“General Zaluzhny’s article in The Economist has acted as an information bomb. It caused shock waves that are still reverberating through Ukrainian and international media. The Russians are gleeful. The allies of Ukraine are scratching their heads and are trying to understand what’s going on. The Ukrainians mostly interpret Zaluzhny’s “revelations” according to their personal political preferences.

It is already clear that Head of General Staff has not warned Zelensky about his plans to go public and that the president disagrees with his assertion that the war has reached a stalemate. There is an obvious disconnect between Ukraine’s political

leadership and its top general. This is a very dangerous situation which should not have happened. Especially in a country which is fighting for its very existence. In the wake of the above article Zelensky's haters are often calling General Zaluzhny "an adult in the room". If so, he should have realized that his unprecedented action might cause serious damage to the country for which he serves.

I would like start with the well-known basics. In any normal country generals serve at the pleasure of democratically elected political leaders. Whatever their past achievements, they can be sacked at any moment if they challenge their employer, be it president or prime minister. If they do not support the course chosen by their political leader, they can resign and write books in which they are free to vent their grievances to the public. Openly disagreeing with the respective Supreme Commander during a hot war is definitely a "no-no." And this is exactly what General Zaluzhny has decided to do. Some inevitable questions arise when one tries to analyze his unexpected decision.

First, why the Economist? I have nothing against this publication and have first subscribed to it when still in a business school almost thirty years ago. However, I was shocked that our top general decided to spill his guts to a foreign newspaper instead of talking directly (in Ukrainian) to the nation that he serves.

Second, what warranted it? If it were about specific categories of military equipment needed for current or future operations, Valery Zaluzhny has direct channels of communication with his peers in the US and other NATO countries. According to his own admission, he talks to them on a daily basis. Western generals and their political bosses normally do their best to deliver what can be delivered.

The same goes for his own employer. Leaders in the West probably cringe inwardly every time they are about to meet Zelensky. They know perfectly well what "that little Jew from Ukraine" will be demanding: weapons, weapons and again weapons. He is irritatingly blunt and does not take "no" for an answer. As a result, even weapon systems unimaginable a year before finally get a

go-ahead and are then delivered. Yes, it is a slow and difficult process. But did General Zaluzhny really think that his unauthorized intervention would help?

People might recall that several months ago he aired another “shopping list” which consisted mostly of main battle tanks and APVs. The allies had largely obliged and delivered at least 80% of what was expected from them. Did Zaluzhny put all those “leopards”, “challengers”, “bradleys”, “marders”, “strykers” and SV-90s to good use? No, not really. In fact, his most sensational revelation can be summed up this way: “we’ve reached a stalemate, and now our allies have to cough up yet another grocery list. Or else.”

I should also add, that instead of asking allies for certain items, he might have looked around and asked his own compatriots. For example, in mid-2022 at least one Ukrainian firm started producing inexpensive (around USD 1,200 per one kit) systems for use against kamikaze drones. They are easy to install and use on practically any vehicle and are especially popular among Ukrainian tankmen. According to them, approaching enemy drones crash several dozen meters from their targets. With just a 2 mln dollar investment General Zaluzhny could have immunized most of Ukrainian armor against both Russian “lancets” and Chinese-made FPVs. Instead, the above systems are purchased by volunteers, brigade commanders and tankmen themselves, while our “iron general” laments the absence of the very same systems and insists that the allies should deliver them asap. Or else.

I have observed with a certain fascination as Zelensky haters (they are also, to the very last one of them, huge admirers of “St. Valery”) decided to actually defend uncompromising position of our President after another bomb – Simon Shuster’s article in the Time. Shuster hinted that it is time to make a deal with the Russians. People that I’ve mentioned above promptly called his article “manipulative” and demanded that he is banned from Ukraine forever.

Just a couple of days later, when Zaluzhny’s article has invited

basically the same conclusion, *the very same people* have applauded his “honesty.” Moreover, anti-Zelensky FB pundits are now openly suggesting that it is time to “make peace with Russia, join NATO and get occupied territories back at some point in the future”. I cannot believe my eyes. A political position which goes against the will of at least 80% of Ukrainians and an official tabu is suddenly openly discussed in our social media by people who call themselves “patriots.” And it happened thanks to our glorious military leader – General Zaluzhny. I do not know whether it was his intention. Maybe not. But I cannot deny that his article has done a lot of harm in this respect.

Soldiers at the front should be confused. Their top military commander has just announced that “a stalemate has been reached”. Does it mean that they should refuse an order to storm yet another Russian trench near Verbove or Klishiivka? Aren’t they supposed to rather wait for all those wonder-weapons demanded by Zaluzhny? I cannot see how his article could have improved an already sagging morale of our troops, who, thanks to his brilliant leadership, are beating their heads against fortified Russian defenses.

There is one major point that Zaluzhny made that was indeed worth public attention (both locally and internationally): the issue of “spring chickens” mobilization. It has never been a secret that from the start of this war the Ukrainian state has made a determined effort to first utilize men in their 40s and 50s rather than representatives of the so called “Generation Freedom” – those who were born and raised in independent Ukraine. To the best of my knowledge, *this is the first time in the world’s history of wars* that grandpas have to carry a burden normally reserved for the young and able.

It is yet unclear who first suggested it. At the moment I assume that it is President Zelensky and his close advisors who are personally responsible for this nonsense. General Zaluzhny has a right and a responsibility to demand that this absurd practice is abolished. At the

same time, in his revelations to the Economist he chose to phrase his demand in a very delicate manner – without mentioning the “age issue”. Why? Probably because he has good political instincts and does not want to antagonize young men, their girlfriends and their moms.

In any case, nobody prevented him from raising this issue with the President and his entourage. Zelensky does not eat his generals for breakfast. He is a smart guy who knows his personal limitations. He tends to listen to the professionals and dismisses them only when they do not deliver. Ukraine is a democratic country, and our top brass do not face execution or prison over disagreements with political leaders.

So, why on earth did General Zaluzhny do this? I think the answer is clear: it was a pre-emptive move to secure his position. Or, failing it, to gain additional political capital for his future involvement in politics.

It is no secret that Zelensky has been in bad mood since late summer. I suspect he first started to seriously doubt promises by generals Zaluzhny and Tarnavskiy (Head of “Tavriya” Command responsible for the offensive in the South) about the same time I did – in mid-July. As our offensive crawled into its sixth month, it had become increasingly clear that the President’s patience was running thin. And that the proverbial penny was about to drop, resulting in dismissal of both “St. Valery” and his closest appointees.

There is only one way this situation can be resolved now: Zaluzhny has to go. It does not have to be ugly. Actually, it would be good for the country if he goes quietly and gets all respect and gratitude he deserves. I am sure that the President would rather accept his resignation for, say, medical reasons, give him a bunch of kudos and at some later point even put him in charge of an important but non-critical endeavor. I do hope that Western peers could help in this respect. An unofficial visit, a case of “Glenfiddich” and an honest conversation could do the trick. If, however, “St. Valery” still refuses to take a hint, it will be on him.”

Although some Ukrainian armored personnel carriers have crossed the river, nothing of major consequence will be able to cross until Ukraine establishes bridgeheads. That may not happen until Ukraine develops a defense against the Russian gliding bombs, that gives Russian aviation a standoff capability.

8:05 AM: In Italy, the Scheherazade superyacht arrested last year, which probably belongs to Putin, was launched - FBK.

8:05 AM: At least 45 US troops injured in attacks in Iraq and Syria, NBC News.

8:05 AM: Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu again rejected the idea of a ceasefire in Gaza until Hamas releases the hostages.

9:12 AM: Russia's war against Ukraine remains on the G7 agenda, countries will discuss support for Ukrainian air defense at a summit in Tokyo.

- The Minister of Foreign Affairs of Germany, Annalena Burbok, reported this, writes ZDF.
- "If we "breathe out" of support for Ukraine now, Putin will ruthlessly take advantage of it - with dire consequences for the people of Ukraine and Europe," she said.

11:08 AM: Polish carriers blocking the movement of trucks on the border with Ukraine have not yet conveyed their official demands to any representative of the Ukrainian side.

- This was reported by the Ministry of Reconstruction of Ukraine.
- "From the information that is available from media and social networks, among the demands: cancellation of the "transport visa-free", i.e. return to the system of permits for cargo transportation, separate lanes and separate queues for trucks with EU numbers and empty ones, access to the "Slyah" system", the ministry clarifies.

Monday, November 6

2:52 PM: The German government is still undecided on whether to supply long-range Taurus missiles to Ukraine.

- This was announced by the head of the German Defense Ministry, Boris Pistorius.
- "I don't think that the missiles will become a game changer. ATACMS, which the USA handed over, have a range of 160 km, Taurus - 500 km, this is a completely different system," said Pistorius.

3:25 PM: The French company Cybergun signed a €36 million contract to supply Ukraine with weapons.

- This is stated in the report of the company's press service.

- The agreement provides for the supply of 10,000 assault rifles, 2,000 sniper rifles and 400 grenade launchers. The first serial deliveries are planned to start in six months, and the process itself will last 10 months.

4:39 PM: Polish transporters have started a strike at the border — the movement of trucks at 3 checkpoints is blocked.

- We are talking about the following points: "Yagodin-Dorohusk", "Krakivets-Korchova", "Rava-Ruska-Hrebene".
- "_Protest organizers plan to allow one truck per hour, as well as trucks with cargo of a security and humanitarian nature_" writes DPSU.

5:02 PM: The best way to ensure stability and prosperity for Ukraine in the medium and longer term is EU membership.

- This was announced by the President of the European Commission, Ursula von der Leyen.
- "_To restore Ukraine - Europe is the answer. To further strengthen Ukrainian democracy - Europe is the answer. To protect Ukraine from future intervention - Europe is the answer_" she said during a speech to EU ambassadors.

7:55 PM: Canada handed Ukraine 6 robots for remote demining of territories, — DSNS.

- Thanks to the wireless and wired connection, the robots can work for up to 5 hours and perform a variety of tasks - remotely destroying explosive objects or reconnaissance of the area.

10:24 PM: More than 100 British companies have admitted violating anti-Russian sanctions as it will help reduce government fines, Financial Times.

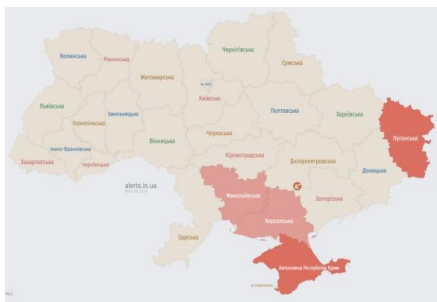
10:24 PM: South Africa recalls diplomats from Israel to assess its relations with the country, — Reuters.

10:24 PM: Biden and Netanyahu discussed the possibility of a humanitarian "pause" in Gaza, writes The Times of Israel.

11:35 PM: Donald Trump rejected Volodymyr Zelenskyi's invitation. He stated this in an interview with the Newsmax TV channel.

- "_I have great respect for President Zelensky, but I think it would be inappropriate to go to Ukraine at this time. The Biden administration is currently dealing with him, and I would not like to create a conflict of interest_".

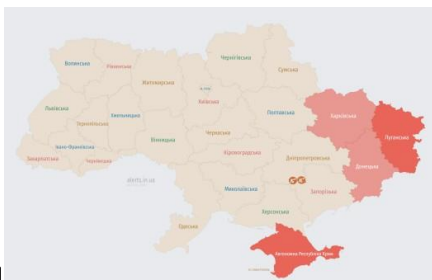
VISUAL CHRONOLOGY OF REGIONAL ROCKET, DRONE, ARTILLERY, MORTAR AND BOMB ALARMS

Tuesday, November 7

7:12 AM: Summary of the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine as of 06:00 on November 7:

- During the day of November 6, there were 78x combat engagements. The enemy launched a total of 16x air strikes and 54x MLRS attacks at the positions of Ukrainian troops and various settlements.
- Air strikes hit Novomykhailivka, Rivnopil (Donetsk oblast), Novodarivka (Zaporizhzhia oblast), Beryslav, and Ivanivka (Kherson oblast).
- More than 110x settlements in Chernihiv, Sumy, Kharkiv, Luhansk, Donetsk, Zaporizhzhia, and Kherson oblasts came under artillery fire.
- During the day of November 6, Ukrainian Air Force launched 6x air strikes on the concentrations of troops, weapons, and military equipment and 1x air strike on the anti-aircraft missile system of the adversary. Also, the forces and means of the air defense of Ukraine destroyed 1x Shahed-136/131 strike UAV and 1x reconnaissance UAVs of the enemy.
- The Ukrainian missile troops hit 3x artillery systems, 1x command post, 1x concentrations of troops, weapons, and military equipment, 1x air defense system, and 1x important target of the Russian invaders.

Khortytsia operational-strategic group

Kupyansk axis: the enemy conducted unsuccessful assault operations in the vicinities of settlements of Synkivka, Ivanivka (Kharkiv oblast), and Stelmakhivka (Luhansk oblast), where Ukrainian defenders repelled around 20x attacks of the adversary.

Lyman axis: the occupiers did not conduct any offensive (assault) operations.

Bakhmut axis: the Ukrainian soldiers repelled 5x adversary attacks near Bohdanivka and Khromove (Donetsk oblast). Also, the enemy

made unsuccessful attempts to regain the lost ground in the vicinity of Avdiivka. In turn, the Ukrainian Defense Forces continue assault operations south of Bakhmut (Donetsk oblast), inflict losses in manpower and equipment on the enemy, and consolidate their new positions.

Tavria operational-strategic group

Avdiivka axis: the enemy keeps trying to encircle Avdiivka. The Ukrainian soldiers are standing their ground and inflicting major losses on the enemy. The enemy's offensive actions were unsuccessful in the vicinities of settlements of Stepove, Avdiivka, and Tonenke (Donetsk oblast), where the Ukrainian Defense Forces repelled more than 20x attacks.

The enemy made 25x unsuccessful attacks in the vicinities of Krasnohorivka and Maryinka (Donetsk oblast).

Shakhtarske and Zaporizhzhia axes: the adversary conducted unsuccessful assault operations near Staromaiorske (Donetsk oblast), Chervone, Robotyne, and northwest of Verbove (Zaporizhzhia oblast). The Ukrainian defenders repelled more than 10x attacks in that area.

Monday, November 6

12:37 PM: Ukraine may face an economic crisis next year without financial support from partner countries.

- This was announced by the Minister of Finance of Ukraine, Serhiy Marchenko.
- A "hole" in the amount of about 29 billion dollars may appear in the budget, which will negatively affect not only Ukraine, but also the states of the European Union.

1:04 PM: The SBU exposed the former deputy defense minister of Ukraine for embezzlement of almost UAH 1 billion

- According to the case file, in 2022, this official, having entered into a conspiracy with his subordinates, made the purchase of

low-quality military uniforms from a private company for almost UAH 1 billion.

- The investigation established that the military of the Armed Forces cannot use the specified uniform, as it is unsuitable for operation in the cold season in the conditions of conducting intensive combat operations.

1:16 PM: In this incomplete year, the SBU neutralized 4,000 Russian cyberattacks

- "No country in the world experiences as many cyberattacks as Ukraine. We are the first to encounter Russian cyberweapons. Ukraine has become a test site where it is tested."
- "But Ukraine has become a shield in the cyberspace of the entire democratic world and effectively opposes Russian hackers", - noted the head of cyber security of the SBU, Ilya Vityuk.

2:18 PM: Military intelligence of Ukraine does not record the active movement of "shaheeds" from Iran to Russia.

- This was stated by Vadym Skibitskyi, a representative of the Ministry of Internal Affairs and Communications of Ukraine.
- Skibitsky noted that Tehran has already fulfilled the first concluded contracts with Moscow for the supply of ready-made kamikaze drones, so now it can only be about small batches of drones and components for them.
- At the same time, according to him, the Russian Federation partially started the large-scale production of "shaheeds" in the territory of the Republic of Tatarstan.

3:55 PM: People's Deputy of Ukraine Andrii Nikolayenko, who hit an 18-year-old girl to death on the Zhytomyr highway, was declared a suspect.

- This is reported by the Prosecutor General's Office.

- According to preliminary data, the people's deputy exceeded the permitted maximum speed. Currently, the issue of selecting a preventive measure for him is being resolved.

4:01 PM: The Pechersk Court of Kyiv chose a preventive measure for People's Deputy Oleksandr Dubinsky — round-the-clock house arrest.

- We will remind that Dubinsky is suspected of organizing a scheme for illegal border crossing for men.
- The People's Deputy himself called the case against him fabricated.

5:47 PM: Ukgazvydobuvannya has commissioned two wells: together they produce almost 500,000 cubic meters of gas per day.

- This was reported by the company's press service.
- "_The location of the drilling of the exploratory well was determined thanks to the previously conducted 3D seismic reconnaissance studies_" the message reads.

6:09 PM: Ukraine has the highest taxes (<https://bit.ly/3QnJfOB>) on the gaming business

- Ukraine has the largest tax burden on the gambling business in Europe. According to Doctor of Law Zoryana Toporetska (<https://bit.ly/49gyc2a>), the state forces legal businesses to go into the shadows and break the law.
- In fact, the gaming business market is taxed at rates and according to the 2010 model. The longer the state delays with changes to the legislation, the longer the illegal gambling business will flourish, the lawyer is convinced.

6:37 PM: Volodymyr Zelenskyi had a telephone conversation with the President of Sierra Leone, Julius Maada Bio.

- "_Happy to restore contact between our states at the highest level after a 20-year break_" Zelenskyi wrote.

- The leaders of the countries discussed the Ukrainian Peace Formula, Zelensky invited the president of Sierra Leone to the second summit within the framework of the GrainFromUkraine initiative.

7:01 PM: Summary of the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine as of 18:00 on November 6:

- During the day _57 combat clashes took place_. The enemy carried out 10 airstrikes, launched 24 attacks from rocket salvo systems on the positions of our troops and populated areas.
- Aviation of the Defense Forces _struck 5 strikes_ on the areas of concentration of personnel, weapons and military equipment and 1 - on the enemy's anti-aircraft missile complex.
- Units of the missile forces _hit 3 artillery pieces_, the command post and the area of concentration of personnel, weapons and military equipment of the enemy

5:24 PM: Last week, UAV operators hit 335 enemy positions.

- This was announced by the head of the Ministry of Statistics Mykhailo Fedorov.
- Also among the affected are 83 armored combat vehicles, 72 trucks, 36 tanks and hundreds of occupants.

8:24 PM: Zaluzhny's assistant was killed by a grenade explosion at his home in the village of Chayki near Kyiv, the spokeswoman of the Ministry of Internal Affairs reported for UP.

- His 13-year-old son is seriously injured and is being treated.
- A case was opened under Article 263 "Illegal handling of weapons, ammunition or explosives".

8:38 PM: Valery Zaluzhny reported that his assistant Gennady Chastyakov died on his birthday.

- "An unknown explosive device went off in one of the gifts," he said.

- The reasons and circumstances of death will be established during the pre-trial investigation.

8:49 PM: In his evening address, Volodymyr Zelenskyy emphasized that budget resources should be directed not to paving and street repairs, but to defense assistance.

- In addition, Zelensky noted that "_elections are not the right time now" _

9:23 PM: Volodymyr Zelenskyi told the details of the investigation into the tragedy that resulted in the deaths of servicemen of the 128th OGSBr.

- _"The brigade commander has been suspended for the duration of the investigation. The whole situation is being analyzed minute by minute. And it will be established who specifically violated the rules regarding the safety of people in the area of access of enemy aerial reconnaissance" _

9:51 PM: The police say that Gennadiy Chastyakov most likely died as a result of an accident. So far, there is no reason to talk about a Russian trail.

- _"With a probability of 99.9%, this is a tragic case. He was presented with combat grenades for his birthday, one of which detonated due to careless handling_", - said the law enforcement agencies.

10:39 PM: Details of the death of Gennady Chastyakov from the Minister of Internal Affairs Igor Klymenko:

- The deceased Major Chastyakov _had a birthday_. He returned home from work with gifts from his colleagues.
- He took out a gift box with grenades inside and started _demonstrating one of the ammunition to his son._ These were grenades of the new Western model

- First, the son took the ammunition and started turning the ring. Next, the serviceman _took the grenade from the child and pulled out the ring_, provoking a tragic explosion.
- In the apartment, the police found another _5 such unexploded grenades_. They will be sent for examination.
- The police _found a fellow soldier_ who gave a fatal gift. His office was already searched and
- 2 similar grenades were seized.
