<u>Tomorrow Should be a Milestone</u> – Ukrainska Pravda reported in today's edition that Russian casualties have reached 599,350 dead, seriously wounded, and missing. Based on recent daily casualty figures of over 1,100 per day, tomorrow the number of Russian casualties should reach over 600,000.

We have said in the past that the grinding fighting in Eastern Ukraine is not the type of fighting Ukraine is good at. Grinding offensives, including meatwaves, artillery and glide bombs is Russia's game, not Ukraine's. Therefore, Ukraine should use its increasing supply from the West of 155mm artillery rounds, superior artillery and, at a minimum, parity in drones, to incur maximum Russian casualties, and slow the Russian offensive in Donbas, and at the same time, isolate Crimea, and hit Russian air bases and logistics.

To this end, the West should focus its supplies to help Ukraine drain Russia's ability to press its Donbas offensive, while increasing supplies for air defense and, above all, end all restrictions on the use of Western weapons against military targets inside Russia.

The type of war Ukraine IS good at is the way its conducting operations in Kursk Oblast, and in 2022 in Kherson and Kharkiv Oblasts, namely a war of

maneuver and confusion. Rather than arguing that Kursk takes away manpower in Donbas, as many of the pundits do, Kursk should be seen as a complement to Ukraine's operations in Donbas, the Black Sea and Crimea. Together these campaigns, if enhanced by Western military supplies delivered on a timely basis, a big "IF" if past performance is any indication, will eventually bleed Russia dry, maybe sooner rather than later.

I agree with everything Anders Aslund said in his article, except for this — "The Biden administration merely claims that it will support Ukraine "for as long as it takes," whereas Harris's Republican challenger, Donald Trump, promises to end the war in a day, implying complete capitulation to the Kremlin." It's almost certain that if it wasn't for Trump the \$61 billion Ukraine Supplemental would've have died in Congress, because it is virtually certain that in a meeting at Mar-a-Lago Trump gave the green light to Speaker Michael Johnson to bring the Ukraine Supplemental to the House Floor. Lindsay Graham a staunch Ukraine supporter who is also close to Trump, to forge a bi-partisan consensus similar to the bi-partisan consensus on foreign policy that this country enjoyed for 70+ years since the end of WW-II. The absence of a bi-partisan consensus is almost certainly being used by both China and Russia to sow discord in the United States, over Ukraine, Taiwan and other foreign policy and national security issues. Why give Russia & China the gift that they turn around and willingly use against the United States?

7:31 AM: Japan will hand over demining equipment ordered from Ukrainian enterprises to the State Emergency Service

- The Japan International Cooperation Agency ordered 12 minibuses for the State Emergency Service from the Ukrainian company Cherkasy Bus. They planned to hand them over in November. In addition, "TRANS-AVTO-D" was ordered to manufacture eight trailers for the transportation of demining machines: the trailers are mounted on IVECO trucks. In July, the rescuers already received four such trucks, the transfer of four more is planned for September.
- Japanese Ambassador Kuninori Matsuda noted that his country will continue to search for the best combination of "Made in Japan" and "Made in Ukraine" formats to ensure that "only the highest quality equipment and vehicles will be transferred to Ukraine."

8:40 AM: Air Defense forces destroyed all 14 drones overnight in Mykolaiv, Cherkasy, Poltava, Dnipropetrovsk, Zaporizhia and Kyiv regions.

10:03 AM: A temple for the military was opened in the Kyiv-Pechersk Lavra.

- The first service has already been held there, attended by military chaplains, soldiers, cadets and the wounded undergoing treatment.
- Military chaplains together with monks of the Lavra, led by Bishop Avraamii, will conduct the service in the "Living Source" church.

10:40 AM: Volodymyr Zelenskyi showed Ukrainian weapons and their results.

• "At sea: Neptune, Sea Baby, MAGURA V5. On land: Bohdana, Stugna, Corsair. In the air: Beaver, Morok, Lutyy," the president wrote.

11:25 AM: Secret talks with Russia on a partial ceasefire were disrupted by Ukraine's offensive in Kursk, — WP.

- The parties were due to send delegations to Doha, Qatar this month to negotiate a deal that would end attacks on energy targets. Russia did not cancel the negotiations but said: "Give us time." The summit was agreed on on August 22.
- 1:23 PM: Volodymyr Zhovnir, the general director of NDSL "Okhmatdyt", has been suspended from his duties until the inspections are completed, Minister Lyashko reports.
 - The situation is related to the restoration of Okhmatdyt buildings and the actions of the Charitable Foundation
 - "Okhmatdyt" healthy childhood"

2:00 PM: GUR showed how special forces of the Military Intelligence of Ukraine destroyed Russian "motorcycle shooters" in close combat.

2:32 PM: Chief of Staff of the Armed Forces Sirsky reported to the president about the events at the front:

- Toretsky and Pokrovsky directions dozens of Russian assaults per day, but the situation is under control.
- The operation in the Kursk region is to strengthen the positions of our forces and expand the stabilized territory. There is another replenishment of the exchange fund.

5:24 PM: In Ukraine, they are preparing to cancel the subsistence minimum — a special social payment will be introduced instead, reports Minister of Social Policy Zholnovich.

- According to her, such a payment will be provided in certain cases, and the amount will be influenced by the "composition of the family and household."
- The official noted that the current subsistence minimum does not correspond to reality, as its size is too small.

5:55 PM: No blackouts are planned for tomorrow, Ukrenergo reports.

6:34 PM: The Council of Churches supported the banning of the UOC (MP) in Ukraine, according to the VRCiRO website.

 "The Moscow Patriarchate justifies pogroms and restrictions on religious freedom, torture and murder of priests and pastors," they wrote in a joint statement.

6:47 PM: Soldiers of 225 OSHB captured the company commander of the occupiers.

- However, he was left without a soldier, since the majority had already been liquidated. And the remnants run away across the field.
- "Our new "friend" wants to join the action in support of the captured heroes from Azovstal and will be happy if he is exchanged," the battalion's fighters write.

7:46 PM: Oleksandr Urin became acting general director of "Okhmatdyt".

- Previously, he headed the department of intensive and efferent therapy of acute intoxications.
- Ex-director of "Okhmatdyt" Volodymyr Zhovnir has been suspended until the inspections are completed.

8:01 PM: For the second day in a row, Monobank has been subjected to massive DDoS attacks, reports co-founder Oleg Horohovskyi.

- Basically, under the blows accounts for donations to the armed forces.
- "We are holding on so that you can help us and continue supporting the armed forces," Horokhovsky writes.

8:46 PM: The prosecutor's office began investigating the alleged beheading of a Ukrainian soldier, — Office of the Prosecutor General.

 "The distribution of such a video by representatives of the Russian Federation once again proves their complete disregard for the norms and principles of international humanitarian law," the prosecutor's office said.

9:24 PM: Forces of the 33rd OMBr repulsed several enemy assaults near the village of Pobieda in the Kurakhiv direction.

 Mechanized amphibious assaults were stopped by mortar and artillery fire.

9:40 PM: Soldiers of the 225 OSHB showed a video of the escape of the company commander, whom they captured.

9:42 PM: He has titles and passports from the Russian Federation and is a lawyer from Tatarova's former firm, he is suspected of the murders of Maidan citizens: the Pechersk court has released the ex-commander of Lviv "Berkut" Rostyslav Pacelyak on bail of 1 million hryvnias.

• This was reported by the representative of the "Neskorenyi Maidan" public organization Roksolana Khmara, the wife of the dissident Stepan Khmara.

10:25 PM: From September, officers of the educational security service will start working in educational institutions, the Ministry of Internal Affairs said.

• They will be responsible for the law enforcement function, patrolling and ensuring protection of the participants in the educational process.

11:21 PM: UOC-MP communities will receive 9 months to "get off" from Moscow - Stefanchuk

- The revised draft law No. 8371 provides for a legal mechanism for checking the communities of the Moscow Patriarchate for connections with the Russian Orthodox Church. 9 months will be allocated for this
- "People should be determined in their faith, in their direction," the head of the Verkhovna Rada added.

11:41 PM: People's deputy Dmytruk is outraged by the "actions of the Armed Forces" in the Kursk region. In response, officer Karas announced a "hunt" for the politician

- A former representative of the Servant of the People party spread pro-Russian narratives about alleged abuse of civilians by Ukrainian soldiers and looting.
- "Is there anything "heroic" or "patriotic" in this? No, of course. This is pure work against us. And it's not just about the moral aspect. Every such incident works against us!" said People's Deputy Dmytruk.
- One of the first to react to Artem Dmytruk's words was Yevhen Karas, an officer and deputy commander of the 14th regiment of the Armed

Forces. Karas announced a "hunt" for the people's deputy who works for the Russian Federation.

- According to DeepState, the terrorists committed the crime in Kolotylivka, on the state border of Ukraine with the Belgorod region.

- "I appealed to the UN and the ICRC regarding another act of violation of international humanitarian law by the Russian side. I also note that the enemy uses such videos to intimidate and demoralize Ukrainians. - We do not have any "dirty bombs" and do not plan to acquire them, said the spokesman of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Heorhiy Tyhiy.

- In particular, he said that he conducts live broadcasts on YouTube and Tik Tok, which are joined by residents of the temporarily occupied territories of Ukraine.
- "Tonight and a week ago, I noticed a very interesting trend: those people from Mariupol who do not support us, who do not wait for us, but support Putin, Russia, have become less cheerful. They no longer have slogans like: Russia, the second army of the world, they are confused, "at a loss". That is, they say to me: "Listen, we don't understand what is happening in the Kursk region, we don't understand what's going on with Putin, he couldn't do that, he had to respond harshly somehow, but that's not the case." And I can see that it's beginning to dawn on them that Russia is not there forever, that's obvious," he said.

2:17 PM: Not protected by Air Defense systems: partisans captured warehouses and hangars with Russian equipment in the Crimean Mountains

- "Our agents have installed technical surveillance systems for the military base of the 126th Separate Guards Brigade of Coastal Defense and the 8th Separate Artillery Regiment," the message reads.
- Thus, the partisans managed to record important information about the storage, movement of military equipment and ammunition. Agents also note that the base is not even covered by means of Air Defense.

3:22 PM: Cyber specialists of the State Security Service paralyzed the work of a Russian nuclear weapons developer.

As a result of a successful attack on the only provider - the company
 "Vega" - a number of strategic enterprises remain without the Internet and communication services for almost a week.

• Including "VNIITF" — a company developing nuclear munitions. A successful attack made it possible to obtain personal data of employees and an array of other documents of the specified plant.

3:50 PM: Ukrainian soldiers captured another "party of Chechens", according to the network.

• "We are happy that we fell into your hands," say the militant.

4:38 PM: Of all the states "friendly" to Russia, only Syria condemned the operation of the Armed Forces of Ukraine in the Kursk region, — Deutsche Welle.

- Meanwhile, China's Foreign Ministry briefly noted that Beijing "has paid attention to the situation."
- As The Moscow Times writes, the CSTO and its member countries also did not condemn the actions of the Ukrainian Armed Forces.

5:04 PM: The Ukrainian army entered the district center of Korenevo in Kurshchyna, - journalist Tsaplienko

• "Ours took Korenevo in the Kursk region. This is reported by the fighters. Although it has not been officially confirmed," Tsaplienko noted.

8:25 PM: The world's largest oil services company SLB is expanding its business in Russia, Financial Times.

- SLB signed new contracts and hired hundreds of employees in the Russian Federation after its biggest Western competitors pulled out of the Russian market.
- A year ago, the company announced that it would stop supplying products and technologies to the Russian Federation, but this was just empty talk.

9:02 PM: Belarus is helping Russia to modernize Iranian "Shaheds", — Center of National Resistance.

• At one of the factories in Gomel, the Russians have developed a process of painting Iranian drones black to disguise night launches.

9:23 PM: Why did 100 Russian conscripts simultaneously surrender to the SBU in Kurshchyna: British analyst Clarke named the probable reason

- According to him, the soldiers of the Russian 488th Rifle Regiment of the Armed Forces of the Russian Federation, which are mostly conscripts, fled the battlefield because they encountered a large unit of Ukrainian troops.
- As they fled deep into the Russian rear, they were fired upon by the Chechens, who were there "to stop their escape," Clark explained.

10:20 PM: The Russians resettled the evacuated residents of Kursk in the occupied Kyrylivka resort

 In Berdyansk, Primorsk and other cities of the Azov region, a mass flow of "evacuees" has not yet been observed.

10:46 PM: A Ukrainian soldier shares his food with a child at a fire pit while locals collect water.

• While Russian propagandists shout about "atrocities", our boys prove the opposite with their actions.

11:03 PM: The elderly man from Kursk, whose murder Russia accused the Ukrainian military, is actually alive - TsPD

8:34 AM: The occupiers in Donetsk region replenish military losses with alcoholics and violators of discipline, partisans

• They note that in the Donetsk direction, the occupiers are forcibly recruiting people from among alcoholics and violators of discipline to defend the positions of the brigade.

 According to the partisans, in fact, any serviceman, from private to officer, who appears in Krasnohorivka in an untidy manner will automatically be sent to the assault squads. The military police like to manipulate this, and even in the conditional rear, they can find fault with unshavenness.

2:33 PM: The occupiers hit Kramatorsk: a two-story building was destroyed, a person is under the rubble

- Five explosions rang out in the city during the day. One of the Russian Smerch rockets hit a two-story building, the others hit an industrial zone. The gas pipeline was also damaged by debris.

- According to the investigation, the suspects communicated with the Russian special services through social networks. They were given the task of setting fire to relay cabinets on the railway, recording the results of shelling, and discrediting the work of the TCC. For this, the Russians, after receiving the evidence, gave them a small reward.
- It is indicated that three people from Odessa were detained during the sabotage. They once again tried to set fire to the relay cabinet of Ukrzaliznytsia, choosing a remote section of tracks without lighting.

7:51 PM: A monument to Pushkin was dismantled in Bilhorod-Dnistrovskyi, Odesa region

- The monument was located in Olympic Square, which used to bear the poet's name.
- Recently, the inscriptions "Take me down" began to appear more and more often on it.
