Ukrainian Woman at the Australian Open

Three Ukrainian women made it to the Round of 16 at the Australian Open Tennis tournament, one of whom, Dayana Yastremska, made it to the Quarterfinals by <u>defeating</u> Viktoria Azarenka of Belarus, a former Australian Open Champion, in straight sets, 7-6 & 6-4. Here is Yastremska's postmatch <u>interview</u>. During the interview, Yastremska mentioned that during recent Russian attack a rocket landed on her Grandmother's house.

The second Ukrainian, Marta Kostyuk, is already in the Quarterfinals. Tonight, U.S. East Coast Time, Kostyuk plays the American, Coco Gauff, for a place in the Semi-finals. I'll be suspending my normal support for American players, for this one match.

Unfortunately Elena Svitolina, Ukraine's most decorated player, had to withdraw during her 4th Round match due to injury.

I take particular pleasure in watching the Ukrainian women defeat their Russian and Belarusian opponents, as Yastremska did against Azarenka, and then refuse to shake their hands at the end of their matches. It has happened often, and it never gets dull. Judging from the number of Ukrainian flags in the stands, there is a great deal of support for Ukraine.

Davos Review/Anders Aslund from the Kyiv Post

According to Anders Aslund's account there appeared to be several Ukrainian themed events at Davos, along with the continued presence of

Ukraine House that has become a Davos institution. Aslund mentioned 2 over-arching themes:

- There is a building consensus of the need to confiscate frozen Russan Central Bank reserves, for re-purposing to fund both Ukrainian reconstruction and weapons purchases.
- The need for Europe's defense industries to prepare for a long war.

 The same should be said for the defense industries of both the United States and Ukraine.

If there is a lesson to be drawn from the continuing debate in the U.S. Congress over military support for Ukraine, it is – don't rely on the United States. The United States has been continually late, starting with at the beginning of Russia's latest invasion when the United States shipped a total of 90 Javelin missiles to stop the Russians, to continual delays in responding to Ukraine's requests for additional weapons, from M777 howitzers to F-16s, and now the unseemly debate in Congress that we witness today.

Hitting Russian Oil Storage Facilities

Over the last few days Ukraine has been hitting several oil & gas storage facilities inside Russia, most recently a major facility near St. Petersburg. The <u>Latest Denys</u> contains a fascinating account of the Ukrainian strike near St. Petersburg. Some highlights:

- 1:15 into the video the infrastructure that was damaged or destroyed was mostly produced in Germany. With sanctions, the destroyed and damaged equipment will be more difficult to replace.
- 2:20 into the video Denys reported that Russia evacuated the tankers that were tied up at the port at the time of the strike. One of the ships was named the Ocean Appilon. According to Denys the tanker is quite new, launched in 2019. It sails under Liberian registry, owned by a company in Singapore and operated by a company in Greece.

- 3:00 into the video The destination of the tanker was listed as a port in the Netherlands. So much for Western sanctions on Russian oil exports.
- 3:25 into the video Last month Ukraine attacked the largest Russian export terminal, Novorossiysk on the Black Sea. There are rumors that Pres. Zelenskyy got a warning from Ukraine's western allies to stop attacking Russian oil export infrastructure. Given the destination of the aforementioned Ocean Appilon, the rumors just might be true.

If the rumors are true, it appears that Ukraine has gotten fed up with Western warnings about attacking Russian oil export infrastructure. Ukraine is continuing to develop more capable long-range UAVs capable of hitting targets deep inside Russia, and doing considerable damage in the process. I wouldn't be at all surprised if Ukraine attempts to hit oil ports on the Russian Pacific Coast, if not via UAVs then by sabotage.

<u>"More Ukrainian Strategic Strikes"</u>/by Mick Ryan via Substack

Some excerpts:

- (Deep Strikes) "allow Ukraine the time to reconstitute its army, through training, equipment replacement and standardisation, rest and rotation, as well as potentially mobilising new troops and formations. It also permits time for rebuilding of Western defence industry, and the conservation of resources this year so they can be built up and then expended in 2025 offensives."
- "Western strategy must shift from resourcing the 'defence of Ukraine' to resourcing the 'defeat of Russia'. Without such a change in strategy and resources, it is difficult to see a resolution to this war that is both just and enduring for the Ukrainian people."
- "As such the strategic strikes in Russia, in Crimea, against Russian military operational infrastructure and maritime strikes in the Black Sea will be vital shaping activities in the coming year."

Ryan goes on the describe what he calls the "strike complex," that includes:

- "Support the achievement of Ukrainian operational and tactical activities. An example of this might be the recent downing of the Russian air force A-50 Mainstay command and control aircraft this month."
- "Enhance Ukraine's strategic freedom of maneuver. This freedom of maneuver is not exclusively military. A good example of this is the attacks on the Black Sea Fleet. This has led to the Russian fleet being less effective in the western reaches of the Black Sea. Consequently, it has permitted the Ukrainians to reopen a maritime trade corridor which is essential to their grain export operations – and earning foreign currency."
- "Engage in economic warfare and to degrade Russian industrial capacity. Examples include two recorded strikes on the Mashinostroeniya Design Bureau in Kolomna, which develops missiles and anti-tank guided missiles. Ukraine is also reported to have recently attacked gun powder factories in Bryansk and Tambov and other locations. Another example is the recent strikes on Russian oil storage and export facilities."
- "Serve important political purposes. The 2023 strikes on Moscow using drones, the Kerch bridge, airfields and even railway tracks within Russia were calculated to paint a picture of Russian military and political incompetence for the Russia people. This is intended to keep political pressure on Putin and demonstrate to Russian citizens that the war is not going their way. It is not clear that this is having a major effect (yet)."

Conclusion – "Ukraine's maturing strike complex is an extraordinarily impressive achievement and will have a vital role to play in Ukraine's 2024 military strategy. It will provide some breathing space for the Ukrainian Armed Forces, will help attrit the Russian forces and assist in Ukraine achieving some of its strategic influence objectives."

Ukraine's improving deep strike capability brings the prohibition of U.S. weapons used by Ukraine to hit Russia increasingly into question.

News From the Batttlefield

According to the Ukrainian Defense Ministry, yesterday's Russian casualties, either dead of so badly wounded that they cannot return to the battlefield - 1,510. This is the largest number of Russian casualties in a single day in my memory, likely Avdiivka and Kupiyansk.

8:04 AM: British police have created a new unit that will specialize in dealing with threats originating from a number of countries, primarily Iran, China and Russia.

9:02 AM: In Israel, thousands of people came to rallies: they demand the resignation of the government, an end to hostilities and the return of hostages

 It is noted that at the rallies organized by the Forum of Families of Hostages and the Missing, there were speakers who demanded an end to the hostilities in Gaza and an exchange with Hamas for the return of the hostages.

2:46 PM: Switzerland and India sign FTA after 16 years of negotiations

6:11 PM: I am convinced that Ukraine will win if the USA gives the promised aid, - American diplomat Bryza

 Matthew Bryza, former adviser to the US Secretary of State, former director of European and Eurasian affairs at the US National Security Council, in an interview with the host of the "Studio Zahid" program, talked about NATO troops in Ukraine and assistance to Ukraine under President Trump.

6:20 PM: Polish President Andrzej Duda announced a meeting with Volodymyr Zelensky in the format of the "Lublin Triangle", PAP.

 "_Unfortunately, it is our tradition that we have to fight for freedom against the Russian invader. That is why it is so important to support Ukraine_," Duda said during a press conference with Lithuanian President Gitanas Nauseda.

10:19 PM: In Italy, the showing of the Kremlin tape "The Witness" with fakes about Ukraine was cancelled.

- The film tells the story of the Belgian violinist Daniel Cohen, who finds himself in Kyiv during a full-scale invasion of the Russian Federation.
 And here he becomes a witness of "inhuman crimes of Ukrainian nationalists".
- In the X social network, the announcement of the show was shared by the pro-Russian Italian-language account X Donbass Italia and the Russian military leader Andrea Lucidi. However, after the publicity, the cinema where "Witness" was supposed to be shown canceled the screening.

10:38 PM: Florida Governor Ron DeSantis has announced his withdrawal from the US presidential race.

• The politician withdrew his candidacy in favor of Donald Trump.

11:11 PM: The death toll of Palestinians in the Gaza Strip as a result of fighting between Israel and the Hamas group has exceeded 25,000, — Reuters.

11:11 PM: South Korea has called North Korea's claim of testing a nuclear-powered underwater drone an exaggeration. The military's analysis shows that it was most likely a torpedo — it is unlikely that it had any nuclear component.

11:11 PM: The US is drawing up plans for a protracted military campaign against Yemen's Houthis after 10 days of strikes have failed to stop the group from attacking foreign vessels in the Red Sea.

11:11 PM: The US has conducted tests of the B-21 Raider strategic bomber, the publication Air and space forces reported.

NATIONAL

7:42 AM: Summary of the General Staff as of 06:00 January 21:

- During the past 24 hours, 80 combat clashes took place. In total, the enemy launched 3 missile strikes (with S-300 anti-aircraft guided missiles against the civilian infrastructure of Novogradivka, Donetsk region) and 4 air strikes, and carried out 58 attacks from MSV on the positions of the Armed Forces of Ukraine and populated areas.
- During the day, the aviation of the Defense Forces struck 6 areas of concentration of personnel, weapons and military equipment, 1 antiaircraft missile complex, 1 ammunition warehouse and 1 enemy communication hub.
- The units of the missile forces struck 3 areas of concentration of personnel, weapons, and military equipment, 1 control point and 1 radio electronic warfare station of the enemy.

9:26 AM: Ukraine is building its own 1,000-kilometer "Surovikin Line," The Telegraph.

- Ukraine's new defense structures are very similar to those used by Russia to thwart the counteroffensive of the Armed Forces: a threelayer system of trenches, tank traps and strongholds.
- One of the main lines of fortifications now runs 10 km from Avdiivka.
- Ukraine strengthened its defense fortifications in the north by 63%.
- The task is not only to build a hard line of defense, but also to make it flexible for further attacks.

11:02 AM: Budanov refused to give a forecast for 2024. "I hope that our success will be greater than theirs," - the head of GUR to the Financial Time magazine.

• Highlights from the Financial Times article:

- GUR strikes against the enemy's rear annoy Western partners who fear a nuclear strike in return, but "everything we have done, we will continue to do;"
- "There is a significant lack. It is even impossible to imagine that we can do without mobilization";
- "the whole legend about the power of Russia is a soap bubble;"
- about the year 2023: "To say that everything is fine is not true. To say that a disaster has occurred is also not true.

11:26 AM: "Mobilization is primarily a question of justice. It is fair to replace, it is fair to rest someone. It is unfair to avoid when someone dies for you, and it is fair that a person should know where he is going, for how much, how well he will be prepared," — Volodymyr Zelenskyi in an interview with the British TV channel Channel 4 News.

1:04 PM: Threat of using ballistic weapons from the south, — Air Force of the Armed Forces of Ukraine.

1:23 PM: Volodymyr Zelenskyi does not see the need to mobilize half a million people now.

 "I personally do not yet see the need to mobilize half a million people... Not because I now want to answer, to please someone," the president said.

2:04 PM: Considerable activity of enemy tactical aviation is observed in the east and south, - PS ZSU.

There is a threat of using air weapons.

3:19 PM: The police have identified the persons who broke into the apartment of the well-known journalist Yuriy Nikolov. They were searched, and investigations are ongoing.

 According to our sources, one of them is a serviceman who did not like Nikolov's criticism of the military. So he tricked his acquaintances to "teach" the journalist. His door was plastered with leaflets urging him to go to war. • Now the detainees face up to 4 years in prison.

3:53 PM: On the Tavria direction, the enemy has increased artillery activity and is regrouping.

- This was reported by the spokesman of the joint press center of the Defense Forces of the Tavria direction, Colonel Oleksandr Shtupun.
- He noted that the Russian group in the Avdiiv region has more than 40,000 personnel. During the day, the enemy lost almost 300 people and 27 pieces of equipment.

4:10 PM: Air Force reports enemy tactical aircraft activity to the southeast.

4:35 PM: The Air Force reports the movement of a guided air missile, believed to be an Kh-59, in the direction of the Dnipro.

4:48 PM: An alleged photo of the order is published online, which allows police officers to "use traumatic weapons, rubber batons and tear gas to disperse any rallies."

- The Center for Counteracting Disinformation informs that this document is fake, as is its content. All rules of this nature are prescribed in the relevant Law "On the National Police".
- By spreading such fakes, the enemy is trying to discredit the law enforcement agencies of Ukraine.

5:22 PM: Volodymyr Zelenskyy personally invited the head of the Security Service of Ukraine Vasyl Malyuk after information about surveillance of journalists.

- The president announced this in an interview with the British TV channel Channel 4 News.
- Zelensky stated that, in his opinion, the fact of secret surveillance of the team of Bihus.Info journalists should be thoroughly investigated.

5:37 PM: Zelenskyi will sacrifice and replace his entourage very easily if necessary - political scientist Reiterovych

- Head of political and legal programs of the Ukrainian Center for Social Development, Ihor Reiterovych, believes that President Volodymyr Zelenskyi can replace his entourage in 2024.
- "I think that we are approaching a period of changes in power. In 2024, with a 90% probability, we will definitely see a new Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine. That is, they will try to blame part of all problems and failures on the current government. Especially since such changes do not require new ones elections," explained Reiterovych

7:52 PM: Summary of the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine as of 18:00 on January 21:

- During the day, 59 combat clashes took place. In total, during the day, the enemy launched 4 missile and 69 air strikes, carried out 50 attacks from anti-aircraft missiles on the positions of our troops and populated areas.
- Aviation of the Defense Forces struck 9 areas of concentration of personnel, weapons and military equipment of the enemy.
- Units of the missile forces damaged 1 control point, 3 artillery means and 1 anti-aircraft vehicle of the enemy.

8:27 PM: Mobilization of students and teachers: what postponement and to whom will the state provide -

- Due to the full-scale military aggression of Russia, martial law and general mobilization are still ongoing in Ukraine. What changes the state is preparing in the mobilization of students and teachers, we will tell in our material.
- Mobilization is the call of citizens for military service during the state
 of emergency, which was extended in Ukraine until February 14, 2024
 due to the escalation of the conflict with Russia. Mobilization applies
 to men aged 18 to 60 who have a military record and do not have
 grounds for exemption or postponement of conscription.

8:59 PM: Rats and mice have invaded the trenches in Ukraine. This is a grim echo of the First World War, reports CNN.

- The mouse infestation is partly due to the changing seasons and mating cycle of the mice, but is also an indicator that warfare has become static;
- In December, there was an outbreak of "mouse fever" in many Russian parts of the occupied territories. Symptoms include rashes, low blood pressure, bleeding in the eyes, vomiting and, because it affects the kidneys, severe back pain and problems with urination, the publication said.

9:45 PM: In the Kherson, Mykolaiv, and Dnipropetrovsk regions, there is a threat of using attack UAVs, the Air Force reports.

10:53 PM: Activity of enemy tactical aviation is observed in the waters of the Sea of Azov, the Air Force reported.

- The movement of attack UAVs in the territory of the Mykolaiv region in the north-western direction. A threat to Kirovohrad Oblast.
- Enemy UAVs are moving in the direction of Cherkasy region.

10:56 PM: Another DDoS attack is being carried out on Monobank, bank cofounder Horokhovskyi said.

• "DDoS attacks are just nonstop. An attack with a total load of 580 million service requests just ended. It's just space," he said.

MORDOR – ruZZia

2:12 AM: Local residents of Tula, Russian Federation, are reporting on social networks about an explosion at the Shcheglovskyi Val plant, one of the largest enterprises in Russia's defense industry.

• We are waiting for official information. Video from local social networks.

8:04 AM: In the Leningrad Region of the Russian Federation, the gas terminal of the Sea Trade Port of the "Novatek" company caught fire in the village of Ust-Luga after the explosions.

8:04 AM: Explosions were also heard in the Russian Tula, Smolensk, Bryansk and Oryol regions. The local authorities announced the alleged work of the Air Defense Forces.

8:04 AM: No Russian oil tankers diverted from course in Red Sea due to Yemeni Houthi attacks on merchant vessels, Bloomberg

10:09 AM: A private plane flying to Moscow from India crashed in Afghanistan. There were 6 people on board, — rosZMI.

• It is reported that the Falcon 10B passenger jet belonged to Gazprom. Before the crash, the pilot reported technical problems.

11:56 AM: Russia spends more weapons and ammunition than it can produce and has difficulties with quality control, — Budanov in an interview with the Financial Times

- The head of the GUR noted that this state of affairs explains Russia's search for weapons in other countries, and North Korea is currently the largest supplier of weapons.
- Another problem is personnel. Moscow is losing as many or even more military personnel than it can recruit.

11:58 AM: Traffic on the Crimean Bridge is temporarily blocked, - rosZMI.

12:21 PM: Today's night attack on the sea terminal in Russian Ust-Luz is a special operation of the Security Service of Ukraine, — mass media.

"Oil terminal "Ust-Luga Oil" in the Leningrad region is an important object for the enemy. Fuel is processed there, which, in particular, is also supplied to the troops of the Russian Federation. A successful attack on such a terminal causes not only economic losses to the enemy, depriving the occupiers of the opportunity to earn money for waging war in Ukraine, but also significantly complicates the logistics of fuel for the Russian military," Ukrainian media reported.

12:42 PM Social Networks: Explosions are heard in temporarily occupied Sevastopol.

2:36 PM: Putin wants to sign a new social contract with the people of the Russian Federation before the elections, said the representative of the GUR Andriy Chernyak.

- He noted that the holding of the All-Russian Forum "Small Motherland

 the Strength of Russia" in January 2024 is one of the demonstrative
 illustrations of the regime's attempt to reduce public tension and
 justify Moscow's criminal actions.
- The main tasks of the Russian dictatorship in the current conditions are to calm the population, maintain full public support for the war against Ukraine, and prevent destabilization within Russia.

5:03 PM: At TOT, the occupiers are collecting money from the salaries of state employees for the fund that supports the Russian military - Resistance

 In the temporarily occupied territories of the south, the occupiers opened a branch of the foundation, which organizes propaganda events and supports the military of the Russian Federation. This was reported by the Center of National Resistance.

6:49 PM: Russia has increased the number of missile carriers in the Black Sea to two, bringing the total salvo to 16 Kalibr missiles.

• This is reported by the Defense Forces of the South.

7:13 PM: The Novatek plant on the Baltic Sea coast has halted all technological operations following an attack by Ukrainian drones, Bloomberg.

• The shipment of oil to tankers was also completely stopped.

8:09 PM: A possible visit of Putin was announced in the DPRK, AR reports.

• The head of the GUR Kyrylo Budanov said that North Korea is the largest supplier of weapons and ammunition to the Russian Federation

and without its help "the situation would be catastrophic" for the occupying forces.

8:29 PM: Russia has stepped up its assaults due to frost, but its losses have increased, British intelligence reports.

- Over the past five days, the number of losses of military equipment on the part of Russia has increased by 88%, and the loss of tanks by 95%. Losses in manpower increased by 15% over the same period.
- These data indicate a steady increase in the intensity of Russian attacks, probably due to the frost, which allows armored vehicles to move over the terrain.

KHARKIV

11:32 AM: The withdrawal of Ukrainian forces from Krokhmalny in the Kupyansk direction is temporary, the military has moved to other lines to save lives.

 Volodymyr Fityo, the spokesman of the command of the Ground Forces, commented on the information about the capture of the village by the Russians.

• "The front line is shifting daily, we just don't report the capture or recapture of 100 meters, we don't need it. And for Russian propagandists, any victory must be brought as a Pyrrhic one, to show why they lost 7,055 soldiers at the front in the area of responsibility of the Khortytsia strategic group in January alone," said Fityo.

2:07 PM: Russian troops shelled Kupyan district of Kharkiv region, — OVA.

 A local resident born in 1950 died of injuries in the village of Pishchane.

10:04 PM: "Kupyansk remains the most important strategic settlement for the enemy": spokesman of the "Steel Border" brigade

- Ivan Shevtsov, spokesman for the "Steel Border" brigade, said that the enemy is currently concentrating its greatest efforts in the direction of Kupyansk with the aim of capturing the city. According to him, at the moment, the enemy has concentrated its efforts most on the Kupyan direction in the Sinkivka area. The occupiers continue to attack it, because "the closest and best way to Kupyansk goes through Synkivka."
- "For the enemy, Kupyansk remains the most important strategic settlement, where he concentrates all his forces. Kupyansk, Kupyansk-Vuzlovy for him today is a goal, a task, and they are trying to achieve this goal with all their strength and means, but they are not succeeding, the enemy is indeed suffering great losses both in terms of personnel and equipment," said Ivan Shevtsov.

10:20 AM: In temporarily occupied Donetsk, the market came under fire — local channels.

 Eyewitnesses report a large number of dead and wounded.

10:55 AM Social Networks: Explosions are heard in Slovyansk, Donetsk region.

5:51 PM: the Russians hit Kurakhovo in Donetsk region, reported the head of the OVA, Vadym Filashkin.

• A man died, another person was injured. A kindergarten and several private houses were damaged.

10:45 PM: Occupiers announced an attack on a market in Donetsk, where people died. The Armed Forces say they have commented

 On the morning of Sunday, January 21, 27 people were allegedly killed in the temporarily occupied Donetsk as a result of an alleged attack on the market. OSUV "Tavria" declares that they are not involved in the

- shelling. The leader of the "DPR" Denys Pushylin and the United Press Center of the Defense Forces of the Tauri region write about this.
- The Defense Forces of Ukraine assure that the forces under the command of the "Tavria" OSUV, in this case, did not conduct combat operations with means of destruction.




ZAPORIZHIA

1:29 PM: In the center of Zaporizhzhia, an unknown man shot twice at a woman passing by, and then shot himself, the head of the Zaporizhzhia OVA Yury Malashko reported.

- It is noted that when the police team arrived, the offender was sitting on a bench in the park. Seeing the law enforcement officers, he committed suicide by shooting himself.
- Doctors tried to resuscitate the victim, but she died in the ambulance.

- According to OVA, 5 private houses, 2 outbuildings and a garage were mutilated in the Marganets community in the Nikopol region.
- A power line was damaged in Marhanka itself. More than 11,000 homes were cut off. By now, most families have already had their lights turned on.

5:04 PM: Fighters from PvK "East" destroyed an enemy Kh-59 missile over the Dnipro district of the region, reported the head of Dnipropetrovsk OVA Serhii Lysak.

10:41 PM: In the area of the city of Dnipro, an enemy unmanned aerial vehicle, the Air Force reported.





9:45 AM: There are 200,000 inhabitants on the right bank of the Dnieper in the Kherson Region, some villages have been razed to the ground, Nikitenko, editor-in-chief of the "Most" publication

"The Tyagin community is suffering a lot, obviously there are not many people left there. In general, they say about 200,000 people on the right bank - it seems that such a figure is written in the development program of the region and it is basically confirmed. Some settlements are already almost deserted, that is, above. There is a piece of the Tyagin community that overlooks the Dnieper, there are several villages there, I will not name them, they are already completely deserted, they no longer exist, they do not look like Krynyk, of course, but close to it, because the Russians they are leveled with the ground," explained Nikitenko.

8:40 PM: Kherson is under Russian fire, reports the head of the MBA Mrochko.

3:40 PM: The head of OVA Andriy Rajkovich confirmed the explosions in Kirovohrad Oblast.
