News From the Battlefield

"Reporting From Ukraine" appears to believe that Russia has concluded that Avdiivka is a lost cause, at least in the short term, and that they're moving troops up to Bakhmut, or "Bakhmut 2." He reports that Russia now has approximately 8,000 troops in positions east of Bakhmut.

Russia appears to be desperate to show some kind of breakthrough during the period leading up to elections in Russia, and it doesn't matter to them where the breakthrough would take place. There is thrust and parry all up and down the line, from the Dnipro Crossing

to Kupiansk in the north.

For its part, Ukraine seems content to killing as many Russians as they can, and continue hitting Russian logistics. Recent destruction of Russian ammo dumps and fuel supply depots, mostly near Donetsk City, has apparently stopped Russia's Avdiivka Offensive in its tracks.

The news I am getting from the Senate, related in yesterday's email, implies that Putin is doing everything he can, using social media, to lean on Republican members of Congress to withhold continued support to Ukraine. Whether or not he's trying to engage Donald Trump in this effort is unclear. The risk to Russia is that when (likely) the U.S. resumes military aid to Ukraine that will include weapons that the U.S. has previously withheld, such as longer range ATACMS missiles armed with unitary warheads capable of cutting the Kerch Bridge, rendering Crimea to a marginal military asset for Russia.

Putin is also continuing to count on the "newspapers of record" (NY Times, Washington Post, Wall St. Journal) to continue to write articles entitled "failed offensive," "stalemate," that he hopes have effect in convincing members of Congress to stop throwing good money after bad, where the U.S. investment in ensuring Ukraine's freedom has the additional benefit of degrading Russia. The "newspapers of record" are populated by senior editors and reporters with long experience in Russia and, conversely, little or no experience in Ukraine, who believe that Russia cannot be beaten by Ukraine, and they go about writing articles supporting their assertion.

The Frozen Russian Central Bank Assets

As U.S. support for Ukraine has hit a temporary snag, more attention is being given to confiscating or re-purposing over \$300 billion in frozen Russian Central Bank assets for use in supporting Ukraine. Here are 2 recent articles, from Ukrainian Pravda and today's New York Times.

The current pause in U.S. support of Ukraine is a symptom of a larger

truth – Western taxpayers have limits on their ability to provide continued support to Ukraine. The corollary is - leaving \$300 billion in Russian Central Bank assets, plus accrued interest, untouched is a non-starter with Western taxpayers who, in large numbers, continue to support Ukraine.

This seems to be finally dawning on the bureaucratic handwringers in Washington, London, and Brussels who, until recently, weren't doing much, other than providing reasons why frozen Russian Central Bank assets should remain untouched. It is likely that the U.S. Congress will see a way to continue to supply Ukraine with weapons but, non-military support for Ukraine, including reconstruction, is another matter. There is also large bi-partisan support in the U.S. Congress to provide the Administration with the necessary authorization allowing them to use frozen Russian Central Bank assets to support Ukraine.



Ministry of Defence of Ukraine, Situation Update posted 20 December 2023 19:06

During the day of December 20, there were 89 combat engagements. The enemy launched 5 missile and 31 air strikes, 53 MLRS attacks at the positions of Ukrainian troops and various settlements.

The operational situation in the east and the south of Ukraine remains difficult.

belarus continue their missions in the areas bordering Ukraine. Sivershchyna and Slobozhanshchyna axes: the adversary maintains its military presence in the areas of Russia bordering Ukraine.

Volyn and Polissya

axes: no significant

changes. No signs of

fire, including Karpovychi (Chernihiv oblast), Khotin, Kostyantynivka, Volfyne (Sumy oblast), Veterynarne, Vovchansk, Budarky (Kharkiv oblast).

Kupyansk axis: the Ukrainian defenders repelled 16 attacks in the vicinity of Synkivka east of Petropavlivka and Ivanivka (Kharkiv oblast). In that area, the enemy used air support in attempts to break through the defenses of Ukrainian troops. The invaders fired artillery and mortars at around 10 settlements, including Synkivka, Petropavlivka, Ivanivka, Berestove (Kharkiv oblast).

Lyman axis: the Ukrainian soldiers repelled 12 enemy attacks in the vicinity of Bilohorivka (Luhansk oblast), east of Terny and Spirne (Donetsk oblast). The invaders launched an air strike in the area of Serebryanske forestry (Luhansk oblast). The enemy fired artillery and mortars at more than 10 settlements, including Nevske, Bilohorivka (Luhansk oblast), Torske, Serebryanka, Verkhniokamyanske, Rozdolivka (Donetsk oblast).

Bakhmut axis: the Ukrainian Defense Forces repelled 6 attacks of the adversary near Bohdanivka, Klishchiyivka, and Andriyivka (Donetsk oblast). Around 10 settlements came under artillery and mortar fire, including Bohdanivka, Ivanivske, Klishchiyivka, Andriyivka (Donetsk oblast).

Avdiyivka axis: the Ukrainian defenders repelled 13 enemy attacks east of Novobakhmutivka, Avdiyivka, and 18 more attacks in the vicinities of Sjeverne, Pervomaiske and Nevelske (Donetsk oblast). The occupiers fired artillery and mortars at around 10 settlements, including Novobakhmutivka, Berdychi, Avdiyivka, Sjeverne, Pervomaiske (Donetsk oblast).

Maryinka axis: the Ukrainian Defense Forces continue to hold back the enemy in the vicinities of Maryinka, Pobjeda, Novomykhailivka (Donetsk oblast). In that area, the adversary, with air support, launched 9 unsuccessful attacks on the positions of Ukrainian defenders. The settlements of Heorhiyivka, Maryinka, Novomykhailivka, Pobjeda were under artillery and mortar fire of the occupiers.

Shakhtarske axis: the enemy did not conduct any offensive (assault) operations. The adversary fired artillery and mortars at around 10 settlements, including Vuhledar, Prechystivka, Zolota Nyva (Donetsk oblast).

Zaporizhzhia axis: the Ukrainian Defense Forces repelled 4 adversary attacks west of Verbove and south of Robotyne (Zaporizhzhia oblast). In that area, the adversary made attempts to dislodge Ukrainian troops from their positions. Around 20 settlements, including Poltavka, Malynivka, Hulyaipole, Huliaipilske, Kamyanske (Zaporizhzhia oblast), came under enemy artillery and mortar fire.

Kherson axis: the adversary fired artillery at the city of Kherson (Kherson oblast), and Dniprovske, Ochakiv (Mykolaiv oblast). Also, the invaders launched an air strike in the vicinity of Krynky (Kherson oblast).

The enemy did not abandon its intention to drive our units from the left bank of the Dnipro, made 29 failed assaults. The attacks were repelled and the enemy retreated having suffered major losses. The Ukrainian troops are holding the line.

During the day of December 20, the Ukrainian Air Force launched air strikes on 16 concentrations of troops, weapons, and military equipment, and 1 strike on an air defense system of the adversary. The air defense forces shot down 1 Kh-59 guided missile.

The Ukrainian missile troops hit 2 concentrations of troops, weapons, and military equipment, 6 artillery systems of the russian invaders.

8:02 AM: US troops to be based in Denmark, countries sign treaty. This was announced by the Prime Minister of Denmark, Mette

Frederiksen.

10:20 AM: US Senate will not vote on aid to Ukraine this year, Senate Democrats and Republicans say.

 "Our negotiators will be working very, very hard during the December and January recess, and our goal is to get something done once we get back," Senate Democratic Leader Chuck Schumer told reporters.

11:02 AM: EU countries and the European Parliament have agreed on a reform that strengthens migration policy.

• This was reported by European Commissioner Ylva Johanson.

12:56 PM: German Attorney General Peter Frank wants to confiscate more than €720 million in Russian assets, Spiegel.

- These funds were placed by a subsidiary of the Moscow Stock Exchange in the German branch of the large American bank J.P. Morgan.
- As the newspaper writes, the Federal Prosecutor's Office of Germany has already submitted a statement to the Higher Land Court of Frankfurt am Main.

1:42 PM: US to ask Japan to provide missiles for Patriot air defense system to Kyiv, — The Washington Post.

• As early as this week, Japan is expected to officially approve policy changes that will allow it to export several dozen missiles for the Patriot air defense system to the United States.

2:40 PM: The Armed Forces received another batch of military aid from Lithuania — field equipment and several tens of thousands of dry food rations.

• The press service of the Ministry of Defense of Lithuania writes about this.

4:07 PM: The US offers to transfer to Ukraine the frozen assets of the Russian Central Bank as an "advance" of compensation for war damages, Financial Times.

American officials believe that the confiscated assets can be

transferred to Ukraine in tranches, for example, through the World Bank or the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development.

 However, the idea of confiscating assets carries legal ramifications, as frozen reserves are protected by international law.

4:23 PM: Ukraine received €150 million for reconstruction from the European Union, the Ministry of Finance of Ukraine reports.

- Funding will help ensure priority measures for the restoration of critically important objects damaged by the armed aggression of the Russian Federation.
- The second tranche of €100 million is expected already in the first quarter of 2024.

4:28 PM: Dollar gains for ninth consecutive day, renewing highs.

 This is evidenced by the data on the website of the NBU regulator.

5:28 PM: The Al Araby television network released a story about the alleged participation of Ukrainians in the ranks of the Israel Defense Forces in the Gaza Strip.

- The spokesman of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Ukraine Oleg Nikolenko immediately denied the relevant information.
- "_Perhaps Alaraby TV is talking about Israeli citizens of Ukrainian or Slavic origin, but they have nothing to do with the Ukrainian state_," says Nikolenko.

6:14 PM: Ten states have launched the Tallinn Mechanism for Cyber Defense of Ukraine, the head of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Ukraine, Dmytro Kuleba, reports.

6:14 PM: Lithuania, Latvia and Estonia approved a declaration on the unified regional application of EU sanctions against Russia.

6:14 PM: Xi Jinping welcomed the expansion of trade between Beijing and Moscow and promised to strengthen ties between the countries, Chinese Foreign Ministry. 6:14 PM: Russian billionaire Roman Abramovich loses court case to lift EU sanctions, Reuters

7:40 PM: The EU will allocate €20 million for the development of Ukrainian innovations, — Ministry of Digital.

- "_Thanks to the project, about 200 Ukrainian startups can receive €12 million in grant funding. The focus is on Deep Techdevelopments_," the message reads.
- DeepTech (deep technologies "deep technologies") are unique achievements protected by patents, which are practically impossible to copy, both scientific and technological.

8:41 PM: Prime Minister of Slovakia Robert Fico spoke against Ukraine's possible membership in NATO, and promises to prevent it.

- In his opinion, Ukraine's accession to the North Atlantic Alliance could trigger the start of the third world war.
- In an interview with "InfoVojna", Fico stated his intention to use the right of veto on such a decision.

10:42 PM: Lithuania plans to train 3,500 soldiers of the Armed Forces of Ukraine next year, LRT reports.

11:07 PM: Ukraine recognized as one of the most dangerous countries in 2024, — Independent.

- According to the study, Ukraine, Syria, Iraq, Afghanistan, Libya, Yemen, South Sudan, Central African Republic and Somalia received the highest warning level "extreme".
- The safest countries are Iceland, Luxembourg, Norway, Switzerland and Denmark.

11:17 PM: On January 17-18, a meeting of NATO's highest military body - the Military Committee - will be held in Brussels, within which the first meeting of the Ukraine-NATO Council is planned.

- This was reported by the press service of the Alliance.
- _"At the last meeting of the first day, the first meeting of the heads of the General Staffs will be held in the format of the

Ukraine-NATO Council," the message says.

11:34 PM: Ukraine's accession to the EU will take away from Hungary all the money allocated by the union — Orban

 _"Undoubtedly, if we accepted Ukraine, all the aid provided to the countries of Central Europe, including Hungary, would be transferred to Kyiv," he said.

- It is reported that the decrease in the volume of foreign trade due to restrictions on the movement of freight transport through the western borders of Ukraine for November and December may reach 1.5 billion dollars.
- In November, the reduction amounted to 860 million dollars, and in December 620 million dollars.

11:35 AM: Volodymyr Zelenskyy appointed his new representative in the Verkhovna Rada.

- This position was taken by People's Deputy Halyna Mykhailiuk.
- This is stated on the website of the Office of the President.

11:55 AM: Business managers will be required to personally deliver their employees who are registered in another city to the TCC.

- This was announced by Volodymyr Fityo, head of the Public Relations Service of the Land Forces Command.
- He also informed that representatives of ZHEKs and condominiums, village heads, elders and representatives of territorial communities can also serve summonses to conscripts.

1:28 PM: As of December, Ukraine produces more than 50,000 FPV drones, Minister of Strategic Industry Oleksandr Kamyshin said.

 According to him, in 2024, the production of more than 10,000 medium-range strike drones is expected, as well as more than a thousand long-range UAVs.

2:03 PM: "Ukrainian team" handed over 100 attack drones to the defenders of Avdiivka

- 100 drones are destroyed by millions of enemy equipment, as well as destroyed manpower of the enemy that is pushing on our land. As the military say, from each drone - new spectators at a concert in Kobzon. We will ensure a full house in hell, said the head of "Ukrainian Team" Artur Palatny during the handover of drones to the fighters of the 110th Separate Mechanized Brigade named after Colonel-General Mark Bezruchka.
- Volunteers called on business representatives, active
 Ukrainians everyone who can to join and also help the defenders of Avdiyivka with drones.

2:35 PM: The Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine adopted the European integration bill No. 10161 in the first reading.

- People's deputy Yaroslav Zheleznyak reports this.
- The adoption of the law should improve the quality of the state's communication with citizens, in particular, eliminate bureaucracy and give people the opportunity to participate in the consideration of cases that concern them.

3:38 PM: Threat of using ballistic weapons from the east, — PS ZSU.

3:55 PM: The Verkhovna Rada adopted two draft laws that exempt from VAT and customs duties the importation of EWs, radar systems and plates for body armor for the army into Ukraine.

People's deputy Yaroslav Zheleznyak reported this.

5:03 PM: BEB analysts discovered a scheme to evade payment of UAH 65 million in customs duties on the export of scrap metal.

- "[...] _a number of companies during the export of scrap metal in customs declarations use codes and descriptions of goods for "covering". This manipulation allows them to export goods without paying export duty_", - the BEB notes.
- It is about 3 enterprises that, by manipulating the nomenclature of goods, carried out export operations without paying customs payments.

6:27 PM: "Kyivstar" has resumed all company services both in Ukraine and abroad.

- This was announced by the company's president, Oleksandr Komarov.
- "_All services of "Kyivstar" work without any restrictions_," said Komarov.

6:40 PM: About 6,000 men of conscription age leave Ukraine throughout the western border area per day, — DPSU.

- Of them, 150-200 are men under the "Shlyah" system as volunteers.
- It is noted that the number of men marrying mothers with many children and leaving has increased recently.

7:12 PM: The Government of Ukraine predicts an increase in the average monthly wage over the next 3 years.

- This is stated in the resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers on the government portal.
- In 2024 21,809 UAH;
- In 2025 25,732 hryvnias;

8:27 PM: The Air Force reports that the takeoff of the MiG-31K has been recorded.

• The International Human Rights Organization notes that such

- actions by the Russian Federation are a war crime.
- "_Terrible conditions in places of deprivation of liberty make prisoners especially vulnerable to military service," the article says.

3:33 PM: In the temporarily occupied Crimea, there was an "arrival" at the center of space communication of Russia, — rosZMI.

• "_Preliminarily, the attack was carried out from an unmanned aerial vehicle. One FSB police officer was wounded, the satellite antenna was damaged," the message reads.

4:46 PM: The Security Service of Ukraine announced suspicions against the leaders of the Central Committee of the Russian Federation, who conducted fake "elections" in the temporarily occupied regions of Ukraine.

- We are talking about Ella Pamfilova, the head of the Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation, and two of her subordinates.
- After conducting the staged "elections", Pamfilova's subordinates personally certified the fabricated results of the forced "expression of will".

6:58 PM: Russia receives microchips for weapons systems and drones through a network of intermediaries in China, Morocco and Turkey, NYT.

 "_Almost all commercial equipment, including basic telecommunications, surveillance equipment, microchips for advanced computing and weapons systems, as well as drones, was not too difficult to obtain_," the publication writes.

7:50 PM: The Ukrainian IT army stopped the Russian cloud service Bitrix24, which is used by the largest companies sponsoring the war in Russia, such as Rosneft.

- This is reported by the Ministry of Statistics.
- As a result of the cyber attack, 40% of users had problems accessing the CRM system and other Bitrix24 services.

7:57 PM: The SBU has announced a wanted list of sanctioned Russian oligarch Mykhailo Fridman.

10:18 PM: Revenge for Kyivstar has begun: Ukrainian hackers from the Blackjack group, probably with the support of SBU cyber specialists, destroyed the IT infrastructure of Rosvodokanal.

- During the attack, they encrypted more than 6 thousand computers and deleted more than 50 TB of data: internal document flow, corporate mail, cyber protection services, backup copies, etc. Now the work of "Rosvodokanal" is blocked.
- According to sources, the SBU is already analyzing 1.5 TB of downloaded data from Rosvodokanal, the largest Russian private company that supplied water to 7 million consumers.


