<u>"Serhii Plokhy: Putin's belief that Russians and Ukrainians are one and the same people is dead"</u>/Interview in "Ukraine Business."

Along with Timothy Snyder, Plokhy has done more to distinguish the study of Ukrainian history and culture from that of Imperial Russia, the former Soviet Union, and the Russian Federation. The fact that there is, until recently, little or no distinction is a burden that Ukraine continues to bear in Western capitals and centers of learning.

Some excerpts from the interview:

- "Russia's imperial tradition of thinking about Russian security in terms
 of spheres of influence and the desire to project military power far
 beyond that state's borders can very well survive the current war and
 the loss of Ukraine. But the Russian imperial identity which imagines
 the Russian nation as consisting of modern-day Russians, Ukrainians,
 and Belarusians, will not survive."
- "Putin's belief that Russians and Ukrainians are one and the same people is dead, and I see no signs of it coming back any time soon. This is the end of a long tradition that goes back to the seventeenth century. The idea of "one people" was used by the Russian Empire to deny the right of Ukrainians to publish in Ukrainian, have separate national identity, and exist as a nation. The Bolsheviks discarded the imperial notion of the three-partite Russian nation (Russia, Belarus,

and Ukraine) in the name of the communist international. Putin brought the older model of Russian identity back only to bury it once and for all."

- "In the nineteenth century, Russian imperial intellectuals were surprised to discover that people around Kyiv did not speak Russian. To make an ethnic claim for Kyivan heritage, they invented a theory that the original population of Kyiv, which allegedly was Russian during the Kyivan Rus times, had migrated to Russia after the Mongol invasion. No one believes in that theory anymore. The ancestors of modern Ukrainians populated the area of today's Ukraine long before it became the core of the Kyivan Rus."
- "Well into the 1990s, history textbooks throughout the West were still referring to Kyivan Rus as "Kievan Russia." Meanwhile, most of the international newspaper coverage of independent Ukraine was coming from reporters based in Moscow. All this could not but influence Western policymakers and the positions they adopted toward Ukraine."
- "The key question posed by Russian aggression in February 2022 was whether Ukraine would be able to protect its independence and continue as a separate country and a separate nation. The war is not over yet, but it is pretty clear by now that Ukraine will remain on the map of Europe."

Plokhy calls out the corrosive influence that Russian and Soviet Studies, that have incorporated Ukraine, has had on the understanding of Ukraine in the West and the development of Western policies toward Ukraine, by "experts" who are products of Russian and Soviet studies programs at our best universities.

What is striking is how little Plokhy refers to Putin by name. It is likely that this is because, as Plokhy states, Putin is merely borrowing narratives that go back to Imperial Russia. For example, in the first bullet point Plokhy speaks "Russian Imperial Identity" that "imagines the Russian nation as

consisting of modern-day Russians, Ukrainians, and Belarusians." Putin is simply borrowing this narrative for his, and Russia's own purpose.

Yet the pundits seem to never tire of describing Russia's invasion as "Putin's invasion." Russia is invading Ukraine, and their justification consists of nostrums that go back to Imperial Russia. Putin isn't bombing Ukrainian cities or murdering innocent civilians in Bucha. Russians are guilty; not Putin.

SITUATION UPDATE OF THE GENERAL STAFF OF UKRAINIAN ARMED FORCES JANUARY 6, 2024

During the day of January 8, there were 67x combat engagements. The enemy launched a total of 55x missile and 22x air strikes, 35x MLRS attacks at the positions of Ukrainian troops and various settlements.

Air strikes hit Petropavlivka, Ivanivka, Kyslivka, Tabaivka, Pishchane, Berestove (Kharkiv oblast), Serebryanske forestry (Luhansk oblast), and Novoselivka (Donetsk oblast).

Around 130x settlements in Chernihiv, Sumy, Kharkiv, Luhansk, Donetsk, Zaporizhzhia, Dnipropetrovsk, Kherson, and Mykolaiv oblasts came under artillery fire.

Khortytsia operational-strategic group, Kupyansk axis: Ukrainian defenders repelled 5x enemy attacks near Synkivka (Kharkiv oblast).

Lyman axis: the Ukrainian defenders repelled 2x attacks of the occupiers east of Terny (Donetsk oblast).

Bakhmut axis: the Ukrainian troops repelled 2x adversary attacks in the vicinities of Klishchiivka and Andriivka (Donetsk oblast).

Tavria operational-strategic group, Avdiivka axis: the Ukrainian defenders continue to hold back the enemy who keeps trying to encircle Avdiivka. The Ukrainian soldiers are standing their ground and inflicting major losses on the occupiers. For instance, the Ukrainian Defense Forces repelled 3x attacks of the adversary near Avdiivka, Sjeverne, Tonenke, and 15x more attacks near Pervomaiske and Nevelske (Donetsk oblast) during the day of January 8.

Maryinka axis: the Ukrainian Defense Forces continue to hold back the invaders in the vicinities of Heorhiivka and Novomykhailivka (Donetsk oblast). The Ukrainian troops repelled 12x attacks in that area.

Zaporizhzhia axis: the Ukrainian Defense Forces repelled 7x attacks of the adversary south of Chervone, west of Verbove, and north of Novoprokopivka.

Odesa operational-strategic group, Kherson axis: the Ukrainian defenders continue to expand the bridgehead. The adversary made 12x unsuccessful attempts to assault the positions of the Ukrainian Defense Forces during the day of January 8.

The Ukrainian Air Defense forces and means destroyed 18x Kh-101 / Kh-555 / Kh-55 guided missiles.

The Ukrainian missile troops hit 2x ammunition depots of the russian invaders.

 According to detailed information, a 63-year-old man and a 62-yearold woman were unblocked from under the rubble. Another 88-yearold man was given first aid.

- Within the current Ukrainian legislation, it is impossible to impose any financial restrictions on men who evade mobilization.
- This was stated by the deputy head of the NBU, Kateryna Rozhkova.
- According to her, any information that is in the banks and concerns each specific person can be disclosed only in extreme cases, mostly by a court decision.

1:42 PM: The enemy's mass missile attack this morning did not have critical consequences for the energy system, "Ukrenergo".

- According to the First Deputy Minister of Defense of Ukraine,
 Lieutenant General Oleksandr Pavlyuk, an assessment of airfields for multi-purpose fighters has already been carried out.
- In addition, complex work is underway in Ukraine to prepare infrastructure protection, in particular by means of air defense.
- "I note that training on the territory of Ukraine takes place in conditions of constant use of airfield infrastructure, engineers and flight personnel to perform combat missions. And we are doing everything to simultaneously beat the enemy, protect our own capabilities and acquire new ones," Pavlyuk emphasized.

3:01 PM: "Ukrainian team" collected heating kits for 100 battalions - another party went to the front

- The "Ukrainian team" handed over a thousand individual heating kits to the fighters of the 130th and 204th battalions of the Teroborona of Kyiv, who are currently holding the front in the east.
- In general, thanks to the support of "Blyskavka" readers in particular, almost 100 battalions will be heated. Warm kits for 50,000 defenders have already been collected, reports "Ukrainian Team".

3:20 PM: Volodymyr Zelenskyy held a telephone conversation with the Emir of Kuwait, Sheikh Meshal Al-Ahmad Al-Jaber Al-Sabah.

 "_Invited Kuwait to send a representative to the next meeting of advisers in Davos and to participate in the preparation of the upcoming Global Peace Summit_," the president writes. 3:31 PM: Since the beginning of the full-scale war, Russia has damaged 1,501 medical facilities in Ukraine, and completely destroyed 195

- Currently, 474 medical facilities have been fully restored, and 383 facilities have been partially rebuilt or are in the process of being restored.
- The Ministry of Health noted that medical facilities in Kharkiv Oblast, Donetsk Oblast, Mykolaiv Oblast, Kyiv Oblast, Chernihiv Oblast, Dnipro Oblast, Kherson Oblast and Zaporizhzhia suffered the greatest losses due to Russian shelling and bombing. At the same time, it is currently impossible to obtain complete information about Luhansk Oblast.
- Also, due to the armed aggression of the Russian Federation, 103 emergency medical aid vehicles were damaged, 125 such vehicles were captured by the enemy, and 253 vehicles were destroyed.

4:53 PM: Hackers are sending messages with malicious software to servicemen of the Armed Forces under the guise of recruiting for the 3rd OSHBr and the IDF, State Special Communications.

- Suspicious activity was detected by specialists of the American-Japanese company Trendmicro at the end of December 2023.
- "_The malicious messages contain archive files, the contents of which will lead to the infection of the computer with the REMCOSRAT and REVERSESSH malware_," the message reads.

5:42 PM: Volodymyr Zelenskyi had a telephone conversation with the King of Bahrain, Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa.

- This is the first conversation with the leader of Bahrain in the entire history of bilateral relations.
- The leaders of the countries discussed issues of bilateral cooperation, global food security and support for the Peace Formula.

6:03 PM: Ukrenergo urges economical consumption of electricity.

- Today, between 13:00 and 14:00, the level of electricity consumption exceeded the corresponding indicator of the previous working day by 13.4%.
- The reason is the beginning of the working week and a significant increase in cooling in all regions of Ukraine. In addition, in the southern region, the power supply to consumers who were cut off due to bad weather is gradually being restored.

7:07 PM: The Cabinet of Ministers has canceled the moratorium on power outages and charging penalties for arrears for housing and communal services.

- This is stated in the relevant government resolution.
- At the same time, the moratorium will continue to operate in the territories where hostilities are taking place.

7:18 PM: The GUR of the Ministry of Defense of Ukraine received 100 gigabytes of classified data from the Russian enterprise Special Technology Center LLC ("STC").

- Its facilities produce military equipment and machinery, in particular the "Orlan" UAV of various modifications and a number of means of radio-electronic warfare and intelligence.
- According to preliminary estimates, the value of the obtained data may amount to 1.5 billion dollars.

7:45 PM: Summary of the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine as of 18:00 on January 8:

- During the day 55 combat clashes took place.
- In the Marinsky direction _Defence forces continue to hold back the enemy near Novomykhailivka_ of the Donetsk region.

8:31 PM: The Air Force reports the threat of using ballistic weapons in the Sumy and Poltava regions.

9:00 PM: The President of Ukraine held a telephone conversation with the Emir of Qatar, Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad al-Thani.

• "[...] _He noted Qatar's contribution of \$20 million to the Grain from Ukraine initiative and assured that Ukraine, despite Russia's attempts to disrupt peaceful navigation through the Black Sea, will continue to be a guarantor of global food security," Zelenskyy wrote.

9:27 PM: Volodymyr Zelenskyy approved the composition of the delegation to participate in negotiations on security guarantees.

- The delegation will participate in negotiations on the development and preparation of bilateral and multilateral international agreements between Ukraine and other states.
- The relevant order is published on the official website of the president.

10:43 PM: Ukraine expects more news about detentions and criminal cases related to schemes in the Ministry of Defense, Defense Minister Rustem Umyerov said.

• "The internal audit of the Ministry of Defense and the updated General Inspection of the Ministry of Defense were able to fully function. They have already discovered many violations - in the last 4 months, more than 10 billion (hryvnias - ed.) of violations that were committed earlier. We respond strictly to all cases,"__ - he assured.

10:49 PM: Air Force reports missile threat in alert areas.

• Poltava, Kirovohrad, Mykolaiv, Zaporizhzhya, Kherson, Odesa, and Sumy regions - the threat of using ballistic weapons.

11:55 PM: A number of "problematic" norms were found in the draft law on mobilization.

• This was announced by the head of the committee on anti-corruption policy Anastasia Radina.

"The committee did identify a number of problematic norms that could lead to corruption risks. However, the Ministry of Defense agreed with the comments made. Together with the profile committee, the committee on the health of the nation and other colleagues, we are already working on changing procedures and approaches." _ - she wrote on Facebook.

1:50 PM: Russia is reviving Stalin-era military structures, British intelligence.

- At the end of 2023, some Russian politicians declared the need to restore the Soviet counter-intelligence unit "SMERSH" in the Russian Federation. This unit was founded by Stalin, it existed in 1941-1946.
- At the same time, at the beginning of January 2024, an image of Russian operatives wearing the patches of this organization appeared in open sources.

x2:47 PM: An explosion occurred on the railway tracks in Nizhny Tagil, — rosZMI.

• Previously - detonated an explosive device. Information about victims and destruction is being clarified.

9:54 PM: The Ministry of Defense of the Russian Federation announced the shooting down of ten rockets on the approach to Belgorod, allegedly launched by Ukraine.

10:20 PM: Russia most often launches missiles at Ukraine from the Caspian Sea due to fears that they may fall on the territory of the Russian Federation.

 "Sometimes missiles lose their radar link to their target, selfdestructors are triggered, sometimes they just fall in a different place than planned. That is why Volgodonsk and the Caspian Sea region are the most frequent places from where the Russians launch missiles," said Yuriy, the spokesman of the Air Force of the Armed Forces of Ukraine Ignat on the air of the telethon.
