Looking back, I have concluded that it's impossible to understand that is happening in Ukraine today, in terms of Ukraine's response to Russia's latest invasion, without understanding what happened during Euromaidan. Hopefully the book will add to people's understanding of this extraordinary period.

In writing the book, I was interested in learning about how the Euromaidan Revolution was managed, especially its leadership.

From my research and extensive interviews, I concluded that the leadership of Euromaidan was not what either Western experts or the Russians expected, or the kind of leadership one might learn at business school. As a result, there was continual misunderstanding between the protestors, and those in the West and Russia whom they believed constituted the leadership.

Among other things the book contains:

- Extensive interviews with those involved in various aspects of Euromaidan, including:
  - $\circ$  Those responsible for food service and distribution
  - The design and placing of the barricades that protected Independence Square from the Interior Ministry police, known as the "Berkut"
  - The person who established the initial first-aid station on Independence Square, and who later was responsible for managing and operating first-aid stations and makeshift hospitals located throughout Central Kyiv
  - A leader of one of the volunteer battalions
  - A member of "AutoMaidan"
  - The leadership of organizations located outside of Kyiv that provided logistical support and money, to support the protests in Independence Square, without which Euromaidan might have turned out differently.
- Also included is an extensive collection of YouTube videos, that appear in footnotes. covering the protests and the fighting. Some of the videos are very hard to watch. Included are:
  - Video of a presentation in Washington, DC by Yulia Tymoshenko's legal team, rebutting the claims made by Yanukovich's legal team of graft that took place when Tymoshenko was Prime Minister of Ukraine. The video amounts to dueling American "white shoe" law firms.
  - Video of a lecture given by my wife, Larysa, on
     December 12, 2013, on Independence Square sponsored
     by the Open University of Ukraine

- Videos of the tragic events on Institutska Street, that took place on February 20, 2014
- Security camera footage from Yanukovich's estate, Mezhihirya taken on February 18, 2014, showing movers moving Yanukovich's personal effects, 4 days before his actual departure.
- My own observations and stories from being in Kyiv throughout Euromaidan.

I have decided to withhold the names of those private individuals whom I interviewed, some of whom are now fighting in the Army. Other than this the book, and emails contained therein, are as I first wrote them.

I'm not sure that there's a shovel big enough, for opponents of supporting Ukraine, like Sen. J.D. Vance (R-Ohio), Rep. Jim Jordan (R-Ohio), Sen. Josh Hawley (R-Missouri), and Rep. Matt Gaetz (R-Florida), to shovel their way out.

The article states that approximately 90% of the money that U.S. taxpayers have spent on military assistance to Ukraine stays in the U.S., and goes to private companies, many of which are located in congressional districts represented by some of the most vocal opponents of military support to Ukraine. The money also goes to employees of these companies, in the form of salaries. Most of this money is spent by employees in the same congressional districts.

They, along with their employers, pay federal, state and local taxes that, at least at the federal level, indirectly goes back to defraying the budget outlays that go to supporting Ukraine.

Opponents of supporting Ukraine claim that their opposition is based on money going to Ukraine, instead of staying in the U.S. This article blows a big hole in their argument for withholding support to Ukraine.

For those discussing how long the war will last, it's worth remembering that the war is approaching its 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. It started on Feb. 28, 2014, when Russia invaded Crimea.

The article mentions the possibility that the loss of assets controlled by the major oligarchs are being transferred to those around Pres. Zelenskyy. This is exactly what happened in the mid-1970s in the Philippines, when former Pres. Ferdinand Marcos declared Martial Law. I was working in the Philippines at the time. Here is one account of what happened to the Lopez Family, at the time the richest family in the Philippines. I may be the only person on the planet who has spent significant time in both the Philippines and Ukraine, and I can see some of the parallels.

The article doesn't mention much of the small-time graft and corruption, the type that affects ordinary Ukrainians. In my book about Euromaidan, that I'm making available (you can purchase the book by clicking on the link <u>HERE</u>), in the book I include a number of examples of small-time graft. One that I didn't include was the ZhEK system, responsible for managing many multi-family residential buildings, such as the building we live in. I once met with the former

Head of the IMF in Ukraine. I mentioned a few examples to him. He hadn't heard of any of them, likely because they're focused on the big issues, like the judiciary or the retail gas distribution system owned by Dmytro Firtash whose name, interestingly, the article does not mention.

8:01 AM: Former US Secretary of State Henry Kissinger has died. He was 100 years old, — Reuters.

8:01 AM: Hamas militants are willing to release male hostages captured in Israel in exchange for the release of several "high-ranking Palestinians" from Israeli prisons, WSJ.

8:49 AM: A 24-year-old girl was killed in a terrorist attack in Jerusalem, and 8 people were injured, Israeli TV channel i24.

• The Israeli Ministry of Foreign Affairs publishes a video from the scene of the events, on which numerous shots can be heard near the entrance to the city at the bus stop. Two suspects were neutralized on the spot.

4:04 PM: Slovakia will extend the ban on the import of agricultural products from Ukraine and tighten transit rules, — Novinky.

4:04 PM: Ministers of transport of European Union countries will discuss the blockade of the Polish-Ukrainian border, — RMF FM.

- Uzhgorod" checkpoint from December 1.






#### **United States of America Ukraine Security Assistance**





From the above it should be clear that US military assistance to Ukraine strengthens US military capacity while at the same time providing jobs.

As with any government spending it is not evenly distributed geographically, in terms of benefits to classes of people, others. Below is a distribution map of Republican and Democrat held state legislatures:



A visual reflection points to greater benefits heading to Republican held states than Democrat ones. Logically there should be greater Republican support for military assistance to Ukraine, but there isn't.

#### Thursday, November 30

7:35 AM: Summary of the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine as of 06:00 on November 30:

- During the day of November 29, there were 101x combat engagements. The enemy launched a total of 11x missile and 28x air strikes, 43x MLRS attacks at the positions of Ukrainian troops and various settlements.
- During the day of November 29, the russian federation attacked Ukraine's civilian infrastructure yet again with 1x Kh-31 guided cruise missile and 2x S-300 anti-aircraft missiles. Also, last night, the occupants launched another strike on Ukraine, using 8x S-300 anti-aircraft guided missiles and 20x Shahed-136/131 attack UAVs. The Ukrainian air defense destroyed 14x attack UAVs. Private houses, three-story residential building in the city of Myrnohrad (Donetsk oblast), and other civilian infrastructure were destroyed or damaged.
- Air strikes hit Synkivka, Petropavlivka, Kupyansk, Kurylivka (Kharkiv oblast), Novomykhailivka, Avdiivka, and Novoukrainka (Donetsk oblast).
- More than 110x settlements in Sumy, Kharkiv, Luhansk, Donetsk, Zaporizhzhia, Dnipropetrovsk, Kherson, and Mykolaiv oblasts came under artillery fire.
- During the day of November 29, Ukrainian Air Force launched 2x air strikes on the concentrations of troops, weapons, and military equipment, and 2x air strikes on the anti-aircraft missile systems of the adversary.

 The Ukrainian missile troops hit 3x command posts, 2x ammunition depots, and 2x concentrations of troops, weapons and military equipment of the russian invaders.

# Khortytsia operationalstrategic group

Kupyansk axis: the enemy conducted assault operations near Synkivka, Petropavlivka (Kharkiv oblast), and Stelmakhivka (Luhansk oblast), where the Ukrainian Defense Forces repelled 7x attacks.

Lyman axis: the Ukrainian soldiers repelled 24x adversary attacks in the vicinities of Serebryanske forestry (Luhansk oblast) and east of Terny,

Yampolivka, and Torske (Donetsk oblast).

**Bakhmut axis**: the adversary conducted unsuccessful assault operations near Ivanivske and Andriivka (Donetsk oblast). The Ukrainian defenders repelled 4x attacks in that area. In turn, the Ukrainian Defense Forces continue assault operations south of Bakhmut (Donetsk oblast), inflict losses in manpower and equipment on the enemy, and consolidate their new positions.

## Tavria operational-strategic group

**Avdiivka axis**: with the air support, the occupiers keep trying to encircle Avdiivka. The Ukrainian soldiers are standing their ground as they inflict major losses on the enemy. The adversary's offensive actions were unsuccessful near Stepove, Novokalynove, east of Novobakhmutivka, Avdiivka, south of Tonenke, Sjeverne, and Pervomaiske (Donetsk oblast). The Ukrainian Forces repelled 22x attacks in that area.

Maryinka axis: with the air support, the enemy conducted unsuccessful assault operations in the vicinities of Krasnohorivka and Novomykhailivka (Donetsk oblast). The Ukrainian Defense Forces repelled 11x attacks in that area.

**Shakhtarske axis**: the Ukrainian defenders repelled 3x adversary attacks south of Prechystivka (Donetsk oblast).

**Zaporizhzhia axis**: the occupiers made 5x unsuccessful attempts to regain the lost ground in the vicinity of Robotyne (Zaporizhzhia oblast). Also, the Ukrainian soldiers repelled 9x enemy attacks northwest of Verbove (Zaporizhzhia oblast).

**Odesa operational-strategic group, Kherson axis**: the Ukrainian Defense Forces maintain their positions held on the left bank of the Dnipro River, continue to conduct counter-battery fire, as they strike behind the enemy lines.

11:21 AM: Ukrainian companies produce about 50,000 FPV drones every month, Russians six times more, Forbes.

 In total, there are about 200 manufacturers of drones of various types in Ukraine. They provide only 10-15% of the total needs of the army. FPV drones alone need about 200,000 units per month.

11:43 AM: The last of the main high-voltage lines damaged by the weather has been put into operation. Power supply reliability in the southern region has been restored, - "Ukrenergo".

- In the morning, 191 settlements remain without power due to bad weather.
- In the evening hours from 16:00 to 18:00 there may be a shortage of electricity in the power system.

## Wednesday, November 29

2:13 PM: Volodymyr Zelenskyi held a meeting on liquidation of the

consequences of large-scale bad weather.

 "\_Instructed to speed up works on restoration of electricity supply and increase the number of repair crews and equipment\_", - noted the president.

2:40 PM: Since 1:00 p.m., a shortage of electricity has been recorded in the energy system, Ukrenergo.

- The reason for the shortage is a rapid increase in consumption due to severe weather conditions and the simultaneous inclusion in the network of thousands of consumers from regions affected by bad weather.
- The company urges you to consume electricity sparingly throughout the day until 6:00 p.m.

3:39 PM: Kolomoisky decided to appeal to the European Court of Human Rights over the court's decision to extend his arrest for another two months.

- This is stated in the statement of his lawyer Oleksandr Lysak.
- "[...] \_national courts continue to detain Ihor Valeriyovych in custody without any justified legal purpose, in complete disregard of the requirements of the Convention on Human Rights\_", the lawyer said.

4:25 PM: The SBU reported the suspicion to Russian General Yevgeny Poplavskyi, who led the repression against Ukrainians during the capture of Lyman.

• On his orders, the occupiers kidnapped Ukrainian patriots and subjected them to numerous tortures.

• In addition, facts were documented when the person involved personally participated in punitive actions and torture of civilians.

4:52 PM: In "Diya" you can now get an English-language version of some documents - a foreign passport, a technical passport or a driver's license.

- To do this, you need to update the application, select a document for translation, click on the three dots in the lower right corner of the document and select the translation function.
- Rights and technical data have an international coding used in the EU, USA and Canada.

6:17 PM: The court extended the preventive measure in the form of round-the-clock house arrest to Metropolitan Pavlo Lebidyu of the UOC MP until January 29, — mass media.

7:17 PM: In Ukraine, a register of those convicted of crimes against children on sexual grounds has been formed — it will serve as a safeguard against contact with criminals.

- This is reported by the Prosecutor General's Office.
- Principals of schools and kindergartens, heads of state administrations and heads of local self-government bodies will have access to the register, in particular.

7:33 PM Summary of the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine as of 18:00 on November 29:

- During the day \_73 combat clashes took place\_. The enemy launched 3 missile and 13 air strikes, fired 8 rocket salvo fire systems at the positions of our troops and populated areas.
- Aviation of the Defense Forces \_made 2 strikes\_ on the areas of concentration of personnel, weapons and military equipment and 2 more on the enemy's anti-aircraft missile systems.

• Units of the missile forces \_hit 3 control points, 2 ammunition warehouses\_ and the area where the enemy's personnel, weapons and military equipment are concentrated.

10:57 PM: Ukraine today received emergency aid from Romania and Poland to cover the deficit in the energy system.

11:18 PM: From January 1, 2024, the resolution on simplifying the system of payment of scholarships and social assistance will come into effect, the Ministry of Social Policy reports.

 Students of vocational pre-university and higher education institutions who were in Russian captivity, imprisoned or in any other way deprived of their freedom due to the armed aggression of the Russian Federation against Ukraine, as well as their children, will be able to receive assistance.

8:01 AM: Explosions rang out in Bryansk, Russia, in the evening. It is reported that the "arrival" of a warehouse with "Shaheed" type attack drones was allegedly recorded.

10:50 AM: A new special operation by the SBU: an explosion occurred tonight on the Baikal-Amur highway, namely in the Severomuy tunnel named after Bessolov, which is located in Buryatia.

- In fact, this is the only serious railway connection between the Russian Federation and China. And currently, this route, which Russia uses, including for military supplies, is paralyzed.
- According to our data, 4 explosive devices went off while the freight train was moving. Now the FSB is working on the spot,

5:24 PM: Russian Major General Volodymyr Zavadsky died in Ukraine.

- His death was confirmed by the organization of graduates of the Moscow Higher Combined Arms Command School "Kremlin".
- According to rosZMI, the general blew himself up with a mine. Some wrote that it was eliminated in the area of the village of Krynky on the left bank of the Kherson region.

5:48 PM: Hackers with the help of the SBU hacked the website of the Ministry of Labor and Social Protection of the Russian Federation

- The Ukrainian hacker group "BLACKJACK" hacked the website of the Ministry of Labor and Social Protection of Russia. According to our sources, this operation was carried out together with cyber specialists of the SBU.
- Hackers gained access to a large number of documents: statistics on the so-called "svo", personal data of military personnel, materials of reports to the President of the Russian Federation, information on the number of prostheses. A separate array of information concerns the temporarily occupied Kharkiv and Zaporizhzhia regions and their current "leadership".

- The Security Service will now have many new documents to study.
- After downloading the necessary information, hackers "demolished" more than 100 terabytes of data from the ministry's servers.

9:28 PM: North Korea sent Russia about 2,000 containers of weapons. This is reported by Reuters.

- According to American and South Korean officials, the port of Rason has been visited by Russian ships connected to the military logistics system since August.
- These ships are suspected of military supplies from North Korea to Russia.

9:37 PM: In the temporarily occupied Crimea, the IPTV broadcast was hacked and Volodymyr Zelenskyi's address was launched.
