Destruction of St. Michael's Cathedral/Ukrainska Pravda

This is the latest in a series of podcasts produced by Ukrainska Pravda, documenting theft and cultural appropriation by the Russians against Ukraine and Ukrainians going back hundreds of years. The series is entitled "Why do they Steal?" You will find links to each episode of the series.

St. Michael's Cathedral has stood on the high ground in Kyiv since the 12th Century. For those who have been to Kyiv, St. Michael's stands on one end of a broad street, with St. Sophia's Cathedral on the other end. In front of St. Michael's is the statue of Queen Olga, where couples about to be married (including us) go to pay tribute. Today, next to St. Michael's there are memorials to the victims of the 1932 & 1933 Famine, and a memorial to Ukrainian soldiers who lost their lives fighting the Russians.

During Euromaidan St. Michael's served as a sanctuary and triage center for protesters wounded and injured in the fighting in and near Independence Square. The bells of St. Michael's have been rung only twice to warn of an invasion, in 1240 during the Mongol sack of Kyiv, and in December 2013, during Euromaidan, warning of the attack of Interior Ministry police against the protestors on Independence Square.

During Soviet times there was a plan to create a grand plaza, along the lines of Red Square in Moscow, going from St. Michael's to St. Sophia's. In the 1930s, to make room for the grand plaza where May Day parades would be held, it was decided to destroy both St. Michael's and St. Sophia's. St. Michael's was destroyed but, according to a story that I heard, the Socialist Prime Minister of France, Leon Blum, talked Stalin out of destroying St. Sophia's. After Ukraine's independence in 1991, St. Michael's was rebuilt.

Russia's history of stealing extends not only to religious and cultural artifacts but to the dead like Prince Potemkin, the living such as approximately 20,000 Ukrainian children who have been abducted to Russia by Russian invaders, washing machines and women's underwear from houses of Ukrainians, a raccoon from the Kherson Zoo and, as we have found out, money that was supposed to be spent on military modernization.

Stealing must be in the Russians' DNA.

SITUATION UPDATE OF THE GENERAL STAFF OF UKRAINIAN ARMED FORCES JANUARY 22, 2024 During the day of January 22, there were 68x combat engagements. The enemy launched a total of 3x missile and 65x air strikes, 56x MLRS attacks at the positions of Ukrainian troops and various settlements.

In the morning, russian occupants launched a missile attack with 4x S300/400 anti-aircraft guided missiles at the civilian infrastructure of the cities of Kharkiv and Balakliya (Kharkiv oblast).

Air strikes hit Hraniv, Hryhorivka, Pishchane (Kharkiv oblast), Novojehorivka, Bilohorivka, Serebryans'ke forestry (Luhansk oblast), Terny, Rozdolivka, Bohdanivka, Khromove, Klishchiivka, Bila Hora, Maiors'ke, Novobakhmutivka, Avdiivka, Vodyane, Novomykhailivka, Staromaiors'ke (Donetsk oblast), Novodarivka (Zaporizhzhia oblast), Kachkarivka, Chervonyi Mayak, Zmiivka, and Beryslav (Kherson oblast).

More than 140x settlements in Chernihiv, Sumy, Kharkiv, Luhansk, Donetsk, Zaporizhzhia, Dnipropetrovsk, Kherson, and Mykolaiv oblasts came under artillery fire.

Khortytsia operational-strategic group, Kup'yans'k axis: Ukrainian defenders repelled 4x enemy attacks in the vicinity of the settlement of Syn'kivka (Kharkiv oblast).

Lyman axis: Ukrainian defenders repelled 1x attack of the invaders near Terny (Donetsk oblast), and 5x more attacks near Makiivka, Bilohorivka, and Serebryans'ke forestry (Luhansk oblast).

Bakhmut axis: the Ukrainian Defense Forces repelled 7x attacks of the adversary near Bohdanivka, Klishchiivka, and Andriivka (Donetsk oblast).

Tavria operational-strategic group, Avdiivka axis: Ukrainian Defense Forces repelled 10x adversary attacks in the vicinities of Stepove, Avdiivka, and 7x more attacks near Pervomais'ke and Nevel's'ke (Donetsk oblast) during the day of January 22.

Mar'inka axis: the Ukrainian defenders continue to hold back the enemy near Heorhiivka and Novomykhailivka (Donetsk oblast). The Ukrainian troops repelled 21x attacks in that area. Zaporizhzhia axis: the Ukrainian defenders repelled 1x enemy attack in the vicinity of Robotyne (Zaporizhzhia oblast).

Odesa operational-strategic group, Kherson axis: During the day of January 22, the adversary attempted 1x unsuccessful assault at the positions of the Ukrainian troops.

During the day of January 22, the Ukrainian Air Force launched air strikes on 8x concentrations of troops, weapons, and military equipment of the adversary. Also, the Ukrainian Air Defense forces and means destroyed 1x Kh-59 air-launched guided missile.

The Ukrainian missile troops hit 1x command post, 1x artillery system, and 1x radar station of the russian invaders.

8:00 AM: By sending ballistic missiles to Russia, North Korea tests them on a battlefield in Ukraine for the first time, Bloomberg.

8:00 AM: Israeli and Palestinian foreign ministers will hold separate meetings with EU foreign ministers today to discuss potential steps to end the war, Reuters.

8:00 AM: Israel to transfer frozen Palestinian funds to Norway for temporary storage, The Times of Israel.

8:00 AM: Switzerland and India reach consensus on free trade agreement after 16 years of negotiations.

8:00 AM: In France, 150,000 people demonstrated against the immigration law.

8:23 AM: Losses of Russian troops as of January 22, according to the General Staff of the Armed Forces.

2:43 PM: Britain has provided a UN panel with satellite photos of Russian ships being loaded at a North Korean port, The Guardian.

- What exactly was downloaded Britain cannot say for sure. But this happened against the background of Pyongyang's accusations of supplying weapons to the Russian Federation.
- "Russia's use of North Korean weapons in Ukraine is a violation of several resolutions of the UN Security Council_," the UN diplomat said.

3:14 PM: Slovakian Prime Minister Robert Fico said Ukraine should give up part of its territory to the occupiers to end the war, Politico.

- Fico does not consider Ukraine to be a sovereign state and says that Kyiv is under US control. He said that he will promise Ukraine's path to NATO, because it is "the basis for the Third World War."
- The spokesman of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Ukraine Oleg Nikolenko has already reacted: "_There can be no compromise on territorial integrity. Neither Ukraine, nor Slovakia, nor any other country_".

3:23 PM: Poland has joined the G7 declaration on guarantees for Ukraine, Polish Prime Minister Donald Tusk said.

• Tusk noted that this declaration is intended to mobilize democratic countries in support of Ukraine.

4:17 PM: US launches spy plane to monitor North Korea, Yonhap.

4:17 PM: The representative of Greece, Theodoros Rousopoulos, was elected as the new president of the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe, according to the PACE page on the X network.

4:17 PM: NASA has re-established contact with the Ingenuity helicopter on Mars, NASA's Jet Propulsion Laboratory.

5:18 PM: The Polish government will appoint a commissioner for the restoration of Ukraine.

• This was stated by Polish Prime Minister Donald Tusk during his visit to Kyiv, reports Onet.

• According to Tusk, the representative of the Polish government on issues of restoration of Ukraine will be the member of the Seimas Pavel Koval, who heads the committee on foreign affairs.

5:28 PM: This year, Belgium will provide €611 million in military aid to Ukraine.

- This was announced by the Minister of Defense of Ukraine, Rustem Umyerov.
- Belgium also has a long-term commitment to support the modernization of the Ukrainian defense forces.

9:48 PM: Hungary will not participate in financing the supply of weapons to Ukraine at the expense of the "European Peace Fund", but it cannot and does not want to interfere with other countries in this matter.

• On January 22, the Minister of Foreign Affairs and Foreign Economic Relations of Hungary, Peter Szijjarto, announced this to journalists following the results of the meeting of the heads of foreign affairs of the member countries of the organization.

10:37 PM: The US and Britain have imposed sanctions against key figures in the Hamas financial network, the British government's press service said.

10:37 PM: Four people have died in Britain and Ireland as a result of Storm Isha, The Independent reports.

10:37 PM: A 7-magnitude earthquake struck the China-Kyrgyzstan border — European-Mediterranean Seismological Center.

11:34 PM: Lithuania and Poland will hold exercises in the strategically vulnerable Suval Corridor.

- This information was confirmed by the presidents of both countries Gitanas Nauseda and Andrzej Duda in a joint interview with Delfi.
- _"I am very glad that the President of Poland really responded sincerely to the desire to conduct joint exercises in this area, which is called the Suval Isthmus", said the President of Lithuania.

• He added that he had discussed with the Polish leader the likely date of the exercises, which could take place in April.

National

7:11 AM: Summary of the General Staff as of 06:00 January 22:

- During the past 24 hours, 68 combat clashes took place._ In total, the enemy launched 4 missile and 102 air strikes, carried out 80 rounds of anti-aircraft fire at the positions of the Armed Forces of Ukraine and populated areas.
- During the day, the aviation of the Defense Forces struck 9 areas where the enemy's personnel, weapons and military equipment were concentrated.
- Units of missile troops damaged 1 area of concentration of personnel, 1 control point, 3 artillery means and 1 means of anti-aircraft defense of the enemy.

7:16 AM: During the night, the Air Defense Forces of the Armed Forces of Ukraine destroyed 8 enemy "shaheeds" - the Air Force of the Armed Forces of Ukraine.

- In total, about 376,860 Russians were eliminated.
- Cities were reportedly attacked by drones.

9:09 AM: Donetsk, Dnipropetrovsk, Kharkiv regions of Donetsk, Dnipropetrovsk, Kharkiv regions - the threat of using ballistic weapons, the Air Force of the Armed Forces of Ukraine.

9:12 AM: Volodymyr Zelenskyy congratulated Ukrainians on Soboronosti Day.

• "When all Ukrainians hold hands, they will not raise them up to surrender. We all fight. And today this applies not only to both banks

of the Dnieper. Today, the universality of Ukrainians covers both hemispheres of the Earth, in every corner of which on February 24 it was heard: I am a Ukrainian," the president wrote.

9:26 AM: Prime Minister of Poland Donald Tusk arrived in Kyiv, — Office of the Prime Minister of Poland.

- It is reported that this is his first visit to Ukraine after being appointed to the position.
- It is noted that he plans to discuss the problem of Poland's embargo on the import of Ukrainian agricultural products and the blocking of the border by Polish carriers.

9:41 AM: Volodymyr Zelenskyi will submit a draft law on multiple citizenship to the Verkhovna Rada.

- He said this in a greeting on the occasion of the Day of the Congregation.
- "Today, I am submitting a key bill to the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine, which will make it possible to adopt complex changes to the legislation and introduce the institution of multiple citizenship," said the president.

10:01 AM: Congratulations to all Ukrainians on the Day of Sobornosty!

- Every year on January 22, we celebrate this holiday in honor of the unification of Ukraine, which took place in 1919.
- And today we need this unity more than ever in order to achieve victory. Therefore, we wish for strength, love for others, the ability to donate or help the country in other ways.
- We also honor the memory of fallen defenders.
- Only together we will win! Glory to UkraineuA

10:18 AM: Volodymyr Zelensky signed the decree "On the territories of the Russian Federation historically populated by Ukrainians."

• According to the president, this means "returning the truth about the historical past for the sake of Ukraine's future."

10:38 AM: Law enforcement officers detained Roman Hrynkevich while trying to cross the border, the Prosecutor General's Office reported.

10:56 AM: Grynkevich's son will be remanded in custody today

- This was announced by the director of the State Bureau of Investigation Oleksiy Sukhachev.
- According to him, Roman Hrynkevich will be brought to court today for the purpose of choosing a measure.

11:04 AM: The SBI posted a video of the arrest of Roman Hrynkevich on the network.

11:25 AM: The State Emergency Service was informed about the work of cyber fraudsters.

- Today, Ukrainians began to receive messages allegedly from the State Emergency Service regarding the plan to evacuate residents with suspicious references.
- "The State Emergency Service did not send out these messages, and it is extremely dangerous to follow the links! Trust only verified sources," the message said.

12:12 PM: All of Ukraine - missile danger! The takeoff of the MiG-31K from the Savasleyka airfield of the Nizhny Novgorod Region was recorded, — Air Force of the ZSU.

12:24 PM: For 2023, 10 People's Deputies were notified of suspicion. The indictments against the two have been sent to the court, said Oleksiy Sukhachev, director of the DBR.

12:28 PM: "Ukrainian team" handed over a thousand warming sets to the 46th Airborne Brigade of the Airborne Assault Forces

• The paratroopers of the 46th brigade liberated the right-bank Kherson region from the occupiers, beat the Russians in Bakhmut and Soledar, in the Melitopol direction, and are now holding Marinka, reports "Ukrainian Team".

 "Let the warm kits that we have collected thanks to your donations protect them from the cold and fill them with the energy of revenge," said Artur Palatny, head of the "Ukrainian Team" during the handing over of aid.

1:02 PM: From 2022, the National Police took control of the financial operations of 7,000 enterprises that cooperated with enterprises from the Russian Federation and Belarus, and prevented the withdrawal of UAH 200 billion from Ukraine.

- This was announced by the head of the National Police, Ivan Vyhivskyi.
- According to Vyhivskyi, these are cases concerning Lybid LLC, which involves Russian oligarchs Igor and Arkady Rottenberg, who owned shares in the Ocean Plaza shopping center.

1:13 PM: Prime Minister of Ukraine Denys Shmyhal and Prime Minister of Poland Donald Tusk honored the memory of defenders of Ukraine who died in the war.

1:52 PM: In December 2023, Ukrainian ports exported more agricultural products than at any time since the Russian invasion, British intelligence.

 "Ukraine achieved this because it did not allow the Russian Black Sea Fleet to operate in the western part of the Black Sea, where it is under threat from Ukrainian missiles and unmanned surface ships," the message reads.

2:10 PM: Volodymyr Zelenskyi has already met with Polish Prime Minister Donald Tusk.

2:28 PM: There is a new Polish defense package, Volodymyr Zelenskyi.

- "_There is a new form of our cooperation for the sake of a larger scale of weapons purchases for Ukrainian needs - this is a Polish loan for Ukraine. We also discussed the possibility of future joint production of weapons with the Prime Minister today_", the president wrote after the meeting.
- 3:36 PM: The Air Force reports a threat of air strikes.

3:56 PM: 40 FPV drones are leaving for the 23rd separate special purpose battalion of the Ukrainian Armed Forces, Kyiv Mayor Vitaly Klychko said.

• "_Fighters serve and protect Ukraine in the Donbass. And let this charitable aid be a contribution to the destruction of the enemy_," Klitschko writes.

5:51 PM: Issuing summonses to citizens is not a function of the National Police of Ukraine.

- This was stated by the head of the National Police, Ivan Vyhivskyi.
- "_We are ready to help, but the police officers will not personally go handing out summonses. At least until such a norm is established by law and it is not determined by our functionary_," said Vyhivskyi.

5:55 PM: Air Force reports enemy tactical aircraft activity.

6:28 PM: Ukraine and Poland will soon begin work to resolve issues related to the blocking of the border by Polish carriers.

- This was announced by the President of Ukraine Volodymyr Zelenskyi.
- "_At a time when we are defending not only our own independence, but also the freedom of other peoples of Europe, in particular the Polish people, solidarity with Ukraine should not be destroyed due to any obstacles," Zelenskyi said.

6:41 PM: Director of the State Security Bureau Oleksiy Sukhachev told the details of the case of businessman Ihor Mazepa, who is suspected of embezzling strategic lands of the Kyiv HPP.

- Proceedings regarding this device were started back in January 2022.
- According to him, since that time, 12 people involved in the embezzlement have been identified - these are not only local officials and officials of the State Geocadastre of Kyiv region, but also wellknown businessmen-developers.

7:15 PM: Volodymyr Zelenskyi presented state awards to Ukrainian defenders and civilians who distinguished themselves in the defense of Ukraine on the occasion of the Day of Sobornosty.

7:51 PM: Roman Hrynkevich arrived at the court session in handcuffs, media.

• The prosecutor will request a preventive measure in the form of detention with an alternative of bail in the amount of UAH 500 million, the spokeswoman of the Prosecutor General's Office, Nadiya Maksimets, reported.

8:09 PM: For 2023, expenditures of the general fund of the state budget on the security and defense sector accounted for 60.8% of the total amount of expenditures — 1,843.8 billion hryvnias.

• The Ministry of Finance of Ukraine writes about this.

8:12 PM: The Air Force reports the activity of enemy tactical aircraft in the waters of the Sea of Azov.

10:13 PM: The court sent Roman Hrynkevich to custody until March 17 with an alternative bail of half a billion hryvnias.

• He is one of the five suspects, like his father, in the case of the supply of clothing for the Armed Forces.

10:48 PM: Several groups of strike UAVs are on the border of the Kherson and Mykolaiv regions, heading north-west, the Air Force reports.

11:11 PM: The police will not take away from citizens the weapons they received at the beginning of the war, but will create a corresponding register, said the head of the National Police, Ivan Vyhovskyi.

"There is a war, and people feel safer with weapons. There is a bill to register these weapons. For a citizen to come and register them. After that, the weapon will be shot, counted and returned to the citizen. And after the end of the war, it will be necessary to surrender it within 90 days If you don't pass it, then you will be criminally responsible," he said.

11:53 PM: In honor of the Day of Sobornost, a meteorologist from the station "Akademik Vernadskyi" and a soldier who protects Ukraine in the direction of Bakhmut took a symbolic photo.

• It depicts Oleksandr Poluden, a meteorologist of the 28th Ukrainian Antarctic Expedition and Artem Ignatenko, a cook of the 26th Ukrainian Antarctic Expedition, who protects Ukraine in the aerial reconnaissance unit.

1:19 PM: About 900 Ukrainian police officers who defected to the Russians have already been identified.

• This was announced by the head of the National Police of Ukraine, Ivan Vyhivskyi.

1:42 PM: The war in Ukraine has undermined Russia's confidence in its conventional armed forces, — Reuters.

• According to the publication, this increased the importance for Moscow of non-strategic nuclear weapons as a means of deterrence in a potential future conflict with NATO.

3:01 PM: The takeoff of the MiG-31K from the Savasleika airfield of the Nizhny Novgorod region was recorded, — PS ZSU.

3:43 PM: With so-called 17 children with diseases of the nervous system and musculoskeletal system were taken from parts of Donetsk region to the Russian Federation for "rehabilitation".

- This was reported by Dmytro Lubinets, the Commissioner of the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine for human rights.
- According to the information of the ombudsman, they were sent by a plane of the Russian Ministry of Defense to the "Ogonyok" rehabilitation center near Moscow.

4:17 PM: The plane of the head of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation Sergey Lavrov covered the distance from Moscow to the USA by the northern route, flying over unfriendly countries in 12 hours and 45 minutes, — rosZMI.

6:56 PM: In the temporarily occupied Sevastopol, January 23 and 24 were declared "days off" due to problems with water supply.

- This was announced by the so-called "governor" of Sevastopol, Razvozhaev.
- Due to bad weather in Sevastopol on January 19, hydroelectric units supplying the city were contaminated. They are being cleaned, so local residents are being turned off.

7:30 PM: The plant of the Russian company "Novatek" will be able to resume full operation no earlier than in a few weeks, — Reuters.

- "_Novatek said on Sunday that it was forced to suspend some operations at a huge fuel export terminal in the Baltic Sea and the "technological process" at this complex due to a fire that broke out_", the publication writes.
- The attack by Ukrainian drones on the processing complex and terminal in Ust-Luz probably led to the loss of a quarter of Novatek's revenues.

9:27 PM: An air alert has been announced in temporarily occupied Sevastopol, local media reports.

• Ukrainians, take care of your safety, take shelter.

10:07 PM: Belarus wants to expand its business in the temporarily occupied territories of Ukraine, reports the Center of National Resistance (CNS).

• It is noted that Belarus plans to open a consulate in Rostov-on-Don by July 1. It will actually serve the residents of the temporarily occupied territories of Ukraine and help Belarusian businesses establish ties with the regions captured by Russia.

• Thus, in fact, the neighboring state once again supported the occupation of a sovereign country and violated international law, the Central Committee of the Central Intelligence Agency added.

- Hot on the trail, law enforcement officers arrested a National Guard serviceman on suspicion of premeditated murder.

11:54 AM: 1 person was killed and 1 injured as a result of the morning attack on Kramatorsk, — OVA.

 "A 49-year-old man died at the scene of the shooting, and his 31-yearold daughter was injured," said the head of the Donetsk OVA, Vadym Filashkin.

8:51 PM: On January 22, the head of Chechnya, Ramzan Kadyrov, visited the temporarily occupied Mariupol with the intention of "pushing" his son to the post of mayor, but he fled after being frightened by a drone.

- This was reported by Petro Andryushchenko, adviser to the mayor of Mariupol.
- According to him, Kadyrov planned to hold a "meeting" in the city's occupation administration in the morning. And then to perform in the Philharmonic. However, later, Kadyrov had to be urgently evacuated, because someone raised a drone in the air over a nearby stadium, where a football match was taking place.
