<u>Davos Panel on Frozen</u> <u>Russian Central Bank</u> Assets

discussion, held yesterday, lasts approximately 60 minutes.

The panel included Bill Browder and Timothy Ash who, together, are the most vocal proponents of repurposing frozen Central Bank of Russia (CBR) assets to finance both Ukraine reconstruction and weapons purchases. There was also a legal expert and a member of Ukraine's presidential administration. As the moderator said at the beginning, there is a bias on the panel toward repurposing CBR assets, not to mention in the audience. She said that the audience was standing room only, with people spilling out into the hallway.

Some takeways from remarks by the panel members:

- The total principal balance of the frozen CBR assets is approximately \$350 billion.
- Earned interest is between \$3 billion and \$5 billion per year.
- Most of the principal resides in Belgium, with significant amounts in the U.K., the U.S. and France, and let's not forget the Isle of Jersey where, according to the panel, there is approximately \$7 billion of frozen CBR assets.
- Interest income generated by the frozen CBR assets is held by Euroclear (<a href="https://www.euroclear.com/about/e">https://www.euroclear.com/about/e</a> n.html), based in Brussels.

- There is now a consensus among key countries that there are sufficient existing legal grounds to repurpose frozen CBR assets for Ukraine reconstruction and weapons purchases.
- The existing legal grounds allow for the use of frozen CBR assets for both Ukraine reconstruction and weapons procurement.
- The final decision must be a political decision made by Western governments, and not an administrative decision to be made by the IMF and other international bodies.

- The political decision will have to be collective.
   Belgium, where most of the CBR assets reside, will not make the decision to repurpose CBR assets on its own.
- It is costing
   Western
   supporters
   approximately \$5
   billion/month to
   support Ukraine,
   exclusive of
   military support.
- There is no way that Western taxpayers will support continued assistance at that level.
- There needs to be stable source of funding, independent from Western political uncertainties.
- Repurposing
   Russian CBR assets
   can be seen as a

form of insurance, against the election of Donald Trump, and other Western politicians who may be opposed to continued Western support for Ukraine.

The difficulties that the U.S. Congress and the Biden Administration are having, to reach a deal on the border with Mexico and funding for Ukraine, Israel, and Taiwan, should be seen as a warning to Western supporters of Ukraine, that government funding for Ukraine will become increasingly difficult, and therefore an argument in favor of repurposing CBR assets to finance Ukraine reconstruction and future weapons purchases.

"Putin's WarpedWartime Economy, asSeen Through a Cartonof Eggs"/Wall St. Journal

Ben Aris, Editor of BNE Intellinews, has argued that Russia has, essentially, brushed off the effects of Western sanctions. Much of his argument appears to rest on the substantial increase in military spending that is taking place in Russia, and the resulting increase in salaries accruing to Russians working in the defense industries that now make up an increasing share of Russia's GDP, combined with continued revenues, primarily from the sale of oil. To me, and I admit that I know far less about Russia's economy than Aris does, in by opinion there are three things wrong about Aris' conclusion:

1. In and of itself and unlike cars and

machinery, to take 2 examples, military production doesn't produce any value in the economy.

- 2. Will all the money being spent on the military be stolen, as was the case with the money that was supposedly spent on military modernization after the 2008 Russian invasion of Georgia? The Russian Army that crossed the border of Ukraine on Feb. 24, 2022, was not the modern juggernaut touted by most of the pundits.
- 3. How is the additional spending being financed? Judging from the increase in the price of eggs, it is being

financed by printing Rubles and continued revenues from oil sales.

Some takeaways from the article:

• "Last month, a poultry-farm boss known as "the Egg King" survived an assassination attempt shortly after authorities started investigating his farm due to high prices." This is somewhat similar to what happens in the U.S. during periods of inflation, but without the assassination attempt. A U.S. president blames the gas stations and the rapacious oil companies. Putin, to his credit, blames the

## Russian Government.

- Egg prices were up 60% in December, compared to a year earlier.
- "Annual inflation ended up 7.4% last year, nearly double the central bank's goal, and the government's mortgage programs have produced a housing bubble."
- "The government looks like a bunch of firefighters who run from one small fire to another with a bucket because they cannot eliminate the underlying inflation problem," said Alexandra Prokopenko, a former Russian central bank official who is now a nonresident scholar at the

Berlin-based Carnegie Russia Eurasia Center."

- "Russian voters were reminded of Soviet-era food shortages as long lines of customers waiting to buy eggs began forming ahead of the New Year's holidays. Some supermarkets in Siberia and occupied Crimea sold eggs individually, for about 12 rubles, or 13 cents, each. One local deputy gifted cartons of eggs to his employees for the holidays."
- "Authorities also launched antitrust investigations into egg and chicken producers, including the Tretyakovskaya poultry farm in the

Voronezh region, owned by Gennady Shiryaev, the Egg King." Similar to what often happens in the U.S.

- "One factor that could prove difficult to correct is a shortage of vaccines after Western sanctions complicated their import. "There is nothing to vaccinate with, so birds get sick," said a St. Petersburgbased veterinarian. "These are quite fragile agricultural animals, and because they are kept in heaps, when one bird gets sick, almost all of them get sick." "
- Russia's central bank last month raised its key interest rate to 16%, more than

double where it stood in June, to curb rising consumer prices.

Putin and Pres. Biden now have something to commiserate about, the effect of inflation on their popularity but, at least in Putin's case, he doesn't have to worry about the effect of inflation on his chances of re-election.

# News From the Battlefield

Bashkorostan – Not exactly the battlefield, but it's a Russian oblast located north of Kazakhstan. The capital of Bashkorostan is Ufa. Bashkorostan is the site of the protests. The protests are covered in the first part of the "Latest Denys."

According to Denys, the protests weren't about lack of heat, which is the case of the protests around Moscow, but

because a local environmental activist was jailed. The protests are located in Baymak, south of Ufa near the border with Kazakhstan.

Bashkorostan is likely another one of those oblasts, primarily in Siberia, made up of ethnic minorites who are bearing a disproportionate number of casualties from the War in Ukraine.

More From Denys – Continued destruction of T-90 tanks by Bradleys. This is likely the result of the use of the TOW wire-guided missiles, that are part of the Bradleys' armament, and not their relatively small-sized main gun. At 8:45 into the video Denys speaks about increased military support from France and Germany. At 11:05 into the video he

reports that Ukraine is testing jet powered drones (Iran is also doing the same), and at 11:15 into the video, a note from a Russian soldier fighting near Krynky, on the Dnipro crossings. He doesn't appear to be happy with the tactics employed by his superiors.

## SITUATION UPDATE OF THE GENERAL STAFF OF UKRAINIAN ARMED FORCES JANUARY 17, 2024

During the day of January 17, there were 78x combat engagements. The enemy launched a total of 9x missile and 128x air strikes, 77x MLRS attacks at the positions of Ukrainian troops and various settlements.

At night, the russian occupiers launched yet another air strike using 33x Shahed-136/131 attack UAVs. The Ukrainian Air Defense forces and means destroyed 22x enemy UAVs.

Air strikes hit Fedorivka, Vovchansk, Tabaivka, Pishchane (Kharkiv oblast), Serebryanske forestry, Bilohorivka (Luhansk oblast), Terny, Holubivka, Serebryanka, Avdiivka, Kostyantynivka, Novomykhailivka, Vodyane, Zelene Pole (Donetsk oblast), Novodarivka, Robotyne (Zaporizhzhia oblast), Chervonyi Mayak, Zmiivka, and Tyahynka (Kherson oblast).

More than 130x settlements in Chernihiv, Sumy, Kharkiv, Luhansk, Donetsk, Zaporizhzhia, Dnipropetrovsk, Kherson, and Mykolaiv oblasts came under artillery fire.

Khortytsia operationalstrategic group, Kupyansk axis: Ukrainian defenders repelled 6x enemy attacks near Synkivka

(Kharkiv oblast).

Lyman axis: Ukrainian defenders repelled 13x attacks of the occupiers in the vicinities of Terny, Yampolivka (Donetsk oblast), and 5x more attacks near Makiivka, and Bilohorivka (Luhansk oblast).

Bakhmut axis: the Ukrainian troops repelled 8x attacks of the adversary near Hryhorivka, Ivanivske, Klishchiivka, and Andriivka (Donetsk oblast).

Tavria operationalstrategic group, Avdiivka axis: the

Ukrainian defenders continue to hold back the enemy who keeps trying to encircle Avdiivka. During the day of January 17, the Ukrainian Defense Forces repelled 13x enemy attacks in the vicinities of Novokalynove, Novobakhmutivka, Avdiivka, and 14x more attacks near Sjeverne, Pervomaiske, and Nevelske (Donetsk oblast).

Maryinka axis: the
Ukrainian Defense
Forces continue to hold
back the enemy in the
vicinities of
Krasnohorivka,
Heorhiivka, Maryinka,
and Novomykhailivka
(Donetsk oblast). The
Ukrainian troops
repelled 10x attacks in
that area.

**Shakhtarske axis**: the Ukrainian defenders repelled 1x attack of the

adversary north of Novodonetske (Donetsk oblast).

Odesa operationalstrategic group, Kherson axis: During the day of January 17, the adversary attempted 6x unsuccessful assaults at the positions of the Ukrainian troops.

- "The existence of Ukraine is mortally dangerous for Ukrainians. And I do not mean only the current state, the Bander political regime. I am talking about any, absolutely any Ukraine,"
   Medvedev said.
- "The presence of an independent state on the historical Russian territories will now be a permanent reason for the resumption of military operations."
- According to him, neither Ukraine's possible accession

to NATO nor its accession to the EU will stand in the way of military conflicts.

9:51 PM: In the Black Sea, the Russian naval group was replenished with another surface missile carrier - a small missile ship of the "Buyan-M" project.

> The total salvo of "Calibers" is up to 16 missiles. The level of missile danger is very high. This is reported by the Defense Forces of the South.

- Computed tomography revealed a fragment of considerable size -8×9 mm, which was stuck in the pericardium (outer shell of the heart).

- As a result, two of the prisoners died, four are considered missing, and four more are still in

captivity. Most suffered severe psychological injuries.
