<u>"Ukraine's Economy is Performing Surprisingly Well"</u> By Anders Aslund/Atlantic Council

According to this article, Ukraine's wartime economy hardly looks like the basket cases described by many of the pundits and some in the U.S. Congress. Some takeaways:

- "Ukraine is likely to achieve annual economic growth of nearly 6 percent in 2023."
- "While inflation in Russia is currently around 7.5 percent, Ukraine's rate has fallen to five percent. Ukraine recently cut its interest rate from 16 percent to 15 percent, while the Central Bank of Russia did the opposite." If foreign financing dries up, Ukraine may have to start printing money again, as they did in 2022 when inflation spiked to 27%.
- Last September Lenna Koszarny, CEO of Horizon Capital the largest private equity firm focused on Ukraine, stated in remarks at Ukraine House in Washington, that 40% of Ukraine's budget outlays were supported by tax revenues, as opposed to external support, something that has escaped the attention of the pundits. Aslund quoted an IMF report stating that tax revenues had increased 23% from January September 2023, compared to the previous period. Some of this may be explained by many Ukrainian companies paying taxes for the first time, in an act of patriotism. Whatever the reason, the reduction in

the number of Ukrainian businesses operating outside what economists like to call the "real economy," will help turbocharge Ukraine's future growth. These businesses will now have access to the banking system, not just for borrowing but also as a source of bank deposits.

- "Ukraine's international currency reserves are currently higher than they have ever been, at around \$40 billion." This is compared to currency reserves of approximately \$3 billion in early 2014, at the end of the Revolution of Dignity.
- "The country's banking system functions surprisingly normally. According to a recent IMF report, Ukraine's total banking system assets and client deposits increased by 36 percent and 51 percent respectively between the start of Russia's full-scale invasion and August 2023. Ukraine's banks are flush with money and offer ample and cheap credits." Personally, I am surprised by the increase in bank deposits, in a country that has historically mis-trusted banks. Hopefully an increasing proportion of deposits are time deposits (greater than 1 year), that would form the basis for an increase of medium-term business financing that will be desperately needed as a source of private capital to support reconstruction.

The ultimate solution to financing Ukraine's reconstruction is the repurposing of approximately \$300 billion of Russian Central Bank assets to help finance Ukraine's reconstruction and support for Ukraine's military and, judging by the performance of Ukraine's wartime economy, the proceeds from the repurposing of the Russian Central Bank assets will fall on fertile ground.

#### News From the Battlefield

Earlier today, Ukraine reported that they destroyed a Russian Su-34 fighter bomber at an airbase in Chelyabinsk, more than 1,000 km. from the Ukrainian border. Expect to see more of these attacks, especially against Tu-95 bombers that launch large cruise missiles from over the Caspian Sea. Russia is no longer making Tu-95s, and they produce only a limited number of Su-34s, two of which were recently destroyed during a bombing run against Ukrainian positions along the Left Bank of the Dnipro River. Expect

further that Ukrainian attacks inside Russian territory will be made using increasingly sophisticated and long-range weapons produced by Ukraine.

In the "Latest Denys," he covers one of the recent Russian air attacks against Kyiv, where Ukraine shot down 10 of the Russian "Kinzhal" hypersonic cruise missiles, likely by using Patriots. These are the same Patriots that Ben Aris, Editor of BNE Intellinews a publication that covers Eastern Europe and the former Soviet Union, said in a post on Twitter (now called "X") would precipitate Russia's use of tactical nuclear weapons, if Ukraine ever received them.

## SITUATION UPDATE OF THE GENERAL STAFF OF UKRAINIAN ARMED FORCES JANUARY 3, 2024

During the day of January 3, there were 58x combat engagements. The enemy launched a total of 7x missile and 58x air strikes, 57x MLRS attacks at the positions of Ukrainian troops and various settlements.

Air strikes hit Zolochiv, Morokhovets, Pylna, Kolodyazne, Petropavlivka, Kucherivka, Podoly, Ivanivka, Berestove (Kharkiv oblast), Stelmakhivka, Novojehorivka, Serebryanske forestry (Luhansk oblast), Terny, Spirne, Pivnichne, Oleksandropil, Avdiivka, Novomykhailivka, Vodyane (Donetsk oblast), Orikhiv, Novodarivka (Zaporizhzhia oblast), Chervonyi Mayak, and Beryslav (Kherson oblast).

Around 110x settlements in Chernihiv, Sumy, Kharkiv, Luhansk, Donetsk, Zaporizhzhia, Kherson, and Mykolaiv oblasts came under artillery fire.

Sivershchyna and Slobozhanshchyna axes: the adversary maintains its military presence in the areas of russia bordering Ukraine.

**Khortytsia operational-strategic group, Kupyansk axis**: Ukrainian defenders repelled 3x enemy attacks in the vicinity of Synkivka and east of Petropavlivka (Kharkiv oblast).

**Bakhmut axis:** the Ukrainian troops repelled 4x attacks of the adversary near Bohdanivka and Andriivka (Donetsk oblast).

**Tavria operational-strategic group, Avdiivka axis**: the Ukrainian defenders continue to hold back the enemy who keeps trying to encircle Avdiivka. The Ukrainian defense Forces repelled 13x attacks near Novobakhmutivka, Stepove, Avdiivka, and 19x more attacks in the vicinities of Sjeverne, Pervomaiske, and Nevelske (Donetsk oblast).

**Maryinka axis**: the Ukrainian Defense Forces continue to hold back the enemy in the vicinities of Heorhiivka and Novomykhailivka (Donetsk oblast). The Ukrainian defenders repelled 14x attacks in that area.

**Shakhtarske axis**: the occupiers did not conduct any offensive (assault) operations.

**Zaporizhzhia axis**: the Ukrainian defenders repelled 1x enemy attack in the vicinity of Robotyne (Zaporizhzhia oblast).

Odesa operational-strategic group, Kherson axis: the Ukrainian Defense Forces continue to expand the bridgehead. Despite significant losses, the enemy does not abandon its intention to dislodge Ukrainian troops from their positions. During the day of January 3, the adversary made 9x unsuccessful attempts to assault.

During the day of January 3, the Ukrainian Air Force launched air strikes on 12x concentrations of adversary troops.

The Ukrainian missile troops hit 1x concentration of enemy troops, 3x air defense systems, 3x artillery systems, 1x electronic warfare station, and 2x command posts of the russian invaders.

- 9:29 AM: "\_It is necessary to provide Kyiv with long-range missiles that will allow Ukraine to destroy launch sites and command centers\_," said the head of the Polish Foreign Ministry, Radoslaw Sikorski.

  - "\_We have not received a written confirmation that our demands will be met, so we continue the protest ", Kondruv noted.
- 5:27 PM: Norway to send two F-16 fighter jets to Denmark to help train Ukrainian pilots, Reuters
- 5:27 PM: At least 100 people have been killed in multiple explosions near the grave of Iranian General Qassem Soleimani, BBC.
- 5:27 PM: A Russian citizen suspected of espionage for the Russian special services was detained in Latvia DELFI.
- 7:03 PM: The United Arab Emirates took a direct part in the organization of today's exchange, GUR of the Ministry of Defense of Ukraine.
- 9:22 PM: NATO will hold an emergency meeting due to Russia's massive missile and drone attacks, Dmytro Kuleba said.

• "One of the key topics will be the strengthening of Ukraine's antiaircraft defense. It is an important signal of Euro-Atlantic unity against the background of the escalation of Russian terror," he said.

9:47 PM: Romania, the Netherlands, Germany and Spain will purchase about 1,000 missiles for the Patriot air defense system.

- The corresponding contract was concluded by the NATO procurement agency on behalf of the coalition of these countries, the Associated Press reports
- \_"This investment demonstrates NATO's commitment to guaranteeing the safety of our people. Russian missile and drone strikes against Ukrainian civilians show how important modern air defense is. The expansion of ammunition production is key to the security of Ukraine and ours," said the NATO Secretary General.

10:49 PM: IAEA experts were denied access to some halls of Zaporizhzhya NPP power units, said the agency's general director, Raphael Grossi.

 According to him, this is the first case when the IAEA was not granted access to the reactor halls of power units that are in a state of "cold shutdown".

7:32 AM: Activity of enemy tactical aviation is observed in the eastern and southeastern directions, - Air Force of the Armed Forces of Ukraine.

10:07 AM: The SBU detained an ex-officer in Kyiv who was an FSB agent and proposed to join the eastern regions of Ukraine to the Rostov region of the Russian Federation.

- He also cooperated with the terrorist Pasichnyk, to whom he provided "expert" recommendations on intensifying repression against Ukrainian patriots in the temporarily occupied Luhansk.

- BEB analysts continue to investigate the activities of enterprises that may have illegally taken advantage of this benefit, and prepare proposals for eliminating potential risks during its application.

11:37 PM: Ukraine will pay social benefits to citizens on time throughout 2024.

- He noted that since January 1, a number of social standards have been updated in Ukraine. In particular, Shmyhal specified that the minimum salary increased by 6% from UAH 6,700 to UAH 7,100.

- "[...] \_the latter are used in "meat" assaults to create the status of a "combat unit"\_", Ukrainian intelligence writes.

4:37 PM: Russian general Igor Trifonov died in the war in Ukraine, rosZMI.

- Earlier, he was sentenced to nine and a half years in prison in the case of bribery and illegal possession of weapons.

4:54 PM: Emergency and rescue operations in the Shevchenkiv district of Kyiv have been completed, — the Ministry of Internal Affairs.

- 30 people died in the capital, of which 1 person died in the hospital.
- Work continued from December 29 after a massive enemy attack.

5:53 PM: The SBU has established the identities of 4 residents of the capital, who published a video of enemy "arrivals" in Kyiv on January 2.

- "\_The received information could be used by the occupiers and their accomplices to prepare new and adjust repeated airstrikes on Kyiv\_," the SBU writes.
- The publication of such media files is considered as adjusting enemy fire, which is punishable by up to 12 years in prison.

8:12 PM: Specialists of "Kyivteploenergo" restored heat supply in 67 houses, which were left without heat as a result of yesterday's rocket attack.

- Currently, one house in the Solomyan district, which was the most affected, remains partially without heating.
- Utility services are working to provide heat to the entrances of the house, where such a technical possibility exists.



# VISUAL CHRONOLOGY OF REGIONAL ROCKET, DRONE, ARTILLERY, MORTAR AND BOMB ALARMS






