INTERNATIONAL

8:02 AM: Europe must provide Ukraine with an additional 50 billion euros due to the delay in aid from the United States, — Macron.

8:02 AM: Norway may transfer 22 F-16 aircraft to Ukraine as part of the aviation coalition, Norwegian publication Nettavisen.

8:02 AM: The White House said that Ukraine needs more air defense equipment, and this is clearly demonstrated by a series of attacks by the Russian Federation on energy infrastructure.

8:02 AM: In Latvia, 27 departure orders were issued to citizens of the Russian Federation who did not comply with the requirements of the immigration law.

8:02 AM: Iran agrees to refrain from striking Israel if the UN Security Council condemns the Jewish state's attack on its consulate in Damascus, Iran's mission to the world body has said.

9:26 AM: UK hands over two Royal Navy minesweepers to Ukraine, Portsmouth News.

- Sandown-class warships, HMS Grimsby and HMS Shoreham, have been decommissioned from the Royal Navy and transferred to the Ukrainian military, where they will operate under the names Chernihiv and Cherkasy.
- They have already arrived in Portsmouth, where their crews are undergoing training to prepare for missions in the Black Sea.

12:30 PM: Ukraine and Montenegro have agreed on "transport visa-free" for cargo transportation from June 1, 2024.

- This was announced by the Minister of Community Development, Territories and Infrastructure Oleksandr Kubrakov.
- In addition, the team of the Ministry of Infrastructure is working on the development of regular and irregular bus service between the states.

2:41 PM: Britain is considering giving Ukraine a prototype laser weapon that can shoot down drones and missiles, The Telegraph.

- Britain plans to adopt the DragonFire laser weapon by 2027. At the same time, the country is considering the possibility of sending prototypes of these weapons to Ukraine earlier, even if they will not be 100% improved.

4:16 PM: The Netherlands has allocated another €1 billion for military aid to Ukraine, as well as €400 million for reconstruction.

- This was announced by the President of Ukraine Volodymyr Zelenskyi.
- "This is in addition to the obligations within the framework of our bilateral security agreement," the president noted.

4:36 PM: A direct Iranian attack on Israel could happen within the next few hours.

- This was reported by CBS News with reference to American officials.
- Iran's attack is likely to include more than 100 drones and dozens of missiles aimed at military targets inside the country, officials said.

6:38 PM: Over the past two days, Polish border guards recorded 613 attempts to illegally cross the border from Belarus.

- This is reported by the Border Service of Poland.
- Migrants behaved aggressively. In particular, branches and stones were thrown at border guards and military patrols, and gas was also used against them.

8:31 PM: More than 50 rockets from Lebanon were fired at northern Israel, local media reported.

8:37 PM: The US is sending reinforcements to the Middle East amid fears of an Iranian attack, AFP reports.

9:41 PM: The European Council has approved a directive on criminal liability for violation or circumvention of EU sanctions in member states. Criminal offenses include:

- assistance to sanctioned persons to circumvent the entry ban;
- trading in sanctioned goods and conducting agreements with sanctioned states or organizations;
- conducting financial activities that are prohibited or restricted;
- concealment of ownership of funds or economic resources by sanctioned persons.

10:11 PM: The Ukrainian embassy, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Ukraine, officially opened in the African Ivory Coast.

- The opening of the embassy was justified by the desire to intensify comprehensive cooperation with Ivorian partners.

11:32 PM: US President urges Iran not to strike Israel.

- "Tehran will not succeed if it decides to use force," Joe Biden said.

12:30 AM: Air Force reports movement of strike UAVs:

- UAVs from Kirovohrad Oblast in the direction of Cherkasy Oblast, heading north;
- UAVs in the western part of the Mykolayiv region in the direction of the Vinnytsia region, heading north-west;
- UAVs in the eastern part of the Mykolaiv region, heading north-west;
- UAVs in the south of the Dnipropetrovsk region in the direction of the Dnipro;

2:47 AM: Air Force reports movement of strike UAVs:

- UAVs in the north-west of Vinnytsia enters the Khmelnytskyi region.
- UAVs in the Voronovitsa district of the Vinnytsia region, heading west.
- Several groups of UAVs in the eastern and southeastern part of Odesa on the border with Mykolaiv Oblast, heading north-west.

7:00 AM: Summary of the General Staff for April 9 as of 06:00 am April, 10

- During the past 24 hours, 97 combat clashes took place. In general, the enemy launched 2 rocket and 91 air strikes, carried out 160 attacks from rocket salvo systems on the positions of our troops and populated areas.
- **Details:**Over the past day, airstrikes have hit settlements in the Sumy, Kharkiv, Donetsk, and Zaporizhia regions.
- More than 110 settlements in the Chernihiv, Sumy, Kharkiv, Luhansk, Donetsk, Zaporizhzhya, Dnipropetrovsk, Kherson, and Mykolaiv regions were under artillery fire.
- On **Lymansky** direction, the enemy once attacked the positions of our defenders in the Torsky district of the Donetsk region.
- On **Bakhmutsky** direction, our soldiers repelled 33 attacks in the areas of the settlements of Bilogorivka in the Luhansk region and Verkhnyokamianske, Spirne, Vyimka, Rozdolivka, Chasiv Yar, Ivanivske, Klishchiivka, Andriivka in Donetsk region.
- On **Avdiivskyi** direction, our defenders repelled 18 attacks in the areas of Novokalynove, Novobakhmutivka, Berdychi, Pervomaiske and Netaivlove settlements of the Donetsk region.
- On **Novopavlovskyi** direction Defense forces continue to restrain the enemy in the areas of Krasnohorivka, Georgiyivka, Novomykhailivka,

Kostyantynivka, Vodyane, Urozhaine settlements of the Donetsk region, where the enemy tried 29 times to break through the defenses of our troops.

- On **Orihivskyi** direction, the occupiers attacked the positions of our defenders 7 times in the districts of Staromayorskyi, Donetsk region, and Robotyny, Zaporozhye.
- On **Khersonskyi** direction, the enemy does not give up its intention to knock out our units from the bridgeheads on the left bank of the Dnieper. So, during the past day, the enemy made 6 unsuccessful attacks on the positions of our troops.
- At the same time, our soldiers continue to actively inflict losses in manpower and equipment on the occupying troops, exhausting the enemy along the entire line of battle.
- During the past day **aviation** The Defense Forces struck 12 areas of concentration of personnel, weapons and military equipment and 4 anti-aircraft missile complexes of the enemy. Also, one Kh-59 guided air missile was destroyed by the forces and means of air defense of Ukraine.
- Subdivisions **rocket** troops were damaged in 1 personnel concentration area, 2 anti-aircraft defense means, 1 enemy EW station.

7:25 AM: Ukrainian Anti-Aircraft Defense destroyed 16 out of 17 Shahed-131/136 attack drones in Mykolaiv, Odesa, Kherson, Dnipropetrovsk, Vinnytsia and Khmelnytskyi regions overnight, Air Force Commander Mykola Oleschuk said.

- According to his data, the Russians attacked at night with 17 attack drones and a Kh-59 guided air missile.

9:45 AM: It's embarrassing to admit, but 8 out of 10 people don't know a single quote by Taras Shevchenko.

11:37 AM: The government approved additional payments of 70,000 hryvnias to the military "at zero".

- Fighters who fight on the front line will receive a salary (20-25 thousand hryvnias), combat allowance (100 thousand) and an additional 70 thousand for every 30 days at the front.

11:58 AM: The bodies of 99 fallen soldiers were returned to Ukraine, — Coordination Headquarters.

- It was possible to repatriate 77 bodies of defenders from the Donetsk region, 20 from the Zaporizhia region, and 2 from the Kharkiv region.

1:14 PM: Andrii Sybiga was appointed deputy head of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in place of Mykola Tochytskyi.

- Such an order was adopted by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine today at a government meeting, the press service reports.

2:03 PM: The Cabinet of Ministers has allocated an additional UAH 3.88 billion for the further construction of defense lines, Prime Minister Denys Shmyhal said.

- According to him, of these funds, 1.7 billion UAH will be for the Kharkiv region, and 1.5 billion UAH for fortifications in the Sumy region.
- Donetsk, Kherson and Mykolaiv regions will also receive an additional resource.

3:41 PM: Russians are hitting Ukrainian TPPs with missiles that contain components from Western and Asian countries.

- This was stated by the head of the OP Andriy Yermak.

4:04 PM: An air alert has been issued in a number of areas.

5:00 PM: An air alert has been issued in a number of areas.

5:32 PM: The General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine found opportunities to send brigades to rest one by one.

- "Such a decision was made, in particular, after reviewing the numbers of certain units that do not take part in hostilities. Thousands of freed servicemen were sent to combat units," the message says.
- Accordingly, a set of measures is being taken to strengthen the brigades that continue to perform combat tasks at the front.

6:26 PM: The government has adopted a decision that will allow financing the purchase of EW for critical infrastructure facilities.

- This was announced by the Prime Minister of Ukraine, Denys Shmyhal.
- The Prime Minister also talked about the decentralization of the energy system — there are already more than 120 small cogeneration plants.

7:13 PM: Air Force reports ballistic missile threat.

7:18 PM: UAV operators from "Azov" conduct reconnaissance and work by dropping ammunition on enemy positions.

- "On the front lines, drones are a necessity. Their characteristic sound almost never leaves the battlefield," the press service of the brigade writes.

9:00 PM: Summary of the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine as of the evening of April 12:

- 81 combat clashes were recorded during the day.
- Aviation of the Defense Forces struck 12 areas of concentration of personnel, weapons and military equipment and 4 anti-aircraft missile complexes of the enemy.
- Units of the missile forces hit 2 anti-aircraft defenses and 1 enemy EW station.

9:18 PM: The court extended the arrest of Roman Hrynkevich for another two months.

- However, he reduced the amount of the pledge from 469 to 393 million hryvnias. Hrynkevich's lawyer Andriy Gujhal informed Suspilno about this.
- Roman Hrynkevich is one of our best doctors. Thank you for bringing back to life our soldiers who defend Ukraine. Thank you for this struggle," the president emphasized.

9:53 PM: Air Force reports enemy tactical aircraft activity in the east. There is a threat of using aviation weapons.

10:30 PM: Ukraine is negotiating to receive two Patriot batteries and one Samp-T, Ukrainian Foreign Minister Dmytro Kuleba said in a telethon.

- "All Patriot batteries ultimately depend on the US decision, because it is an American system. We know exactly where and what is."
- At the same time, our state could receive an air defense system within weeks.

11:14 PM: Data on hundreds of thousands of possible evaders are in the police databases, they are already being checked, Minister of Internal Affairs Klymenko said.

- In addition, the police are massively looking for Ukrainians who received a summons and did not come to the TCC.

11:47 PM: DTEK showed one of its TPPs after two missile attacks.

MORDOR – ruZZia

11:05 AM: The Kremlin is sending troops of the Pacific Fleet of the Russian Federation to the war against Ukraine, GUR MOU.

- In order to replenish the sanitary and irreversible losses of the Russian occupation forces, as well as to staff new military units, Moscow is sending to war the personnel of the Pacific Fleet of the Russian Federation, as well as the 11th Army of the Air Force and Air Defense Forces.
- It is about 2,000 Russian servicemen from the Primorsky Krai and Kamchatka regions of the Russian Federation.

11:46 AM: In the Russian city of Belgorod, a drone hit the administrative building of Gazprom, — rosZMI.

- The governor announced that two were injured, and the Russian Ministry of Defense announced that 5 Ukrainian drones had been shot down over the region.

2:51 PM: In Moscow, ex-SBU employee Vasyl Proznorov was blown up, rosZMI.

- The car exploded when the man tried to start it.
- Currently, Prozorov is in the hospital, and the so-called Investigative Committee of the Russian Federation has opened a criminal case under the article about "attempted murder".
- _Prozorov previously admitted that he was a spy for the Russian Federation for four years, passing information to the enemy about the

progress of the anti-terrorist operation — a few years ago, the traitor fled to Russia._

4:52 PM: Self-proclaimed President Lukashenko explained why Belarus does not go to war against Ukraine:

- "If we went to war against Ukraine today, it wouldn't help. Because their border with Belarus is "barricaded" in such a way that we can't get there. It is completely mined, concreted_ [...]"

6:52 PM: FSB officers systematically harassed and beat Ukrainians trying to get to EU countries through the Estonian-Russian border.

- This was reported by Postimees with reference to the yearbook of the Estonian Security Police.
- According to the Ukrainians, there were "conversations" with them that were more like interrogations, they were forced to fill out questionnaires, their means of communication were checked and data were collected, including beatings.
- During the examination, people were forced to strip down to their underwear, after which they were photographed.

7:38 PM: Takeoff of the MiG-31K from Savasleika airfield (Nizhny Novgorod region), — Air Force Command.

8:21 PM: The Ministry of Defense of the Russian Federation reports on the successful test of an intercontinental ballistic missile.

- These are missiles carrying thermonuclear weapons.

SUMY



3:01 PM Social Networks: An explosion is heard in Sumy.

4:01 PM: The enemy carried out an airstrike on the civilian infrastructure of the city of Sumy - no people were injured.

- This is reported by Sumy RMA.
- All the necessary services are working on the spot, the consequences of the impact are being clarified.

5:13 PM: As a result of a Russian airstrike on civilian infrastructure and the residential sector in Sumy, three people were injured, — RMA.

- Also, as a result of the impact, the roof of a non-residential building was partially destroyed, and a fire broke out. Employees of the State Emergency Service have already extinguished the fire.

KHARKIV



3:22 PM: A 65-year-old man died as a result of Russian strikes on Kupyansk-Vuzlovo in Kharkiv Oblast, — National Police.

- The Russian army also shelled Vovchansk and Monachynivka, 3 casualties are known.

10:47 PM: To the authorities of Kharkiv, the lost revenues will be compensated from the state budget, which will help reduce the tax burden on the city.

DONETSK



10:59 PM: As a result of Russian strikes on New York in Donetsk region, a woman was killed and a man was wounded.

- This was reported by the head of the Donetsk RMA, Vadym Filashkin.

ZAPORIZHIA



1:40 PM: More than 1,000 residents of the temporarily occupied territories of the Zaporizhzhia region are in Russian captivity.

- This was announced by Ivan Fedorov, the head of the Zaporizhzhia RMA.

DNIPRO



10:25 AM: The Air Force reports a missile threat in the Dnipropetrovsk and Zaporizhzhia regions.

4:27 PM: Guided air missile in the direction of Kryvyi Rih, — Air Force Command.

4:34 PM Social Networks: Explosions are heard in Dnipropetrovsk region.

5:43 PM: Anti-Aircraft Defense forces shot down an enemy missile over Kryvorizky district.

- This was reported by the head of Dnipropetrovsk RMA Serhii Lysak.
- Falling debris caused a fire, damaged the roof of a private house. A 28-year-old woman was injured, but her condition is satisfactory.

KHERSON



10:35 AM: Russian troops attacked a residential building in the village of Kachkarivka, Kherson region, from a drone, — RMA.

- A 49-year-old local resident was injured as a result of dropping explosives from a drone in his own home. The victim is now in the hospital.

8:01 AM: The number of dead as a result of the Russian attack on Mykolaiv on April 11 has increased to 5 people, - RMA

- A 37-year-old man died in the hospital, who was seriously injured as a result of yesterday's shelling by the Russian Federation, noted the head of Mykolaiv RMA Vitaly Kim.

ODESSA



10:05 AM: The death toll from the Russian attack on Odesa on April 10 has risen to 6, the Prosecutor General's Office reported.

- A 56-year-old man died in the hospital.

2:44 AM: UAVs from the north in the direction of Starokostyantynov, - Air Force Command.

2:55 AM Social Networks: An explosion is heard in the Khmelnytskyi region.
