Looking back, I have concluded that it's impossible to understand that is happening in Ukraine today, in terms of Ukraine's response to Russia's latest invasion, without understanding what happened during Euromaidan. Hopefully the book will add to people's understanding of this extraordinary period.

In writing the book, I was interested in learning about how the Euromaidan Revolution was managed, especially its leadership.

From my research and extensive interviews, I concluded that the leadership of Euromaidan was not what either Western experts or the Russians expected, or the kind of leadership one might learn at business school. As a result, there was continual misunderstanding between the protestors, and those in the West and Russia whom they believed constituted the leadership.

#### Among other things the book contains:

- Extensive interviews with those involved in various aspects of Euromaidan, including:
  - Those responsible for food service and distribution
  - The design and placing of the barricades that protected Independence Square from the Interior Ministry police, known as the "Berkut"
  - The person who established the initial first-aid station on Independence Square, and who later was responsible for managing and operating first-aid stations and makeshift hospitals located throughout Central Kyiv
  - A leader of one of the volunteer battalions
  - A member of "AutoMaidan"
  - The leadership of organizations located outside of Kyiv that provided logistical support and money, to support the protests in Independence Square, without which Euromaidan might have turned out differently.
- Also included is an extensive collection of YouTube videos, that appear in footnotes. covering the protests and the fighting. Some of the videos are very hard to watch. Included are:

  - Video of a lecture given by my wife, Larysa, on
     December 12, 2013, on Independence Square sponsored

- Videos of the tragic events on Institutska Street, that took place on February 20, 2014
- Security camera footage from Yanukovich's estate,
   Mezhihirya taken on February 18, 2014, showing movers moving Yanukovich's personal effects, 4 days before his actual departure.
- My own observations and stories from being in Kyiv throughout Euromaidan.

I have decided to withhold the names of those private individuals whom I interviewed, some of whom are now fighting in the Army. Other than this the book, and emails contained therein, are as I first wrote them.

#### Talk by Sir Richard Barrons at the Lucerne Dialogue

Sir Richard Barrons is a retired general in the British Army. If you don't have time to watch his <u>entire speech</u>, which is well-worth watching, then go to the 17<sup>th</sup> minute where he talks about the War in Ukraine, and the choices that Ukraine's Western supporters must make. #### Here is what Gen. Barrons said:

- "The War in Ukraine is about your interests and your security."
- "Right now, there are Ukrainian soldiers sitting in trenches where they will be all Winter, with not enough ammunition, and equipment, and training."
- "The only way Ukraine wins is if we mobilize our industry and our will behind that."
- "And do not tell me that it's unaffordable."
- "We have an economy of \$15 trillion/year, and I can lead the Ukrainian Army to victory at \$75 billion/year for two or three years (The Biden Administration's budget request for Ukraine is around \$60 billion, for Fiscal Year 2024).
- "This is not about affordability; this is about choice, and competence."

- "Isn't it a bargain if we can defeat Russia's objections to you, where we only spend money but we do not spend children."
- "The Bargain of the Century."

#### News From the Battlefield

It is already raining in southern Ukraine, what will likely melt all the snow and turn everything into mud. Currently it is 47F in Kherson City (+7C). Low visibility will adversely affect the use of drones, for both sides.

According to the "Latest Denys," at 2:25 into his video Denys said that Russian forces are retreating from positions north of Avdiivka. Denys furtherreports that the estimates of Russian casualties provided by British intelligence closely matches Ukrainian estimates. Yesterday Ukraine estimated 860 Russian casualties, most of them coming from the fighting around Avdiivka.

"Reporting From Ukraine" covers the Dnipro Crossings, primarily around Krinky, including a mutiny, 2:35 into his video, where Russian soldiers refused to fight unless their colonel led the attack, from the front. At 4:20 into the video, Reporting from Ukraine states that if Ukrainians advance 1 more kilometer that they will cut the Russian supply road that they rely on for resupply.

### **Tuesday, November 28**

12:20 AM: Blocking the border: the Polish government called on Ukraine to cancel registration in the e-queue for empty trucks.

- The Minister of Infrastructure of Poland Andrzej Adamczyk appealed to the Deputy Prime Minister Oleksandr Kubrakov with a request to cancel the mandatory registration in the "eCherga" system of vehicles returning from Ukraine to the EU without cargo at at least two checkpoints Zosyn - Ustylug and Nyzhankovychi - Malhovice.
- It is noted that the introduction of the electronic queue significantly increased the waiting time at the border for empty Polish trucks, which affected the competitiveness of the companies that own them.
- The ministry also asked the European Commission to create a
  joint committee and analyze how "transport visa-free" affects
  the transport market to the EU. The cancellation of this
  agreement is a key demand of the protesters.

8:00 AM: The US Congress will approve more than \$60 billion in additional aid to Ukraine by Christmas, House Speaker Johnson said.

8:00 AM: Macron discussed the situation at the Zaporizhia NPP with the head of the IAEA.

## Monday, November 27

2:16 PM: In October, some traders started importing Russian gas to the Czech Republic, which had stopped coming to the country since the beginning of this year, Czech Minister of Industry and Trade Jozef Sikela said.

2:16 PM: Turkey is preparing for its first flight a fighter jet developed by KAAN, NTV.

2:16 PM: NATO allies will agree on recommendations for reforms that Ukraine needs to implement to be ready for membership in the Alliance, Secretary General Jens Stoltenberg said.

3:15 PM: President of Ukraine Volodymyr Zelenskyi became the most influential person in Europe in 2023 according to Politico.

• The publication notes that the ranking of the most influential people of 2024 will be announced on November 28.

3:31 PM: Ukraine will become a member of NATO after the end of the war and reforms, - Stoltenberg

- "Allies agree that Ukraine will become a member of NATO. At the [Ukraine-NATO] meeting, we will agree on recommendations for Ukrainians... regarding reforms, as we continue to support Kyiv on this path to NATO membership," said the Secretary General of the Alliance.
- However, all allies still agree that full membership remains impossible in the midst of war, even if Ukraine and NATO continue to move closer together, he added. Stoltenberg also called on Turkey and Hungary to complete the ratification of Sweden's application to join NATO.

6:11 PM: Polish protesters have begun a 24-hour blockade of the Medyka-Sheghini checkpoint, which will last until January 3, protestor representative Roman Kodruw said.

- He noted that voices are heard from the Ukrainian side of the border that Polish protesters are blocking the passage of humanitarian aid to Ukraine.
- Kodruv called this false, but he did not rule out that if such accusations continue, then the protesters really will not let any trucks through.

6:32 PM: The Czech Republic seeks to continue importing Russian steel as an exception to EU sanctions against the Russian Federation.

• The Czech company Vítkovice Steel requests an extension of the exemption from the ban on the import of Russian steel until 2028. Thick sheets are made of steel from the Russian company NLMK. If the exception no longer applies, it could cause a crisis in the Czech construction or automotive industry, Vítkovice Steel spokeswoman Jana Dronska said.  "Suppliers from China are not producing gates (ed. - steel sheets) of the right quality, and to some extent there is also a lot of unreliability on the supply side," Sikela said, adding that he is looking for other solutions, but there are no good ones now.

7:08 PM: Germany provides more than 300 million euros to help Ukraine in the energy sector.

• This was announced by the German Ambassador Martin Jaeger.

8:02 PM: Duda took the oath of the new Moravetsky government. It must be approved by the Seimas.

• He supported the fact that a significant part of the positions in it will be held by women and young people will join the government. Moravetskyi will have two weeks to get a vote of confidence for the government from the Diet.

8:17 PM: Volodymyr Zelenskyi held an important conversation with Ursula von der Leyen ahead of the European Council meeting in December.

- The President assured that Ukraine will implement all recommendations before the December meeting of the European Council, including those related to the rights of national minorities and strengthening of anti-corruption institutions.
- Zelensky assured Ursula von der Leyen that Ukraine will implement all the recommendations of the European Commission before the meeting of the European Council.
- He also informed about the draft laws passed in the first reading, which are aimed at further strengthening the anticorruption infrastructure.
- In addition, the President of Ukraine said that the best signal of permanent support for Ukraine from the European Union would be the approval of a multi-year aid program in the

amount of 50 billion euros. And the decision to start negotiations on Ukraine's membership in the EU, he added, "will become a powerful motivation for Ukrainians who have been fighting for their freedom and common democratic values for almost two years."

9:03 PM: The Polish government reacted to the blockade of the border with Ukraine.

- The Polish Ministry of Infrastructure noted that one of the reasons for the protest of Polish carriers is the electronic queue for trucks returning to the EU without cargo, which was introduced by Ukraine.
- The Ministry calls for canceling mandatory registration of trucks in the electronic queue at at least two checkpoints.

10:00 PM: 16 former prisoners from Ukraine are stuck on the border of the Russian Federation and Georgia.

- "Several people there are Crimeans, they were in prison before the annexation, and then they were transferred to Kherson.
   They have documents in their hands: a certificate of release and a paper confirming their identity," the volunteers said.
- The men live in the neutral zone at the Daryali checkpoint. Some of them are in the basement, where there is no heating.
- Volunteers say that the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Ukraine and the Embassy of Ukraine in Georgia are aware of the situation. According to them, the organization's partners provide legal assistance to Ukrainians.

10:45 PM: Until the end of active hostilities in Ukraine, its full membership in NATO is impossible, — NATO Secretary General Stoltenberg.

 He noted that it is still too early to say what decision will be made at the Washington summit regarding Ukraine.  \_"All allies agree that full membership is impossible during a war, but of course we will continue to look for ways to bring Ukraine and NATO closer together," - quoted him by The Guardian.

11:17 PM: German customs officials block all Polish trucks and cars at the German-Polish border.

 A video of a large convoy of Polish cars was published on Instagram by an eyewitness - Ukrainian transporter Serhiy Vladi.

11:50 PM: The PACE Bureau created a special committee on the situation of children in Ukraine.

 The first meeting of the committee will be held on December 15 in Paris, said Yevgenia Kravchuk, deputy head of the Verkhovna Rada Committee on Humanitarian and Information Policy, member of the Ukrainian delegation to PACE.

11:55 PM: Speaker of the US House of Representatives Mike Johnson said that the issue of aid to Ukraine is a priority in the work of the US Congress.

 \_"We cannot allow Putin to march through Europe. We understand the need to provide assistance to Ukraine," he said during a conversation with journalists.

#### **NATIONAL**

7:00 AM: The occupiers began storming Avdiivka from two more directions, - the head of the MBA.

- It became even more difficult in the Avdiyiv direction. The intensity of hostilities on the part of the enemy has been increasing for some time, and there is already an understanding that this is really the third wave. The Russians additionally opened two more directions, from which they began to conduct active assault actions from the side of Donetsk, through Spartak, and the so-called promka. The enemy is trying to storm the city from all directions. The invaders use a lot of barrel and rocket artillery. Despite the weather conditions, the enemy uses a lot of aviation.
- According to the head of the Avdiyiv city military administration, fierce battles continue in the area of the industrial zone, which do not subside day or night.

7:25 AM Summary of the General Staff as of 06:00 November 28: \*

 During the day of November 27, there were 84x combat engagements. The enemy launched a total of 1x missile and 8x air strikes, 20x MLRS attacks at the positions of Ukrainian troops and various settlements. During the day of November 28, russian occupants launched 1x air strike on Ukraine, using 1x Shahed-136/131 attack UAVs. The enemy drone was destroyed. Unfortunately, the russian terrorist attacks have wounded civilians. Private residential buildings and other civilian infrastructure were destroyed or damaged.

- Air strikes hit Stepova Novoselivka (Kharkiv oblast),
   Novomykhailivka, Kostyantynivka, Novoukrainka (Donetsk oblast).
- More than 130x settlements in Chernihiv, Sumy, Kharkiv, Luhansk, Donetsk, Zaporizhzhia, Dnipropetrovsk, and Kherson oblasts came under artillery fire.
- The Ukrainian missile troops hit 1x command post and 3x concentrations of personnel, weapons, and military equipment of the russian invaders.

#### Khortytsia operational-strategic group

**Kupyansk axis**: the enemy conducted unsuccessful assault operations in the vicinities of Synkivka and Petropavlivka (Kharkiv oblast), where the Ukrainian Defense Forces repelled 3x attacks.

**Lyman axis**: the enemy conducted assault operations in the vicinities of Stelmakhivka, Serebryanske forestry (Luhansk oblast), Terny, Yampolivka, and Torske (Donetsk oblast). The Ukrainian soldiers repelled 12x attacks in that area.

**Bakhmut axis**: the Ukrainian troops defenders repelled 28x attacks of the adversary near Bohdanivka, Ivanivske, Klishchiivka, and Andriivka (Donetsk oblast). The Ukrainian Defense Forces continue assault operations south of Bakhmut (Donetsk oblast), inflict losses in manpower and equipment on the enemy, and consolidate their new positions.

## Tavria operational-strategic group

Avdiivka axis: the enemy keeps trying to encircle Avdiivka. The

Ukrainian soldiers are standing their ground and inflicting major losses on the occupiers. The adversary's offensive actions were unsuccessful east of Novobakhmutivka, northeast of Berdychi, Avdiivka, Opytne, Sjeverne, and south of Tonenke (Donetsk oblast), where the Ukrainian Defense Forces repelled 23x attacks.

Maryinka axis: with the air support, the invaders conducted unsuccessful assault operations in the vicinities of Maryinka and Novomykhailivka (Donetsk oblast). The Ukrainian Forces repelled 9x attacks in that area.

**Shakhtarske axis**: the adversary did not conduct any offensive (assault) operations.

**Zaporizhzhia axis**: the occupiers made 3x unsuccessful attempts to regain the lost ground near Robotyne and Novoprokopivka (Zaporizhzhia oblast).

Odesa operational-strategic group, Kherson axis: the Ukrainian troops maintain their positions held on the left bank of the Dnipro River, conduct counter-battery fire, as they strike behind the enemy lines.

8:33 AM: The higher anti-corruption court sent People's Deputy from the group "For the Future" Serhiy Labazyuk to the pre-trial detention center for two months, - NABU press service.

- He will be able to leave if he pays a deposit of 40 million 260 thousand hryvnias.
- According to the investigation, the People's Deputy, in collusion with the director of the joint-stock company, tried to bribe the Minister of Community Development, Oleksandr Kubrakov, and the head of the State Agency for Reconstruction and Development of Infrastructure, Mustafa Nayem.

8:51 AM: 10 people died in Ukraine due to bad weather. Another 23 people, including children, were injured.

 This was announced by the Minister of Internal Affairs of Ukraine Ihor Klymenko. 10:04 AM: The wife of the head of the Main Directorate of Intelligence, Marianna Budanova, was poisoned with heavy metals, the media reported with reference to intelligence sources.

- After a prolonged deterioration of her health, she was hospitalized. The course of treatment is now ending.
- \_"These substances are not used in any way in everyday life and military affairs. Their presence may indicate a purposeful attempt to poison a specific person," the intelligence agency said.

10:44 AM: This night, air defense forces destroyed an attack UAV of the "Shahed" type, and in the morning - a reconnaissance UAV of operational-tactical level "Orlan-10", Air Forces of the ZSU.

 Also, at night, the Russians used an air-to-air missile in the eastern direction, and around 9:00 a.m. they struck
 Zaporizhzhia with a ballistic missile (presumably "Iskander-M").

#### Monday, November 27

12:26 PM: All of Ukraine is a missile hazard! — Air Force of the Armed Forces of Ukraine.

- The takeoff of the MiG-31K from Mozdok airfield was recorded.
- The whole of Ukraine was shut down by the alarm for three hours.

12:37 PM: Ukraine will not sign a settlement agreement with the Russian Federation without reparations, Deputy Minister of Justice Iryna Mudra said.

- \_"Ukraine will never do this. And the world will not go away, because someone has to pay these reparations. If not Russia, then who?" - added Iryna Mudra.
- 2:16 PM: "Scythian gold" was returned after ten years of legal proceedings in the Netherlands, website of the National History Museum of Ukraine.

3:55 PM: In Ukraine, 12 highways in the Mykolaiv (8), Odesa (3) and

Kirovohrad (1) regions remain closed due to bad weather.

- This is reported by the State Emergency Service.
- Rescuers towed 1,130 vehicles and removed 164 trees while eliminating the consequences of snowfall. 1215 people and 330 pieces of equipment are involved in the works.

5:02 PM: Ukrenergo will receive €24.5 million from Germany to strengthen the Ukrainian energy system.

 This was announced by the chairman of the board of Ukrenergo, Volodymyr Kudrytskyi.

5:33 PM: The Verkhovna Rada Committee on National Security did not demand from Zaluzhny the plan that Bezugla spoke about, - Secretary of the Verkhovna Rada Committee on National Security and Defense, People's Deputy Roman Kostenko.

6:26 PM: Volodymyr Zelenskyy addressed the International Maritime Organization.

 "\_Informed that Ukraine succeeded and that Russia as a terrorist state has no place in international organizations, and even more so in its governing bodies, which are supposed to take care of international security\_," the president wrote.

6:41 PM: "Ukrzaliznytsia" will launch a new direct train #143/146 Vienna - Chop - Vienna from December 10.

• It will be connected to convenient transfers at the Chop station.

7:44 PM Summary of the General Staff as of 18:00 on November 27:

- During the day, 79 combat clashes took place. The enemy launched 1 missile and 3 air strikes, fired 13 anti-aircraft missiles at the positions of our troops and populated areas.
- The defense forces will continue to hold positions on the left bank of the Dnieper in the Kherson region. They continue to inflict fire damage on the occupiers.

 Units of the missile forces inflicted damage \_on areas of concentration of personnel, weapons and military equipment\_ of the enemy.

7:47 PM: The Ministry of Defense and the US Embassy have agreed to strengthen joint arms control.

- "Now the Ministry of Defense will provide additional transparency regarding the storage and use of foreign weapons. Certain types of missiles, launchers, UAVs and night vision devices transferred by American partners require careful control and special storage conditions," the message said.
- According to the agreement, the officials of the Armed Forces undergo training on the use of special electronic devices and conduct inventories at arsenals, bases, and warehouses throughout Ukraine. From now on, the Ministry of Defense will carry out the necessary supervision of the availability, accounting and compliance with the proper storage conditions with foreign partners.

9:33 PM: In May, Patriot shot down five Russian aircraft over the Bryansk region, said the spokesman of the Air Force of the Ukrainian Armed Forces Ignat

• One Su-34 fighter, one Su-35, two Mi-8MTPR-1 helicopters and one Mi-8 were shot down. Also, Patriot shot down another Su-35, but already over the Black Sea.

9:40 PM: The operation of the GUR Ministry of Defense against the Russian plant producing Kh-59 missiles was successful. Serhiy Zgurets column.

- These are systematic and methodical strikes with the use of kamikaze drones, which can, if not completely disrupt, then really slow down the pace of work of the Russian enterprise that assembles and manufactures Kh-59 missiles.
- The front line

- O Despite the snow and cooling, the areas around Avdiyivka and Bakhmut remain the hottest. Although the situation on the entire front, with a length of more than 1,000 km, remains extremely difficult in every sector. Heavy fighting is currently going on around Bakhmut. The enemy there is increasing the pressure on our positions by constant attacks along the entire contact line.
- Andrii Babichev, a serviceman of the 93rd OMBr "Holodny Yar" from Bakhmut, said that the enemy was pressing heavily on Khromovo in the direction of Bohdanivka. The enemy is trying to align his defense line, because the Defense Forces bypassed Bakhmut from the left side, from the south. By now, the occupiers have practically leveled their defense line, but they still want to go through. The second red dot is Klishchiivka.

9:52 PM: Parliament registered a resolution on the dismissal of Maryana Bezuglai from the position of deputy head of the Committee on National Security, Defense and Intelligence 10:20 PM: Three more regional gas companies came under state control

- The gas distribution enterprises JSC "Rivnegaz", JSC
   "Chernivtsigaz" and JSC "Zaporizhgaz" came under the control of the state and will work as part of JSC "Naftogaz of Ukraine".
- Personal accounts, tariffs and payment details for consumers from Rivne, Chernivtsi and Zaporizhzhia regions remain unchanged.

10:25 PM: Due to bad weather, 5 people died in Odesa region, almost 1,500 settlements in 17 regions were cut off, — President Zelenskyi.

- Currently, the map is available for Kyiv residents. Next, they will expand to other large cities of Ukraine.

4:46 PM: In Kyiv, the Ternopil volunteer was detained by the police and threatened to serve a summons.

- Volunteer Alya Shirshina, who was returning from the front from her husband, was detained by the police in Kyiv 10 minutes after midnight. The woman tried to call a taxi, but the police decided to take her to the station.
- The man detained by the Kyiv police is the main character of the photo with Timothy Snyder's book in the trench. At one time, this photo flew around the world and became viral.

5:16 PM: Kernes' son said that officials of the Kharkiv City Council falsified documents signed by the deceased mayor.

- Kyrylo Kernes stated that he had access to his father's medical records at the "Charite" clinic, which relate to his state of health. According to him, the documentation can prove that all decisions that were approved on behalf of Kernes were made without his participation.
- According to Kernes, from the moment the mayor of Kharkiv was taken to the clinic, that is, on September 16, 2020, officials of the Kharkiv City Council "made a series of falsifications of the decisions of the mayor", who was Gennady Kernes at that time.

• \_"A 63-year-old man died. Two women, aged 65 and 63, were injured. There may be people under the rubble",\_ - head of Dnipropetrovsk OVA Serhiy Lysak.

### Monday, November 27

7:15 PM: The Russian Federation shelled Nikopol region with heavy artillery: a woman was injured; residential buildings were damaged.

- Serhii Lysak, the head of the State Administration, informed that the administrative building, the lyceum, the church, and the sports club were damaged as a result of the shelling. Also, 7 apartment buildings and 14 private houses were damaged, one farm building was destroyed and 12 were mutilated.
- Lysak also stated that the car, power line and gas pipe were gutted.


