"The other day, a filmmaker from Beverly Hills called me. He said he was really interested in making a documentary about the Battle of Kyiv. And he asked me if I was interested in joining the project and also asked if I had good ideas and thoughts that could be pitched to Hollywood bosses. And heaven knows I did have quite a few ideas on why people should tap into that page of modern history. I often get back to those days in my thoughts. This always gives me a new bit of strength and motivation.

On those days of February and March 2022, we in Ukraine were all alone. Half of the world was literally burying us alive. Our fate seemed to have been decided upon forever. We were surrounded by a cloud of darkness that was closing in. We had very few weapons sent to us from the West in the final moments before the H-hour. We all were facing a gargantuan wall of doomsday that was just about to bring an end to our little world. I don't think that many of us were seriously thinking about a new day to come when hundreds of Russian missiles were roaring from all around Kyiv in the invasion's initial hours.

Yet, there was this 'fuck this shit,' we're not going down that easy' kind of attitude. The spiritual uplift of the final stand or the finest hour, if I may. So many of us were doing what he or she should and ought to do. The military was ambushing and slaying gargantuan advancing Russian armored columns. Reporters were staying in the semi-encircled city and doing their job. Many ordinary people were getting rifles and ammo from the police just in the streets of Kyiv and were cooking up Molotovs to give Russians a warm welcome in the end.

Many, yours truly included, took care of their loved ones and got back to the city under attack to never ever feel ashamed of themselves. Businesses were keeping the city afloat and feeding the old and the poor. Those whom we elected to lead us were doing their thing. Those tragic days were about this very simple and basic moral principle: do what you must and come what may.

We did not come to terms with 'there's nothing that can be done' and 'Kyiv will inevitably fall within 72 hours.' And now, whatever happens, be it America abandoning us in the worst European war of aggression since Adolf Hitler or anything else, we'll still be doing what we all should. Because we still have no choice but to do what is right. that's repelling the biggest European war of aggression since Adolf Hitler for over 700 days and is not even thinking of giving up.

But until then - good night from the fighting Ukraine."

Amen – Yet the negativity keeps on coming. Today, in the Wall Street Journal, one of the "newspapers of record," there was an Op-Ed entitled "A New Strategy that Can Save Ukraine," by Stephen Hadley & Matthew Koenig, both of the Atlantic Council. Both Hadley and Koenig are very well-respected, and the Atlantic Council is very supportive of Ukraine, which makes their choice of words rather surprising.

Hadley and Koenig describe a strategy to "save" Ukraine consisting of five elements. All 5 have been previously described by other experts, so it's not worth repeating here.

Ukraine doesn't need "saving." Ukraine needs all the support it can get to achieve victory. Does anyone really think that given what Ukraine has been through, especially in the early days of the war, that Illia Ponomarenko is thinking about Ukraine needing to be "saved?"

Sen. J.D. Vance (R-Ohio) and House Speaker Michael Johnson, and other Members of Congress who support their position to withhold military assistance to Ukraine, collectively the "Nattering Nabobs of Negativity" to quote the late Vice President Spiro Agnew, should think about what would've happened if the pundits had been correct, that Ukraine would've lost in 5 days. There would've almost certainly been a nasty partisan war without end on NATO's eastern flank, with several NATO countries providing the partisans with weapons, thus exposing the entire Alliance to Russian aggression and a possible use of Article 5. What would NATO do? Tell these countries, all NATO members, to stop supporting the Partisans?

To ensure against this happening in the future, the Nabobs need to get their heads out of the sand, and do the following:

- 1. Support a policy of giving Ukraine everything it asks for, when Ukraine asks for it;
- 2. Get behind the roadmap laid out by 3 Republican Congressional committee chairs, and demand from the Biden Administration that it provide Congress with a strategy that will lead to Ukraine's victory.

INTERNATIONAL

8:02 AM: States and Britain inflicted blows on 36 sites the Houthis control in Yemen.

8:02 AM: Speaker of the House of Representatives Mike Johnson announced that next week there will be a vote on a bill to provide Israel with \$17.6 billion in security assistance without support for of Ukraine.

8:02 AM: The White House called Johnson's statement about supporting Israel without helping Ukraine a "cynical maneuver."

8:02 AM: In Tehran, special services broke up a rally organized by the families of the dead passengers of the UIA plane, which was shot down by Iran in January 2020.

9:21 AM: White House opposes bill to support Israel without aid to Ukraine.

- White House spokeswoman Karin Jean-Pierre called it a "cynical political maneuver" by Republicans.
- The Biden administration emphasizes that Israel's security should not be a "political game."

11:30 AM: Allies of Ukraine plan to finance Kyiv with debt obligations and bonds issued by Western countries. Such obligations will be secured by frozen Russian assets.

- The Financial Times writes about it.
- According to the publication, already after the end of the war, "the coalition supporting Ukraine will demand that Russia pay the debt, and if it does not do so, then the frozen Russian assets will be confiscated."

12:37 PM: The Ministry of Defense of Lithuania confirmed that it signed a contract with NATO for the purchase of 155-mm artillery shells

- "Lithuania is one of the countries that buys 155-mm artillery shells as part of the large NATO contract signed at the end of January," the report says.
- The Ministry of Defense of Lithuania has confirmed to the media that under the signed contract, Vilnius is now among those participating in a large NATO purchase of 155 mm artillery shells for 1.1 billion euros. The contract was recently signed with French Nexter and German Junghans Microtec. Deliveries should begin at the end of 2025.

1:01 PM: The Polish government has announced the strengthening of border controls with Ukraine, — the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development of Poland.

- Warsaw wants to intensify inspections of goods leaving Ukraine.
- _"Excessive imports of agricultural products from Ukraine, which do not meet the production requirements of the EU, threaten the competitiveness of Polish agriculture," the ministry said in a statement.

2:46 PM: The signing of the security agreement between Ukraine and Germany may take place before the end of the month, - Frankfurter Allgemeine Zeitung

- Stefanishyna noted that the text "has not yet been finalized, but it is generally complete." According to information from government circles in Berlin, the agreement should be signed on February 16 during the Munich Security Conference in Berlin.
- The publication noted that this agreement should become part of a network of bilateral security agreements designed to support Ukraine in the fight against Russian aggression while the country is not yet a member of NATO.

5:32 PM: At least 51 people have died in one of the deadliest wildfires in Chile's history, BBC.

- It is difficult for rescue services to reach the most affected areas, so the number of victims of the fires is expected to rise.
- A curfew was introduced in some cities. This should help clear the roads so that emergency vehicles can reach the victims more easily.

5:40 PM: "Ukraine is fighting for us to have a peaceful life": the speakers of the parliaments of the Baltic countries called on the US Congress to provide assistance to Ukraine

- Representatives of the Baltic countries met with the speaker of the US House of Representatives, Mike Johnson, and other lawmakers from both parties.
- "Ukraine is fighting for us to have a peaceful life, for our children to go to school and study there, for us to go to work and do our own business. Ukrainians pay a high price for us to have these opportunities. And that's why I want to emphasize that the war for Ukraine is a struggle for peace in the whole world", - emphasized the Speaker of the Latvian Saeima Daiga Mierinja.

7:11 PM: The US and Japan have named China as a hypothetical enemy for the first time during their joint command and staff exercise, Kyodo.

7:11 PM: North Korea is making millions of dollars selling false eyelashes, beards and wigs, hiding the product's origin under the label "Made in China," — Reuters.

7:11 PM: US President Biden wins South Carolina's Democratic primary with more than 95% of the vote, CNBC.

7:11 PM: The American company Google presented a new tool for converting text into images, ImageFX, based on artificial intelligence (AI).

7:28 PM: Photo of defenders from Ternopil Oblast and a student of UCU were placed on stamps in Liberia

• A total of six Ukrainian defenders are placed on the stamps. Two of them are from Ternopil Oblast. This is paramedic Kateryna Polishchuk and Inna Derusova, the first woman to be posthumously awarded the title of Hero of Ukraine.

8:50 PM: The Polish military has warned civil aviation of a "possible activation of military aviation" along the border with Ukraine, Belarus, the Russian Federation (Koenigsberg region) and Lithuania.

 "_Navigational warnings — unplanned military activity related to ensuring national security — is a common message when it is necessary to ensure the safety of traffic in Polish airspace_," says the message of the Operational Command of the Polish Armed Forces.

11:22 PM: A 3-week training course for canine specialists of the State Emergency Service of Ukraine ended in France.

 Emergency services of the State Emergency Service received 5 Belgian Malinois sheepdogs, a specialized car with a trailer and small mechanization equipment.

NATIONAL

7:32 AM: Summary of the General Staff as of 06:00 February 4:

- During the past 24 hours, 66 combat clashes took place. In total, the enemy launched 2 missile and 65 air strikes, carried out 53 anti-aircraft fire at the positions of the Armed Forces and populated areas.
- During the past day, the aviation of the Defense Forces struck 12 areas where the enemy's personnel were concentrated.
- One Kh-59 guided air missile, 10 Shahed-136/131 type strike UAVs and 3 enemy reconnaissance UAVs were destroyed by the forces and means of the Air Defense Forces of Ukraine.
- Units of the missile forces struck 1 area of concentration of personnel and 1 artillery of the enemy.

12:02 PM: ZSU advanced southwest of Bakhmut - ISW.

- Geolocated footage released on February 3 shows units of the 85th Separate Motorized Brigade striking Ukrainian forces in a wooded area east of Klishchiivka.
- Also, in the Kherson Region, the Russian Federation is having great difficulty attacking the positions of the Armed Forces of Ukraine in Krynyky, because ours completely control the airspace with the help of UAVs.

12:22 PM: The Russians focused on shelling energy infrastructure in the frontline regions, - Ministry of Energy

- "In this heating season, of course, we all see that there were no such massive attacks on the energy infrastructure. The enemy concentrated mainly on the frontline regions," he said.
- The official specified that both generation and distribution facilities were destroyed in such areas, and coal mines and the gas supply system were hit.

5:03 PM: Volodymyr Zelenskyi visited the "East" air command.

- They discussed the protection of Ukrainian cities and villages, critical infrastructure facilities and the front line from the air, as well as the peculiarities of the use of Western air defense systems.
- The President awarded combat pilots.

6:39 PM: After the change of Zaluzhny, we will lose time to establish new communications with Western partners, - former spokesman of the General Staff of the Armed Forces

 Colonel of the Armed Forces of Ukraine Vladyslav Seleznyov, exspokesman of the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine, noted that the lion's share of the military and technical support of the Ukrainian army is also due to direct communications between the commander-in-chief, his staff and our Western partners.

7:46 PM: Jerry Heil and alyona alyona are the winners of the final of the national selection "Eurovision-2024".

• They will represent Ukraine with the song "Teresa & Maria".

7:51 PM: Summary of the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine as of 18:00 on February 4:

- During the day _59 combat clashes took place._
- In the Marinsky direction _Defence forces continue to hold back the enemy near Georgiyivka and Novomykhailivka of the Donetsk region.
- Aviation of the Defense Forces struck 5 areas where enemy personnel were concentrated.

8:22 PM: Ukrainian defense forces have destroyed 6,640 Russian invaders and 924 units of enemy equipment and weapons in a week.

 This was announced by the First Deputy Minister of Defense of Ukraine, Lieutenant General Oleksandr Pavlyuk.

11:31 PM: Volodymyr Zelenskyy confirmed his intentions to release Zaluzhny.

- The President of Ukraine stated this on the air of the Italian TV channel Rai1, adding that he is also considering the dismissal of not only Zaluzhny, but also other senior officials.
- "_Of course, a reboot and a new beginning is necessary. When we talk about this, I mean the replacement of a number of state leaders, not only in the military sphere. I am thinking about this replacement [Zaluzhnyi], it is true. This issue concerns the entire management group, who drives the country's car_," Zelenskyi said.

MORDOR – ruZZia

12:51 PM: The presence of "Wagner" mercenaries in Belarus benefits the Russian Federation, as it forces Ukraine to maintain defensive positions and personnel along the northern border, British intelligence.

• At the same time, the report emphasizes that there are probably less than 1,000 Russian mercenaries left in Belarus, whose duties include training the Belarusian military and security forces.

9:21 PM: Sanctions increase number of air accidents in Russia, The Wall Street Journal.

• In 2023, there were at least 74 incidents involving passenger planes in the Russian Federation, while in 2022 there were 36.

• The breakdowns are related to sanctions, which prohibit foreign companies from servicing airline planes from Russia and supplying spare parts for them.

9:42 PM: Mi-8 helicopter "disappeared from radar" in Russia over Lake Onega in Karelia, — rosZMI.

There were 3 people on board, the search for the aircraft is ongoing.
The plane belongs to the Ministry of Emergency Situations of Russia
and was flying from Petrozavodsk to the city of Vitegra, Vologda
region.

10:21 PM: Russians have assembled 500 tanks, more than 600 combat vehicles, hundreds of howitzers and 40,000 soldiers to attack Kupyansk, — Forbes.

- It is noted that the occupiers plan to launch a major offensive in order to achieve military success closer to the spring against the backdrop of Putin's election campaign.
- The Armed Forces, despite the shortage of shells, are now actively strengthening and stocking FPV drones for this battle.

11:03 PM: Explosions are heard in temporarily occupied Sevastopol, local channels report.

11:42 PM: The Russian Federation is preparing "observers" among students for the presidential elections in the occupied territories

- The Russian invaders in the temporarily occupied territories are training "observers" among students who will be engaged in the organization of falsification of the results of the presidential elections. The CNS writes about it.
- It is noted that the occupation administration set a plan for the number of students for universities to "work for the elections". Each university should identify students who will be "observers" and then instruct them on future falsifications.

• "Yesterday at 6:20 p.m. on the approaches to the Glukhiv community, the soldiers of one of the

strongholds noticed the movement of an armed group consisting of ten people. The Ukrainian soldiers immediately started a shooting battle and called anti-sabotage reserves from their battalion. Within a few minutes, mortars joined the battle, densely covering with fire the place of concentration of enemy forces," he wrote.

2:13 AM: Kharkivska and Dnipropetrovsk region - threat application ballistic armament, reported Air Forces Armed Forces.

10:53 PM: The head of the Kharkiv RMA Oleg Sinegubov commented on the publication of Forbes about the alleged preparation of the Rashist offensive on Kupyansk.

- "_The army of the Russian Federation has been advancing in this direction since February 2022. And since the counteroffensive of the Ukrainian Armed Forces, the occupiers have not abandoned their intentions to recapture these territories, since this is a logistically important direction for them ," he noted.
- The head of the OVA emphasized that "the Armed Forces are ready for any further scenarios, actions of the enemy and quick response to intelligence results."
