibr cruise missiles during the morning attack.

• _"The enemy group has practically collapsed, two units are patrolling in the Black Sea, one in the Sea of Azov. Missile carriers continue to be at their base points. StormRMA weather did not allow them to be used during this attack," - said Nataliya Gumenyuk, spokeswoman for OC "South".

3:05 PM: One of the Russian rockets flying towards Ukraine fell in the Krasnodar region — rosZMI.

6:30 PM: Russia has carried out 626 chemical attacks since the start of the full-scale war.

- This is reported by the Armed Forces Support Forces Command.
- "_Most often, the enemy uses grenades, such as K-51, RGR, which are dropped from UAVs. However, homemade explosive devices equipped with irritant substances are also used. Artillery shelling with shells containing chemically dangerous substances is also carried out," the message says.

7:27 PM: Russia plans to build a number of landfills in the temporarily occupied territories of eastern Ukraine, which will serve the Russian Federation - Center of National Resistance.

- The enemy plans to create six such landfills at the TOT of Luhansk region, three more in Donetsk region.
- "_They plan to take garbage there not only from TOT, but from Rostov, Belgorod and Voronezh regions_", writes the Central Committee of the Central Committee of the Russian Federation.

9:36 PM: Power, heat and water have gone out in various areas of the RostRMA, according to local social media.

11:12 PM: In Russian prison colonies, the heating is turned off so that the prisoners are more willing to go to fight.




