

There is a huge difference between hope and expectation. Expectation is the framework with which we burden our future. We take responsibility for our expectations and their realization or not is our doing.

Hope on the other hand is not our plan for the future. It is what we would like to have happen and if it doesn't or does we keep acting as before. That is without expectation.

Yesterday's massive rocket and drone attack on Ukraine was expected. The rashists spent time prior to the attack informing us that it would happen and

we were programmed to accept that it would. We were programmed to accept that it was because of us; that we were responsible.

Unfortunately the Rashists spent as much effort informing the rest of the world that Ukraine's existence is responsible for their actions. Some in Ukraine and the rest of the world after hearing this argument for years actually believe it. They believe we caused the attack.

Two things come from this. One is that logic or rational thought cannot effectively counter sustained efforts at implanting false expectations. The other is that physical destruction, liquidation of the source, does work.

Traditional Christian Values, as Articulated by Russia

President Putin, and his toady Patriarch Kirill, aka "The Tobacco Metropolitan" for his involvement in cigarette smuggling when Metropolitan of Kaliningrad, have long been touting the purity and chasteness of Russian society, and its adherence to "traditional" Christian values, whether it be religion, anti LBGTQ+, or others.

Much of this rhetoric is not directed toward Russian society. Instead, it is directed at the American "Religious Right," especially elected officials and Presidential candidates, who rely on "Religious Right" groups for support. Elected officials and certain presidential candidates, in turn, rail against Ukraine shutting down churches, tolerating deviant behavior and other alleged transgressions, and use these as a basis to try to stop American military assistance to Ukraine.

Along these lines, yesterday I received two YouTube files. The first was a <u>performance</u> by a Ukrainian choral group in London singing traditional Ukrainian Christmas carols. The second was a group of videos of a recent <u>party</u> in Moscow, entitled "Mostly Naked." My question is - which society, Russia or Ukraine, really embrace Christian values?

It would have made my day if the "chaste" Maria Lvova-Belova, the Russian Commissioner of Children's Rights and a figurative descendant of Heinrich Himmler who, along with Putin, the subject of an ICC international arrest warrant for forcibly deporting Ukrainian children to Russia, would have been at the party. A "Kirill sighting" would have been even better, except he probably routinely holds similar events in the sanctity of one of his palaces (perhaps clad in vestments with nothing underneath).

Given the high level of hypocrisy in Russian society, especially its support of "traditional Christian values," it would have hardly been surprising if either Maria, Kirill, or both, had shown up. Perhaps American elected officials and presidential candidates should take note. I somehow doubt that they will.

The Southern Border

The US Immigration & Customs Enforcement ("ICE") recently reported that several thousand Russian citizens have crossed into the United States from Mexico. After interrogation and jailing suspected Russian agents, of which there are likely more than a few, the U.S. should immediately deport the others.

News From the Battlefield

This is an excellent account from "Reporting From Ukraine," on how the recent (Dec. 28 & 29) Russian missile strike on Ukraine was executed. Given the level of deception coming from the Russians, Ukraine did well to shoot down 73% of the 158 drones and missiles that Russia used in the attack.

Last night Russia once again struck Ukraine, using Iskander missiles against cities near the Russian border. Iskanders only give Ukraine a few minutes' notice.

Great Britain immediately announced that they will be sending Ukraine a supply of anti-aircraft missiles. The U.S. is doing the same, as part of their final shipment to Ukraine under the previous appropriation. Given Russia's evident repudiation of traditional Christian values Mike Johnson, the Speaker of the U.S. House of Representatives, and a self-described man of faith, should immediately move to bring forward the \$60 billion Ukraine appropriation.

SITUATION UPDATE OF THE GENERAL STAFF OF UKRAINIAN ARMED FORCES DECEMBER 28, 2023

Last night, the invaders launched a massive missile strike against Ukraine, attacking critical infrastructure, industrial, military and civilian facilities. The enemy used about 160 means of air attack against Ukraine: missiles of various types and attack UAVs. Ukrainian air defense forces destroyed 88 Kh-101/Kh-555/Kh-55 cruise missiles and 27 Shahed-136/131 attack UAVs.

The operational situation in eastern and southern Ukraine remains difficult.

During the day of December 29, there were 31 combat engagements. The enemy launched 134 missile and 60 air strikes, carried out 36 MLRS attacks at the positions of Ukrainian troops and various settlements. Unfortunately, the russian terrorist attacks have resulted in civilian casualties and injuries. Private residential buildings, hospitals and other civilian infrastructure were destroyed and damaged.

Volyn and Polissya axes: no significant changes. No signs of formation of an offensive group. Certain units of the armed forces of belarus continue their missions in the areas bordering Ukraine.

Sivershchyna and Slobozhanshchyna axes: the adversary maintains its military presence in the areas of russia bordering Ukraine. The enemy

continues its sabotage and reconnaissance activities, shelling Ukrainian settlements from the territory of russia and increases the density of minefields along the state border of Ukraine. More than 20 settlements came under enemy artillery and mortar fire, including Krasni Lozy, Zaliznyi Mist, Bleshnya (Chernihiv oblast), Stepok, Zapsillya, Basivka, Popivka (Sumy oblast), Udy, Huryiv Kozachok, Krasne Pershe, Ambarne (Kharkiv oblast).

Kupyansk axis: the Ukrainian defenders repelled 7 attacks in the vicinity of Synkivka (Kharkiv oblast), where the enemy, with air support, made failed attempts to breach Ukrainian defense. The occupiers launched an air strike near Ivanivka (Kharkiv oblast). The invaders fired artillery and mortars at around 10 settlements, including Dvorichna, Synkivka, Petropavlivka, Ivanivka (Kharkiv oblast).

Lyman axis: the adversary conducted no offensives. The occupiers launched air strikes in the vicinities of Makiyivka, Nevske, Serebryanske forestry (Luhansk oblast), Terny, Serebryanka (Donetsk oblast). The enemy fired artillery and mortars at more than 10 settlements, including Nevske, Bilohorivka (Luhansk oblast), Torske, Serebryanka, Verkhniokamyanske, Spirne, Rozdolivka (Donetsk oblast).

Bakhmut axis: the Ukrainian Defense Forces repelled the enemy attack near Andriyivka (Donetsk oblast), where the enemy attempted to regain lost ground. Around 10 settlements came under artillery and mortar fire, including Bohdanivka, Ivanivske, Klishchiyivka, Andriyivka, New York (Donetsk oblast).

Avdiyivka axis: the Ukrainian defenders repelled 3 enemy attacks near Stepove, Avdiyivka, and 10 more attacks in the vicinities of Sjeverne, Pervomaiske and Nevelske (Donetsk oblast). In that area, the enemy conducted unsuccessful attempts to improve his tactical situation. The occupiers launched air strikes in the vicinities of Oleksandropil, and Novobakhmutivka (Donetsk oblast). The invaders fired artillery and mortars at around 10 settlements, including Berdychi, Stepove, Avdiyivka, Sjeverne, Pervomaiske (Donetsk oblast).

Maryinka axis: the Ukrainian Defense Forces continue to hold back the enemy in the vicinities of Maryinka and Novomykhailivka (Donetsk oblast), where the enemy conducted 5 failed attacks on Ukrainian positions. The settlements of Krasnohorivka, Heorhiyivka, Pobjeda, Novomykhailivka, Paraskoviyivka were under artillery and mortar fire of the occupiers.

Shakhtarske axis: the enemy conducted no offensives. The adversary fired artillery and mortars at around 10 settlements, including Vodyane, Vuhledar, Prechystivka, Urozhaine, (Donetsk oblast).

Zaporizhzhia axis: the Ukrainian Defense Forces repelled the adversary attack west of Verbove (Zaporizhzhia oblast). More than 25 settlements, including Poltavka, Malynivka, Mala Tokmachka, Novodanylivka, Kamyanske, Stepnohirsk (Zaporizhzhia oblast), came under enemy artillery and mortar fire.

Odesa operational-strategic group, Kherson axis: the adversary fired artillery at the settlements of Ivanivka, Antonivka, Novotyahynka, Kherson (Kherson oblast), and Solonchaky (Mykolaiv oblast).

The occupiers do not abandon their intention to drive Ukrainian units out of their footholds on the left bank of the Dnipro. Thus, during the day, the enemy made 9 unsuccessful assaults. The Ukrainian troops are holding the line and keep inflicting significant losses on the enemy.

During the day of December 29, the Ukrainian Air Force launched air strikes on 10 concentrations of troops, weapons, and military equipment, and 3 strikes on air defense systems of the occupiers.

The Ukrainian missile troops hit 2 concentrations of troops, weapons, and military equipment, 3 artillery systems, 5 ammunition depots, and 2 important targets of the russian invaders.

 The building of the metro station "Luk'yanivska" was damaged by the explosion. The station works as a shelter. Trains follow the station without stopping.

8:38 AM: So far, as a result of Russian strikes on Kharkiv, one person has died and eight people have been injured, RMA head Oleg Sinegubov said.

• Damage to the city's civil infrastructure was recorded: a medical facility, warehouses, and civil enterprises.

8:45 AM: The air defense system is operating in Ternopil Oblast, the press service of the Chortkiv City Council reported.

8:46 AM: In Dnipro, there are dead and injured as a result of the morning attack, Mayor Boris Filatov said.

8:51 AM Social Networks: Repeated explosions are heard in Lviv.

8:53 AM: Lviv Mayor Andriy Sadovy confirmed the explosions in the city.

9:02 AM: Approximately three people are under the rubble of a warehouse damaged by rocket fragments in the Shevchenkiv district, Kyiv Mayor Vitaly Klychko said.

 Three people were caught. The search and rescue operation is ongoing.

9:07 AM: Today, Russia launched everything but the Calibers, Air Force spokesman Yuriy Ignat said.

- the Russians used Daggers, ballistics, S-300, cruise missiles, UAVs, X-22 or X-32. About 18 strategic bombers launched X-101/X-505.
- "We have never seen so many targets simultaneously on our monitor,"
 Ignat said.

9:12 AM: The head of the Lviv OVA, Maksym Kozytskyi, showed the condition of the residential quarter, which was affected by the blast wave.

• There is destruction and victims. There are currently no victims.

9:13 AM: A warehouse with an area of approximately 3,000 m2 is on fire in the Podilsky district of Kyiv, — KMVA.

 Many wounded, the number is being specified. The search for the victims is underway.

9:16 AM: In Lviv, one person was killed and three were injured in a residential building on Hotkevicha Street due to a rocket attack.

• This was announced by the head of the Lviv RMA Maksym Kozytskyi.

9:23 AM: The occupiers launched more than 20 strikes on the city of Kharkiv, previously with S-300 missiles, RMA head Oleg Sinegubov said.

• The destruction and damage of warehouse and production buildings, a transport depot, and an enterprise were recorded.

As a result of the blows, 1 person died - a man of about 35 years old,
 11 people were injured.



9:28 AM: In the Darnytsia district, fragments of a downed rocket fell in the private sector of the Osokorka microdistrict, Mykola Kalashnyk, the head of the Darnytsia RDA, said.

• There were no victims, there was no fire, the farm buildings were partially destroyed.

9:36 AM: Mayor of Lviv Andriy Sadovy showed the consequences of a rocket attack on the city, where 3 schools and a kindergarten were damaged.



• Currently, there are 8 wounded in the city.

9:38 AM: In Dnipro, as a result of a hit, the building of a medical facility was significantly damaged, — Ministry of Health.



• All patients and medical personnel managed to go to the shelter.

9:40 AM: There are currently 10 injured in Zaporizhzhia, two of them in serious condition, — Ministry of Health.

• People remain under the rubble of one of the buildings.

9:45 AM: In Dnipro, as a result of a rocket attack, almost a dozen people were previously injured. Four died.



- This was reported by the head of OVA, Serhiy Lysak.
- In the city, an "arrival" at the shopping center, a private house, a six-story building, and a maternity hospital were mutilated.

9:47 AM: The number of victims in Kyiv has increased to 17 people, — KMVA.

9:51 AM: In Odesa, as a result of a rocket attack, 2 Odessa residents were killed. 15 people were injured, among them two children - 6 and 8 years old.

- This was announced by the head of RMA Oleg Kiper.
- As a result of a night attack by drones in Odesa district, a preserved building of one of the infrastructure objects was hit. And in Odesa, a high-rise building was damaged by debris. 10 "shaheeds" were destroyed by air defense forces.

9:55 AM: The body of one deceased was recovered from the rubble of a warehouse in the Shevchenkiv district of Kyiv, Vitaliy Klitschko reported.

• The search and rescue operation is ongoing.

10:09 AM: In Kyiv, as a result of a rocket hitting the roof of an unfinished business center in the Shevchenkiv district, floors 10 through 8 were partially destroyed, Vitaliy Klitschko reported.

 Rescuers have already freed the fourth victim from the rubble of a warehouse in the Shevchenkiv district.

10:19 AM: 18 wounded and 2 dead in Kyiv, KMVA reported.

• "_The Lukyanivska metro station has resumed its work_," the administration added.

10:22 AM: Approximately 110 rockets were fired over Ukraine, most of them were shot down, Volodymyr Zelenskyy said.

10:33 AM: There are already 5 victims in Dnipro, more than 20 injured, RMA head Serhii Lysak said.

• The search and rescue operation is ongoing.

10:36 AM: In Lviv, the number of people injured due to a rocket attack has increased to 15, reported the head of OVA Maksym Kozytskyi.

• As of this hour, partial destruction is known in 13 residential high-rise buildings and two schools. Many damaged cars.

10:37 AM: A massive missile attack damaged a high-voltage power line in the central region. Without blackouts of consumers.

• This was reported to Ukrenergo.

10:39 AM: In Kyiv, in the Podilskyi district, where the warehouse caught fire, a search is underway for the victims — KMVA.

• 10 people are currently under the rubble.

10:41 AM: In Zaporizhzhia, the body of another woman was recovered from the rubble of a private house, Anatoliy Kurtev, secretary of the city council, reported.

10:52 AM: The KMVA clarified the consequences of the missile attack on the capital.

• So far, one, not two, dead have been identified. The 21st person was injured.

10:57 AM: 114 out of 158 missiles of various types and attack drones were destroyed by the forces and means of the Air Force in cooperation with units of the Defense Forces of Ukraine:

- 27 strike BpLA «Shahed-136/131»
- 87 Kh-101/Kh-555/Kh-55 cruise missiles.

11:08 AM: As a result of the attack on Odesa, a three-story building was also hit. Rescuers have just pulled out a human body from under the rubble.



- As the head of RMA Oleg Kiper reported, the number of victims as a result of the Russian missile attack has increased to three. 23 people were rescued from the residential 17-type roof by the State Emergency Service.
- The lyceum was also damaged in the city as a result of shelling.

11:12 AM: Lviv region was attacked by 14 "Shakheds", OVA head Maksym Kozytskyi

reported.

• 8 of them were destroyed by soldiers of the "Zahid" PvK. However, there is also a hit - in one of the enterprises in Lviv. The partial destruction of the administrative building and production workshops was recorded. There are no victims or injured.

- 11:13 AM: As a result of massive shelling, there is a power outage in Kyiv, Dnipropetrovsk, Odesa, and Kharkiv regions.
 - This was reported to the Ministry of Energy.
- 11:37 AM: As a result of the Russian attack on Ukraine in the morning of December 29, at least 12 people were killed and 76 people were injured, the Ministry of Internal Affairs.
- 11:40 AM: Another person was found from under the rubble of warehouses in the Shevchenkiv district, the KMVA reports.
- 11:49 AM: As a result of the Russian attack, 4 people are currently known to have died in Zaporizhzhia, the head of the OVA, Yuriy Malashko, said.





6:24 PM: Britain announced an urgent delivery of missiles to Ukraine's air defense systems after a massive Russian missile strike.

- This was announced by the Minister of Defense of Great Britain, Grant Shapps.
- According to him, hundreds of British-made air defense missiles are being sent to provide Ukraine with everything it needs to protect itself from Putin's barbaric bombings.

 "_53 people were rescued today by our titans from the State Emergency Service. 8 of those rescued were pulled out from under the rubble_," the message reads.
