Look Out for Bashkortostan

Bashkortostan is a region of the Russian Federation. It is located in the southern Ural Mountains, just north of the border with Kazakhstan. The capital is the City of Ufa.

Earlier this week a major protest, approximately 10,000 people, erupted in the town of Baymak, not far from the border with Kazakhstan. As reported in Meduza IO, the protest was precipitated by the arrest of Fail Alsynov, a leader of the Bashkir national movement and a local environmental activist. Police from outside of Baymak were brought in, to help quell the protests. Yesterday, Meduza reported that the protest has spread to the Capital of Ufa.

A likely additional reason for the protests is the relatively large number of Bashkirs, a large ethnic minority inside Russia, who have been conscripted into the Russian Army and sent to Ukraine. Russia has been relying heavily on ethnic minorities to do the fighting in Ukraine.

As we have reported several times before, Ukrainian 5th Columnists have been operating inside Russia since 2014, the end of the Revolution of Dignity, mostly in areas populated by ethnic minorities like the Bashkirs. Their focus has been on helping ethnic minorities to protect their local language, resist the draft, and other subversive activities. Once these kinds

of protests start, likely sparked by some local issue such as the opening of a gold mine near the town of Baymak, they have a tendency to spread.

There have also been protests in several towns around Moscow, the Cities of Novosibirsk and Nizhny Novgorod, over the failure of district heating systems that provide hot water and heat to residential buildings in most Russian systems. These have all happened in the middle of winter. This is a particularly sensitive time, during the run-up to the Russian presidential election.

SITUATION UPDATE OF THE GENERAL STAFF OF UKRAINIAN ARMED FORCES JANUARY 18, 2024

During the day of January 18, there were 127 combat engagements. The enemy launched a total of 2 missile and 81 air strikes, 45 MLRS attacks at the positions of Ukrainian troops and various settlements.

Air strikes hit Vovchansk, Mykolaivka, Holubivka, Ivanivka, Kyslivka, Tabaivka (Kharkiv oblast), Serebryanske forestry, Bilohorivka (Luhansk oblast),

Bohdanivka, Avdiyivka, Heorhiivka, Novomykhailivka, Vodyane (Donetsk oblast), Robotyne, and Orikhiv (Zaporizhzhia oblast).

More than 110 settlements in Chernihiv, Sumy, Kharkiv, Luhansk, Donetsk, Zaporizhzhia, Dnipropetrovsk, Kherson, and Mykolaiv oblasts came under artillery fire.

Khortytsia operational-strategic group, Kupyansk axis: Ukrainian defenders repelled 18 enemy attacks near the settlements of Synkivka, Petropavlivka, Tabaivka, and Berestove (Kharkiv oblast).

Lyman axis: the Ukrainian defenders repelled 15 enemy attacks near Terny and Yampolivka (Donetsk oblast), and 8 more attacks in the vicinities of Serebryanske forestry, Bilohorivka (Luhansk oblast).

Bakhmut axis: the Ukrainian defenders repelled 2 attacks of the adversary near Bohdanivka (Donetsk oblast).

Tavria operational-strategic group, Avdiyivka axis: the Ukrainian defenders continue to hold back the enemy who keeps trying to encircle Avdiyivka. The Ukrainian soldiers are standing their ground and inflicting major losses on the occupiers. For instance, the Ukrainian Defense Forces repelled 27 enemy attacks in the vicinities of Novokalynove, Novobakhmutivka, Avdiyivka, and 17 more attacks near Pervomaiske and Nevelske (Donetsk oblast) during the day of January 18.

Maryinka axis: the Ukrainian Defense Forces continue to hold back the enemy near Krasnohorivka, Maryinka, and Novomykhailivka (Donetsk oblast). The Ukrainian troops repelled 15 attacks in that area.

Shakhtarske axis: the Ukrainian defenders repelled 4 attacks of the adversary west of Staromaiorske and south of Urozhaine (Donetsk oblast).

Zaporizhzhia axis: the Ukrainian soldiers repelled 5 enemy attacks west of Verbove and Robotyne (Zaporizhzhia oblast).

Odesa operational-strategic group, Kherson axis: the Ukrainian Defense Forces continue to expand the bridgehead. During the day of January 18, the

adversary attempted 11 unsuccessful assaults at the positions of the Ukrainian troops.

During the day of January 18, the Ukrainian Air Force launched air strikes on 5 concentrations of troops, weapons, and military equipment of the adversary.

The Ukrainian missile troops hit 1 concentration of troops and 2 command posts of the russian invaders.

7:15 AM: Slovakian Parliament authorizes arms exports to Ukraine, - Politico

- It is noted that this marks a complete reversal of the country's authorities from the pre-election promise of Prime Minister Robert Fizo "not to provide a single cartridge" to Kyiv.
- Earlier, the President of Slovakia, Zuzana Čaputova, vetoed the draft law, citing the fact that the country's Ministry of Defense does not have expert resources to assess the negative risks of arms sales for the international reputation and security of Slovakia.

8:01 AM: France for year will produce for of Ukraine close 80 self-propelled howitzers Caesar: six with them already V the road.

8:01 AM: Senate Republican Leader McConnell expects a bipartisan deal on Ukraine funding and US southern border security to come up next week.

8:01 AM: The US has struck Houthi bases in Yemen for the fourth time in a week after militants again attacked a commercial vessel.

8:01 AM: Pakistan responded to Iran's strikes with its own attack, Anadolu Agency.

9:10 AM: Ukrainian breakfast begins in Davos.

- This year, panelists will talk about the protection of life and liberty in Ukraine, the global context, and what is at stake now.
- The Ukrainian breakfast in Davos has been held every year since 2005, its purpose is to promote Ukraine and unite Ukrainian and international leaders.

10:59 AM: NATO unveils its first-ever quantum strategy.

 Quantum technologies have been prioritized by NATO members because of their impact on defense and security. These include artificial intelligence, data and computing, autonomy, biotechnology and human enhancement, hypersonic technologies, energy and motion, new materials, next-generation communication networks, and space.

12:29 PM: The Halmeu-Diacove checkpoint on the Romanian-Ukrainian border is blocked for trucks with the equipment of Romanian farmers, the State Customs Service.

- This is the third blocked checkpoint on the border between Romania and Ukraine.
- The movement of trucks to the exit from Ukraine is temporarily suspended in order to prevent blocking the passage of passenger cars.
 The timing of the blocking is currently unknown.

1:12 PM: France will supply Ukraine with 50 AASM aerial bombs each month, French Defense Minister Sebastien Lecornu said.

- The corresponding aerial bombs will be adapted for Ukrainian Sovietmade fighters.
- He added that from February, France will start providing Ukraine with 3,000 artillery shells per month, instead of 2,000, as it was before.

1:25 PM: Ukraine expects that on February 1 at the summit of the European Council, a positive decision will be made to allocate financial support to Ukraine in the amount of 50 billion euros under the Ukraine Facility program.

- This was announced by Prime Minister Denys Shmyhal.
- According to him, this program involves not only the allocation of funds, but also the systemic transformation of Ukraine on the way to the EU.

2:16 PM: The Netherlands allowed some refugees from Ukraine to stay only until spring: details

- The court overturned the decision of the Minister of Justice Eric van der Burgh on the deprivation of residence rights and benefits for refugees without Ukrainian citizenship, which he issued in September of last year. The government should return to the previous instructions, which gave people who lived in Ukraine with permits the same rights as Ukrainian citizens.
- The decision concerns about 2,900 people who moved to Ukraine to work or study before the full-scale war. The largest group is made up of students from countries such as Nigeria, Morocco, Tanzania and India.

3:07 PM: Volodymyr Zelenskyi had a telephone conversation with French President Emmanuel Macron.

- "_Thank you for launching the "Artillery Coalition" initiative and for the announced commitment of France to manufacture dozens of advanced "Caesar" artillery systems for Ukraine in 2024 and ammunition for them, Zelenskyy wrote.
- The leaders of the countries discussed the situation on the battlefield and Ukraine's defense needs, in particular those prioritized for inclusion in the next military aid package from France.

3:30 PM: US President Biden agrees to tougher immigration policy to deflect criticism and preserve aid to Ukraine.

The Wall Street Journal writes about it.

4:03 PM: Poland has extended temporary protection for Ukrainians until March 4, 2025, the press service of the country's government reports.

• Foreigners who have already received certificates can continue to use them as residence documents confirming their legal status.

6:05 PM: Biden agrees to concessions to Republicans to unblock aid to Ukraine, WSJ.

- US President Joe Biden agreed to make concessions to Republicans on immigration reform.
- For three years, the administration has struggled to curb a surge in migrants at the southern border, and Republicans have seized on the issue to oppose Biden's re-election. The White House is also aware of this political vulnerability. So, a bipartisan deal can neutralize these attacks.

8:00 PM: In Paris, more than 20 countries formed an artillery coalition to help Ukraine.

- The 23-nation US-France-led initiative is part of the efforts of the Defense Contact Group of Ukraine ("Ramstein"), which unites more than 50 allies of Kyiv.
- The French Ministry of Defense said the "artillery coalition" aims to join forces to help Ukraine have an artillery force that meets the needs of its counter-offensive and its army of the future, in the short and long term.

8:15 PM: 'It's not a tragedy': Hungary is unsure if it will reach an agreement with the EU on aid to Ukraine.

- At the same time, the head of the Hungarian Prime Minister's administration, Gergey Guyas, noted that "this is not a tragedy", because a solution can be found by 2026 - that's when the seven-year financial framework, which regulates the EU's annual budget, comes to an end.
- "The possibility of improving relations between Hungary and Ukraine cannot be ruled out, and Hungary should strive for good relations with the neighboring country. We should not lose hope that changes may occur in Hungarian-Ukrainian relations," Guyash said.

11:18 PM: The Netherlands intends to join the EU mission to ensure the safety of shipping in the Red Sea. This was stated by the Minister of Defense of the Netherlands in an interview with BNR.

11:18 PM: The US has imposed new sanctions against companies and vessels that helped Russia sell oil, the US Treasury Department's Office of Foreign Assets Control said.

11:18 PM: Estonia will expel the head of the local Russian Orthodox Church, who blessed the Russian aggression against Ukraine, Postimees reports.

11:18 PM: Iran has enough weapons-grade uranium for several nuclear warheads, Bloomberg quotes IAEA chief Grossi as saying.

10:56 PM: The Romanian government has announced aid to farmers and transporters who went on protests.

- The Prime Minister of the country, Marcel Čolaku, presented some of the first measures, including, in particular, financial assistance and some changes in legislation. He clarified that this includes compensation in the amount of 100 euros per hectare to farmers for the loss due to the war in Ukraine. Compensation in general cannot exceed 280,000 euros.
- Also, the government approved the changes in the rules, which were demanded by the carriers. In particular, regarding the registration and periodic technical inspection of vehicles, as well as the equivalence of some categories of driver's licenses.
- We will remind, on Thursday, January 18, in front of the Halmeu-Diakove international checkpoint on the Romanian-Ukrainian border, farmers blocked the movement of trucks.

5:45 PM: The European Parliament passed a resolution by 345 votes calling on the EU Council to activate Article Seven against Hungary, — Reuters.

• As the article provides, if Hungary systematically violates the fundamental norms of democracy, the European Council can decide to

- suspend some of its rights, for example, the right to vote or the right to representation.
- The resolution itself condemns "_deliberate, continuous and systematic efforts of the Hungarian government aimed at undermining the fundamental values of the EU_".

7:25 PM: Latvia has begun deporting nearly 1,000 Russian citizens, Postimees.

7:25 PM: NATO is going to conduct large-scale exercises in February with the participation of about 90,000 servicemen, the goal of which is to deter aggression from the Russian Federation, Bild.

7:25 PM: Estonian Prime Minister Kaja Kallas may replace Borrell as EU foreign minister, Politico.

7:25 PM: At least seven people have been killed in landslides caused by heavy downpours in the Philippines, Xinhua reported.

NATIONAL

10:14 AM: Currently, 2,331 people are ready to join the personnel reserve for civil service in the liberated territories of Ukraine, of which 2,132 have already been enrolled.

• This was reported by the Ministry of Reintegration of the Temporarily Occupied Territories of Ukraine.

10:29 AM: In "Servant of the People" they propose to tax the purchase of a new iPhone and pay more taxes from the salary of 20,000 UAH.

 "_A new iPhone for 60-70 thousand UAH can be taxed_, said People's Deputy Roksolana Pidlasa, answering the question of where to get money for mobilization. -_If you earn more than 20,000 UAH, then you could pay the military tax instead of 1.5%, and 3%. We need to think about luxury taxes_".

12:51 PM: "Ukrainian team" handed Budanov scouts a batch of kamikaze drones and a thousand warm sets

- The intelligence and sabotage unit "Kraken" was formed in Kharkiv in the first days of the large-scale attack by the Russians. His fighters liberated the Kharkiv region, took part in the battles for Soledar and Bakhmut.
- As the head of the "Ukrainian team" Artur Palatny noted during the aid transfer, drones will help our defenders to inflict even more terror on the enemy, and warm sets will protect against frost.

3:41 PM: NAKC included the Swiss company Barry Callebaut in the list of international sponsors of the war.

- The company maintains 3 factories in Russia and pays taxes to the budget of the aggressor.
- "_In addition, after the start of the full-scale invasion of Russia into Ukraine, the company delivered chocolate to the aggressor under the guise of goods of primary necessity_", - writes NAZK.

4:36 PM: Footage of the Russian Kh-101 missile being defused by police bomb squads.

- A warhead weighing 400 kg was found with the remains of the cruise missile.
- With the help of equipment, the warhead was buried in a pit so that the soil absorbed the force of the explosion and the fragments did not fly far.

5:03 PM: The government of Ukraine has started negotiations with partners on helping refugees return to Ukraine.

- This was stated by the Deputy Minister of Economy Trade Representative of Ukraine Taras Kachka.
- According to him, it will be a matter of competition, since, unlike at the time of Poland's accession, the EU member states today are interested in attracting such a workforce as Ukrainians, who do not create migration problems.

5:17 PM: One of Ukraine's goals for 2024 is to launch five joint ventures in the country with Western arms manufacturers.

- This was announced by the First Deputy Prime Minister the Minister of Economy of Ukraine, Yuliya Svyridenko.
- It is about sharing advanced technologies in partnership with Day & Zimmermann, Northrop Grumman, Lockheed Martin and Raytheon.

6:01 PM: Ukraine tested a new kamikaze drone with a jet engine, the Drone Army.

 Currently, there are no details about the capabilities of the new drone, its characteristics and information about its developers.

6:37 PM: Cyber attack on Ukrainian "Kyivstar" will cost the parent company about \$95 million, — Reuters.

• The publication writes that the corresponding losses were caused by measures taken by the company to compensate customers for the inconvenience caused by disruptions in the "Kyivstar" network.

6:46 PM: The son of a Lviv businessman, suspected of fraud and participation in a criminal organization within the scope of the case concerning the purchase of clothing for the Armed Forces, has not yet been found.

- This was reported by the communications spokeswoman of the DBR Sapyan.
- It is probably about Roman Hrynkevich. He was declared wanted, officially he did not cross the border.

7:05 PM: The Ministry of Defense has connected whistleblowers to the Unified Portal — the department has been added to the list of state bodies on the special portal of the NAKC.

- From now on, anyone who knows about possible facts of corruption offenses in the Ministry of Defense can file a whistleblower report.
- The portal guarantees applicants compliance with conditions of anonymity and confidentiality, reliable protection of personal data.

7:39 PM: Ukraine cannot forcibly return conscripts who are currently abroad.

- This was stated by the Secretary of the National Security and Defense Council of Ukraine Oleksiy Danilov.
- "_We understand that a person who is in the territory of another country is also subject to the laws of that country. We would like them to return, but it will not be possible to do it by force_," Danilov said.

7:50 PM: Summary of the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine as of 18:00 on January 18:

- During the day _114 combat clashes took place._
- Aviation of the defense forces _struck 5 areas_ concentration of personnel, weapons and military equipment of the Russian invaders.
- Units of the missile forces _hit 1 control point_ of the Russian occupiers.

8:01 PM: The Air Force reports that there is a threat of using ballistic weapons in the Kharkiv, Zaporizhzhia, and Dnipropetrovsk regions.

8:09 PM: In his evening address, Volodymyr Zelenskyi reported on dozens of critical components in Russian missiles that were produced abroad.

 _"So to block Russia's ways of circumventing sanctions is literally to block terror. I am grateful to all partners who understand this, and to everyone in the world who helps us in the relevant work," the president said.

9:03 PM: Ukrainian hackers stole technical passports of more than 500 military facilities of the Russian Federation, - mass media.

 Hackers from the Blackjack group, who are believed to be related to the Security Service of Ukraine, hacked the servers of the Russian state-owned enterprise "Glavnoe voonene-stroitelnoe upravlenie po spielik objektam", which builds military facilities throughout the territory of the Russian Federation. Hackers also destroyed seven servers and encrypted more than 150 computers of employees of the institution, due to which most of the Russian special construction companies were left without the entire array of data and backup copies of information.

10:26 PM: The first aerial victories of F-16 fighters in Ukraine are expected already this year.

• This was stated by the Minister of Foreign Affairs of Ukraine, Dmytro Kuleba, on the air of the telethon.

10:46 PM: The court chose a preventive measure for one of Ihor Hrynkevich's accomplices.

- Andrii Kolotylo was sentenced to 60 days in custody with the possibility of bail in the amount of 500 million 528 hryvnias.
- The suspect's lawyer, Serhii Pushkarska, informed that they will prepare an appeal against the court's decision and that the amount of the bail, according to him, is "too large for the status of a participant."

11:30 PM: The Ministry of Justice proposes to allow the mobilization of people with a criminal record

- Currently, the mobilization of people with criminal records is prohibited by law.
- "They live among us, they are just as afraid, they are just as worried and they can be just as useful, but, unfortunately, they are removed from the military register and cannot help the army in any way," said Deputy Minister of Justice Olena Vysotska.
- Therefore, the ministry worked out changes to eliminate such a legislative obstacle, and they have already submitted it to the relevant committee of the Verkhovna Rada. Although Vysotska admits that these changes are "debatable".

1:07 AM: Explosions are heard in the Moscow region, local social networks report.

8:01 AM: Russian hackers attacked Swiss government websites during Zelensky's visit to Davos.

10:40 AM: GUR MOU attacked an oil depot in St. Petersburg with drones, there is a hit.

• This is reported by the mass media with reference to sources in the special services.

11:23 AM: Restrictions on the departure and arrival of aircraft have been introduced at the Russian airport, Russian media reported.

• The airspace is closed, departures and arrivals of planes are stopped.

11:46 AM: Until 2014, some residents of the Kursk region were clearly aware of themselves as ethnic Ukrainians, - polytechnic expert

- When asked whether there is still a Ukrainian population in the Kursk region of the Russian Federation with the memory that they are Ukrainians, not Russians, Kostenko answered: "In fact, a very large number of the population, which before the war, before the full-scale invasion, until 2014, were clearly aware of themselves as ethnic Ukrainians, they lived on the territory of Russia, in fact I can say Ukraine, but the ethnic and national identification was actually Ukrainian."
- According to the head of the Center for Social Research, in a large number of settlements on the border of the Kursk region, the inhabitants did not speak Russian, but a Ukrainian dialect, where there was a wide range of our words.

1:40 PM: Russia's Kh-101 missiles are different from those used in 2022, said Vadim Skibitskyi, a representative of the GUR IOU.

 "This is a missile already with an active electronic warfare system, with active protection, thermal traps, etc.," said the representative of the GUR during the discussion program in Davos.

6:15 PM: Russia is focusing its main efforts on pushing Ukrainian units out of the Kupyan Forest and capturing Synkivka.

- This was announced by the commander of the Ground Forces of the Ukrainian Armed Forces, Colonel-General Oleksandr Syrskyi.
- "_Despite the difficult situation in the Kupyansk direction, we are holding the defense and destroying the enemy ," Sirskyi said.

8:55 PM: The drones used to attack the oil depot in the Leningrad region were Ukrainian-made.

- This was stated by Oleksandr Kamyshin, Minister of Strategic Industries of Ukraine, during the Deciding Your Tomorrow discussion.
- _"It's made in Ukraine. Yes, we hit the target tonight, and this thing flew exactly 1,250 kilometers that night," Kamyshin said.

9:25 PM: Russia used a rare 4-ton P-35 anti-ship missile from the 1960s to strike Ukraine, Defense Express.

- _"In the images, with an additional blurred Defense Express background, you can see the wreckage of the P-35, which differs in significant dimensions," - the publication writes.
- It could be launched either from the shore-based missile complex "Redut" or from the underground "Object-100".

11:55 PM: In the Russian Federation, the slogan "Glory to Ukraine" and the symbols of the OUN and UPA were added to the list of Nazis.

• For "propaganda or public demonstration" of the symbols of these organizations, a fine of up to 2,000 rubles or an administrative arrest of up to 15 days is provided, rosZMI reports.

KYIV



2:48 PM: At today's meeting, the Kyiv City Council plans to allocate 500 million hryvnias for the purchase of drones for the military, the mayor of the capital Vitaliy Klychko said.

 "_I would like to remind you that according to various programs and sources of the capital budget last year, we found almost 7 billion hryvnias to help the security and defense forces. That is, 10 percent of the budget - the largest among all cities of Ukraine. Not 1 percent, as some lie and manipulate [...]," added Klitschko.

9:53 PM: Another 29 streets, squares and boulevards were renamed in Kyiv.

- In particular, streets named after Dmytro "Da Vinci" Kotsyubail, Denys Monastyrskyi, and Hleb Babich appeared in the capital.
- Also, among the new toponyms, you can now find names dedicated to the destroyed plane "Mriya", the composer Mykola Mozgov and the Black Zaporozhians.

9:36 AM: As a result of the Russian missile attack on Chuguiev, the number of victims has increased, the Kharkiv Regional Prosecutor's Office.

• A 45-year-old woman and a 63-year-old man were injured. Another 82-year-old woman experienced an acute stress reaction.

1:31 PM: As a result of the attack on Kharkiv on January 16, 12 victims are in hospitals, some are in serious condition

- It is noted that three people are in serious condition. These are 39- and 43-year-old women who are in the neurosurgery department, as well as a 77-year-old woman who is in the toxicology department after carbon monoxide poisoning.
- Doctors consider the condition of other patients to be average and mild. Among the injuries are craniocerebral, fragmental lesions and fractures.


11:16 AM: This night Kherson was attacked by enemy drones of the "Shahed" type, reported the head of OVA Oleksandr Prokudin.

• There were two "arrivals" in residential quarters in the Dnipro district. The homes of the Kherson people were damaged. Also, last evening, the Russians hit a gas station in Korabelny district.

1:55 PM: The army of the Russian Federation is attacking Kherson from the temporarily occupied left bank, reports the head of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Roman Mrochko.

• Explosions are heard in the central part of the city.
