Russian Invasion of Ukraine

The Soviet Union fought Nazi Germany for three years, ten months and three weeks from June 22, 1941 to May 8, 1945. Ukraine has been fighting Russian invaders for three years, five months, four weeks and 1 day. The end of WWII led to a new order. The same will happen again.

Later in this email Bohdan produced a map showing the origins and trajectories of the big Russian missile strike last Wednesday night and Thursday morning, Ukraine Time. On the lower left-hand corner, you can see the cruise missile that hit the American manufacturing plant in Zakarpattia Oblast. On the upper left-hand corner where you see two missiles (yellow lines) and a number of drones, is Lutsk. An American friend of mine is currently living in Lutsk. He's married to a Ukrainian originally from Lutsk, and they have a 1-year-old daughter. Lutsk is also on the route that western weapons deliveries take, when coming in from the distribution hub in Poland.

["Kherson – Human Safari"](#)/A Film by Zarina Zabrisky

The link contains the full-length film, lasting just over 1 hour which I encourage you all to watch, a trailer, and many other resources telling the story of Kherson, from its occupation by Russia starting in late February and early March, 2022, the beginning of the resistance, life during liberation in November 2022, the destruction of the Nova Kakhovka Dam on June 6th, 2023, up until today, as Kherson is experiencing the Russian "Human Safari,"

the hunting and murdering of its citizens by Russian FPV drones, being launched by Russian troops who are approximately 5 miles away on the Left Bank of the Dnipro River.

Since the start of Russia's latest invasion, Kherson is the only Ukrainian oblast capital to be occupied by Russia. The occupation was likely the result of treasonous activities by Ukrainians serving in the Army and the SBU. We may never know the true circumstances.

I visited Kherson once, in the Summer of 2012, when I was living in Kyiv and on an assignment. The central part of the city sits on a bluff on the Right Bank of the Dnipro River. A large portion of the city, including a major port, lie along the banks of the Dnipro below the central district, plus a large island a short distance downstream. These parts of Kherson were inundated by the flooding created by the Russian destruction of the Kakhovka Dam.

The Antonovskiy Bridge connects central Kherson with the Left Bank of the Dnipro, the portion of Kherson Oblast still occupied by Russia. A major portion of Ukraine's farmland that is irrigated is in this part of Kherson Oblast. The source of water was the North Crimean Canal, that begins at the Kakhovka Dam, flows into Crimea, and supplied Crimea with virtually all its surface water. Because of the destruction of the Kakhovka Dam, Crimea is now largely without any surface water.

When I was in Kherson we drove across the bridge, and we met with a farmer who was cultivating approximately 2,500 acres (1,200 hectares) of potatoes. He sold his potatoes to Fozzy, the parent company of Silpo, a large chain of supermarkets in Ukraine. His potatoes were sold in a brown paper bag showing his company's name. I've often wondered what happened to him, and the 430 residents of the village who were, simultaneously, lessors of the farmland and employees of the farm.

The movie includes an account of the looting of Kherson's cultural patrimony, including the exhumation and removal of the body of Prince Potemkin, of "Potemkin Village" fame and Catherine the Great's lover, and

the [kidnapping of a racoon from the Kherson Zoo](#). The raccoon became celebrity, with one meme showing meeting with Putin across Putin's desk.

The occupations of Bucha and Irpin lasted around 1 month. The occupation of Kherson lasted 8 months, not including flooding of much of the city plus its people being subjected to the continuing Human Safari.

In my opinion, "Kherson: Human Safari" ranks alongside other recent acclaimed documentaries about the war, including "20 Days in Mariupol" that won the Academy Award for best full-length documentary.

["Ukraine's Black Sea Triumph: How Asymmetrical Warfare Crippled Russia's Fleet"](#) /Chuck Pfarrer via Kyiv Post's "Point of Impact"

As a "Former Naval Person," there are few more things that are as enjoyable as reporting on Ukraine's naval successes. This video starts with the sinking of the cruiser "Moskva" and takes us up to the present, Ukraine's recent operation on a spit of land at the Mouth of the Dnipro River. Some observations:

- Cruiser Moskva – The story I heard is somewhat different from Pfarrer's telling. I had heard that rather than Moskva turning its air search radar off, Moskva had the radar pointed in the opposite direction, away from the Neptune Missiles. The radar was pointed at a Bayraktar drone, that Ukraine had deployed as a decoy for exactly this purpose.
- Moskva – Ukraine benefitted from support by U.S. intelligence, pinpointing Moskva's location.
- Moskva – From looking at the burning ship, it seems clear that Russians haven't learned how to properly counter-flood, to keep a damaged ship on an even keel. Counter-flooding is the process of flooding spaces below the waterline, opposite the damage to avoid a list that would cause the ship to capsize. Proper counter-flooding might've saved Moskva.
- Ukraine's Riverine Force – As Pfarrer states, Ukraine's Riverine Force attacked a Russian installation on the Tendrovo Spit, at the Mouth of the Dnipro in Kherson Oblast. This area is becoming a greater priority

for Ukraine, in its effort to re-open the Port of Mykolaiv. The Riverine Force is also active upstream on the Dnipro, trying to stop Russia from occupying the islands in the Dnipro Delta. They've been using small boats that they have obtained from both the U.S. and the U.K.

One of my many problems with the coverage of the war by the Pundits is that they tend to look at ground operations as being divorced from Kyiv's success in taking the war to Russian territory, where oil production has been curtailed, and ammunition supplies hit and, of course, Ukraine's success in the Black Sea. The result is there perception that Russia continuing to move forward, but under increasing logistical strain. This, in run, influences public policy as to whether Ukraine should give up land for peace.

["Ukraine to mass produce long-range Flamingo missile in winter, Zelensky says"](#)/Kyiv Independent

The Flamingo missile has a range of 3,000 km., a 1,150 kg. warhead, and a speed of approximately 600 mph. It has internal guidance, resistant to jamming. Apparently, a Flamingo has been used once, on a target in Crimea. The Flamingo takes the physical size of Russia's land mass out the equation.

With the Flamingo improving Ukraine's ability to hit Russian targets far inside Russia, especially oil refineries and ammunition dumps, the calculus may be changing. Time may now be on Ukraine's side, rather than on Russia's as the pundits always claim. The British Ministry of Defense calculated that it would take Russia 4 years and 1.9 million casualties to conquer Ukraine's fortified cities of Sloviansk and Kramatorsk, in the portion of Donetsk Oblast held by Ukraine. Separately, the Financial Times calculates that in 12-18 months Russia's economy will start to buckle. Putin is trying hard to get Trump to force Zelenskyy to agree to give up the rest of Donetsk Oblast as part of a peace deal. It is understandable why Putin is trying so hard to get Trump to carry his water on this issue.

["The Second Channel Russia and Ukraine use to Trade Prisoners of War"](#)/Wall Street Journal

This is a fascinating article showing how despite the nastiness of this war, the Russia and Ukraine still manage to trade prisoners of war. Some excerpts:

- Europe's largest wave of prisoner exchanges since the wake of World War II was set in motion when a Ukrainian soldier reached into the pocket of a dead Russian officer and found a phone. The device landed in the hands of Brig. Gen. Dmytro Usov, a deputy to the head of Ukraine's HUR military intelligence service, which had just lost two of its men in battles northwest of Kyiv. Russia's invasion of Ukraine was only three weeks old, and the phone presented a way to retrieve their remains. Usov, a career intelligence officer with a trim gray-streaked beard, scrolled through the deceased's phonebook and pressed "call" on a contact whose rank suggested this might be a Russian frontline commander. "Your officer is dead," he told the stunned Russian after introducing himself. He texted a photograph of the corpse, then offered a deal: the bodies of your men for ours. What followed has evolved into one of the strangest subplots of Europe's biggest war since the 1940s: a series of swaps that started with a few corpses and then slowly escalated into the regular trade of hundreds of captured prisoners, many skeletal and barely clinging to consciousness.
- Despite being snared in conflict and deadlocked at the negotiating table, both sides speak of their shadowy prisoner exchange channel—run directly by military intelligence officers—as efficient and professional. Their transactions mark a striking paradox: two bitter enemies aligned on almost nothing, yet collaborating time and again on one deeply human issue—prisoners of war.
- Military historians have puzzled over the relatively smooth logistics and regular pace of these trades, conducted mid-conflict, a pattern virtually unheard of in modern warfare. By contrast, the Soviet Union held on to German POWs for years after World War II. Some weren't freed until 1956. The United States and North Vietnam didn't begin consistent POW releases until 1973, after two decades of American deepening involvement and a long, grinding peace process. Iran and

Iraq, whose war ended in 1988, released their last POWs three days before the 2003 U.S. invasion of Iraq began.

- “If there’s a chance to save a human life, returning someone home to their family before hostilities end, and in the process free our own soldiers whom we deeply care about it, then we do it,” said Russia’s chief negotiator on Ukraine, Vladimir Medinsky, who used a Russian idiom to emphasise that the neighbors remain mortal enemies: “As we say in Russia, we don’t christen our children together.”

Maybe I’m wrong, but things may be getting more difficult for the Russians fighting along the Donbas Line. Pokrovsk is not the only place where Russian offensives are being reversed. This report is from Sumy, opposite Kursk, where Russia had reportedly amassed more than 100,000 troops. The question is what is stopping Russia from deploying these troops against a much smaller number of Ukrainians in Sumy? Perhaps a lack of vehicles, armored personnel carriers, and lack of fuel all have something to do with it.

Wednesday, August 20

8:01 AM: The EU will continue the pressure on Russia's military economy. The next (19) package of sanctions against Moscow should be ready by next month, said the High Representative of the European Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy, Kaya Callas.

8:01 AM: Elon Musk is putting the brakes on plans to start a political party to avoid taking voters away from Republicans, The Wall Street Journal.

8:01 AM: MEPs nominate Serbian student protesters for the Sakharov Prize for Freedom of Thought, Beta Briefing.

9:10 AM: White House wants to hold Zelenskyi-Putin summit in Budapest, Politico.

- As the publication notes, the US Secret Service is preparing for a summit in Hungary. Geneva, Vienna, Rome, Budapest and Doha are also being considered as venues.

- Geneva (Switzerland) is considered the best option, while Russians do not like Rome or the Vatican, and Ukrainians do not like Budapest.

10:29 AM: The US may provide air support to Ukraine as part of a potential peace agreement with the Russian Federation, Donald Trump said in an interview with Fox News.

- White House press secretary Caroline Leavitt also mentioned this the day before. According to her, US air support is "an option and a possibility".

11:03 AM: Britain is ready to send troops to protect Ukraine's skies and seas, but not to the front line, The Guardian.

- Chief of the General Staff Tony Radakin will take part in a meeting at the Pentagon on Wednesday, where the contribution of 30 countries to Ukraine's security will be determined.
- Previously, the deployment of up to 30,000 troops was discussed, but this figure was reduced due to the opposition of some European states.

11:51 AM: The White House has launched an official TikTok account.

- The first video featured an address by Donald Trump saying, "I am your voice," and the caption for the clip read, "America, we're BACK! Hello, TikTok?".
- This decision has already caused criticism among some lawmakers, because as early as 2024, they tried to ban the platform in the US due to national security risks.

5:19 PM: Despite US pressure: India resumes purchases of Russian oil after brief hiatus, Bloomberg

- The country's state-owned refineries have already purchased a batch of Urals oil this week, which will be shipped in September and October. In addition, India also received a discount on this oil - "minus" \$2.5 per barrel.
- Meanwhile, the Kremlin says it will help New Delhi deal with customs pressure and increase trade.

6:38 PM: A Russian "shaheed" fell and exploded in Poland tonight, PAP said with reference to the Polish Ministry of Defense.

- The drone fell in a corn field 100 km from the border. It is probably a "drone simulator" with a small amount of explosives.
- Windows were broken in several houses, and there were no casualties. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Poland has already announced that it will issue a protest to the "culprit".

7:14 PM: America is selling weapons to Europe for Ukraine with a 10% markup, US Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent said.

- According to him, this can cover the US costs for arming Ukraine within the limits of security guarantees, including the protection of the Ukrainian sky.
- In addition, the States expect compensation for the invested money after the end of the war thanks to the economic partnership with Ukraine.

7:28 PM: Poland will not send its troops to Ukraine after the end of the war, the country's Defense Minister Władysław Kosiniak-Kamys said.

- According to him, the Polish army has other tasks, including protecting NATO's eastern flank and providing logistics for a potential "peacekeeping mission."
- Meanwhile, Estonia has declared that it is ready to provide Ukraine with its contingent in the size of one company.

9:28 PM: Poland confirmed the explosion of a Russian drone near Lublin.

- Minister of Defense Władysław Kosiniak-Kamys said that it is a provocation by Russia at a time when peace talks are ongoing and there is hope for the end of the war in Ukraine.

11:00 PM: Britain and EU countries are preparing new sanctions against Russia in case Putin refuses to meet with Zelensky and Trump, The Telegraph.

- The publication notes that the head of the Kremlin agreed to meet with Trump in Alaska only after the US president introduced additional tariffs of 25% against India.

11:06 PM: The Netherlands will deploy two Patriot air defense systems to Poland along with 300 troops to protect NATO's logistical support and training center for Ukraine, Defense Minister Ruben Breckelmans said.

- The unit will also include the NASAMS system and means of combating drones.
- The minister emphasized that this deployment has three key goals: protecting NATO territory, deterring Russian aggression, and strengthening support for Ukraine.

11:17 PM: On The Mark Levin Show, Trump compared occupied Crimea to Texas and said the peninsula is "in the middle of the ocean."

- The politician accused Obama of having "gifted" Crimea to Russia, and added: if he had done it himself, "they would have been talking about it for 20 years."
- In fact, the area of Texas is more than 695,000 km², which is almost 26 times larger than Crimea (27,000 km²) and even more than all of Ukraine (603,000 km²).

Thursday, August 21

12:00 AM: Sweden can strengthen Ukraine's security in the air and at sea, Prime Minister Ulf Kristersson said.

- After the summits in Washington, Stockholm is ready to provide air reconnaissance and naval resources.
- According to him, it is not about sending large ground units, but about supporting Ukraine's ability to defend itself.

8:00 AM: The US has imposed new sanctions against two judges and two deputy prosecutors of the International Criminal Court. They are accused of "persecuting" citizens of Israel and the United States.

8:00 AM: Britain announced a new package of sanctions amid increased international efforts to achieve a "just and lasting peace" in Ukraine.

8:00AM: Russia is selling oil to China through Iran's shadowy infrastructure, FT investigation says.

8:00 AM: The Israel Defense Forces launched an offensive against Gaza City.

4:36 PM: Trump pauses peace process until Zelensky meets Putin, The Guardian.

- The US president has decided not to interfere in the organization of negotiations for the time being and believes that the next step should be a bilateral Ukraine-Russia summit.
- Trump allegedly plans to join already at the stage of a tripartite meeting in the Trump-Zelensky-Putin format. And the organization of Zelensky's summit with Putin is currently being handled by Vice President J.D. Vance, Secretary of State Marco Rubio, and Special Envoy Steve Witkoff.

4:50 PM: Trump criticized Biden for banning Ukraine from striking Russia.

- The US president said that it is impossible to win a war without striking the aggressor country.
- According to him, Biden limited Ukraine only to defense, and it "worked badly." "Exciting times are ahead," Trump added.

6:38 PM: The US and the EU have signed a framework trade agreement on reciprocal, fair and balanced trade, which takes effect on September 1, - White House.

- The main thing:
- The EU abolishes tariffs on industrial goods and opens the market for American seafood and agricultural products.
- The US imposes a 15% MFN tariff on most European goods.
- The document is called the first step towards greater trade cooperation between the US and the EU.

8:30 PM: Trump said that the issue of peace in Ukraine will be clarified within two weeks.

- He added that if this does not happen, it will be necessary to act differently.

8:50 PM: US Senator Lindsey Graham said that Russia kidnapped 19 thousand Ukrainian children.

- He called it barbarism and promised to promote a bill to recognize the Russian Federation as a state sponsor of terrorism if the children are not returned.

- "This will make business relations with Putin's Russia radioactive for other countries and companies," the senator emphasized.

9:11 PM: Poland expressed a note of protest to the ambassador of the Russian Federation due to the fall of a Russian drone on the territory of the Lublin Voivodeship, writes Polskie Radio.

- The incident was called a "foreseeable provocation", Russia was accused of violating international treaties and a hybrid war.
- Warsaw condemned the actions of the Russian Federation against the civilian population and demanded an explanation.

Wednesday, August 20

8:53 AM: GUR released data about the drone, which could be a reconnaissance, strike or false target.

- It is equipped with a camera and LTE modems for video transmission and course correction.
- The "delta-wing" fuselage is similar to the Shahed-131, half of the components are from China. The DLE engine in the bow makes it look like an italmas from zala group.

9:27 AM: Air defense forces shot down 62 of 93 enemy drones and 1 of 2 Iskander-M ballistic missiles.

- Enemy rockets and strike drones were also hit at 20 locations.

10:08 AM: The National Police has launched a pre-trial investigation into allegations of domestic violence against actor Kostyantsyn Temlyak.

- As part of this investigation, possible facts of other offenses are being checked, the police said.
- It is believed to be about texting and sending sexually suggestive photos to a 15-year-old girl.

11:13 AM: The SBU detained two Russian informants in Donetsk region and Dnipropetrovsk region.

- A 20-year-old resident of Synelnykivskyi district monitored the stops of the Armed Forces echelons and installed a hidden camera to transmit data to the enemy. Another informant in Donetsk region "pointed"

guided air bombs and artillery of the Russian Federation at fortified areas and warehouses of Ukrainian troops near Slovyansk.

- Phones were seized from both of them, the transfer of information to Russian intelligence was recorded. Extras face up to 8 years in prison.

11:18 AM: Volodymyr Zelenskyi reacted to the night shelling of Ukraine:

- "All these are demonstrative strikes that only confirm the need to put pressure on Moscow, the need to introduce new sanctions and tariffs, until diplomacy is fully operational," the message states.

12:04 PM: 7 more Instagram accounts have been blocked for casino advertising, among them blogger Simbochka, Ministry of Digital.

- Illegal advertising was found on news pages, bloggers with thousands of followers, and Simbochka's account with an audience of one million. Stories systematically showed "easy wins" and left active links.
- Meta and PlayCity jointly blocked accounts for direct violation of the law.

1:30 PM: Herman Smetanin headed UkrOboronProm for the second time.

14 candidates applied for the position, their selection was carried out by the international company Odgers Berndtson.

- Smetanin already managed the concern in 2023, after which he became the Minister of Strategic Industries. Before that, he worked in the management of several armored companies.

4:15 PM: The Council approved changes to the state budget of UAH 40 billion — the document concerns mainly non-military expenditures.

- These expenses were balanced by the reduction of other non-military expenses (36.7 billion UAH), as well as the redirection of part of the bank profit tax from the Kyiv budget (8 billion UAH).

4:32 PM: Zelenskyy appointed Mykola Tochytskyi as the permanent representative of Ukraine to the Council of Europe.

- Previously, this position was held by Borys Tarasyuk, he worked as post-predator at the Council of Europe since 2019.

5:01 PM: In "Rezerv+" you can now pay a fine for not entering the military register after changing your place of residence, — the Ministry of Defense.

- If you ignore the fine from the moment of the decision to impose it (40 days), then the case will go to the executive service.
- "This may lead to the blocking of bank accounts, seizure of property or transport, and entry into the Unified Register of Debtors," the ministry notes.

6:01 PM: All embassies and consulates of Ukraine have introduced online submission of documents — we are talking about 120 diplomatic missions, writes the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

- From now on, Ukrainians abroad will be able to submit information and documents through an electronic cabinet in the "e-Consul" system.
- You will only need to physically come to the institution to receive a ready-made document.

6:03 PM: The Rules Committee voted for the resolution on removing Maryana Bezugla from the Verkhovna Rada meeting, People's Deputy Zheleznyak.

- Decisions should be considered on August 21 at the meeting of the Council.
- Bezugla stated that she is suing the court regarding the "illegality of the decision of the Regulatory Committee".

7:41 PM: The government is expanding the list of free medicines and medicinal products purchased by the state, Prime Minister Svyridenko reports.

Now on the list:

- drugs for autoimmune diseases of the nervous system and neuromuscular diseases;
- medical products for the correction of complex scoliotic deformations of the spine.

7:58 PM: The ex-head of the central MSEK Marunich was ordered to house arrest at night until September 4, "Suspilne".

- He is suspected of systematically issuing disability documents to citizens who actually had no legal grounds for it.

8:55 PM: TikTok blocked two channels of the sanctioned ex-Nardeput Murayev — they were spreading pro-Russian messages and disinformation.

- "Murayev has now created a backup channel, but it will also cease to exist over time," TsPD assures.

9:46 PM: Volodymyr Zelenskyi congratulated the laureates of the "National Legend of Ukraine" award.

- In the list of awarded:

- artist Anatoly Kryvolap
- pop singer Vasyl Zinkevich
- Canadian philanthropist James Temertay

11:45 PM: The government has approved the permanent use of the electronic queue in TCCs and joint ventures, which has been tested in pilot mode since May 2024, — Ministry of Defense.

- The service is now available for conscripts, servicemen and their families. It will make it possible to avoid "live" queues near the TCC, increase security and make reception of citizens faster and more convenient.

11:59 PM: General Staff: There were 116 battles at the front, 107 occupiers were neutralized in the Pokrovsky direction

Since the beginning of the day, 116 combat clashes took place at the front, the largest number of assaults was recorded in the Pokrovsky direction.

- **Details:** The enemy launched two missile strikes with 43 missiles and 49 air strikes, dropping 70 guided air bombs. He also used 1,850 kamikaze drones for strikes and carried out 3,876 attacks on populated areas and positions of our troops.

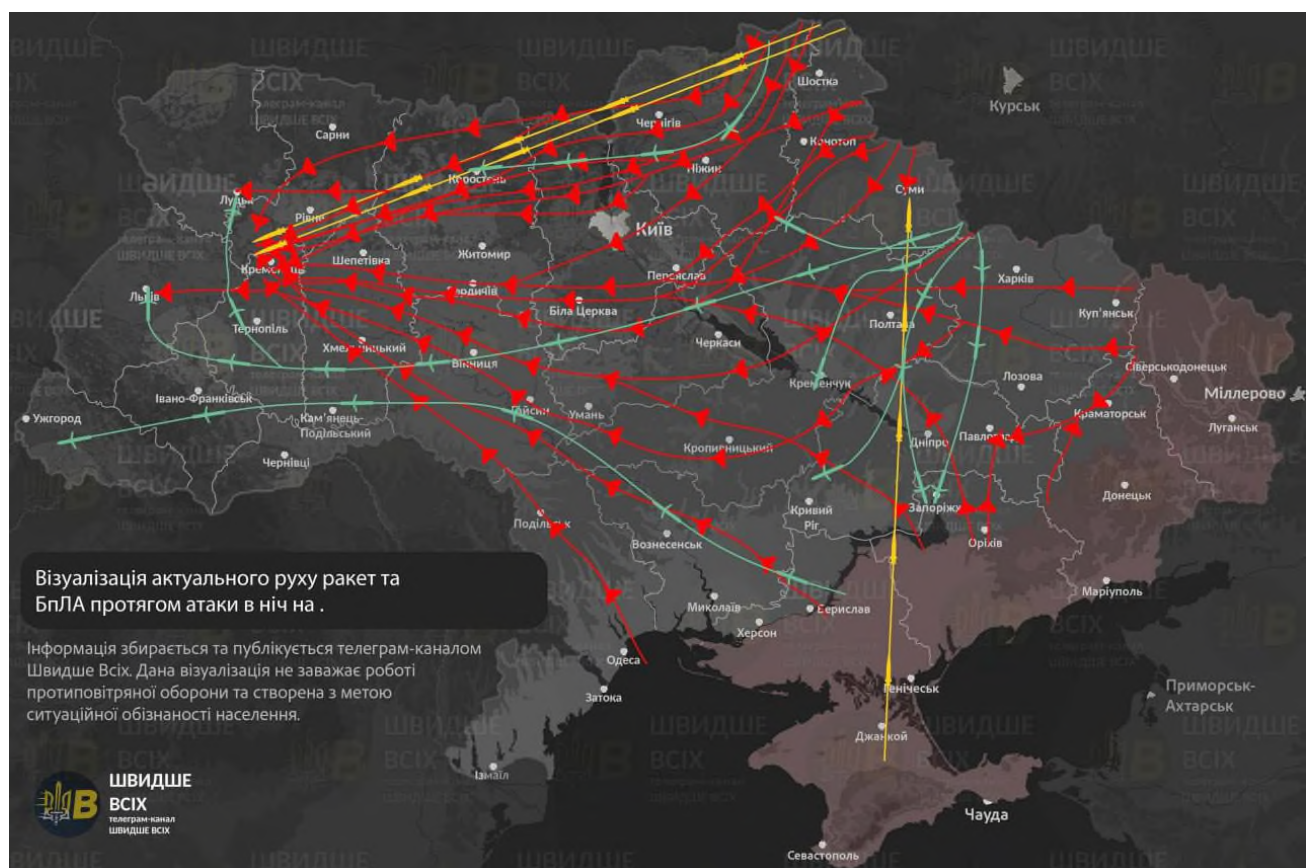
- During the day, the enemy carried out 29 offensive actions in the Pokrovsky direction.
- According to preliminary data, the Defense Forces neutralized 107 occupiers, of which 71 were irreversible.
- In addition, it is reported that Ukrainian soldiers destroyed one control point of unmanned aerial vehicles, one warehouse of fuel and lubricant materials, 47 unmanned aerial vehicles, six units of automobiles and two units of special equipment, and also damaged two enemy guns.

Thursday, August 21

5:18 AM: Explosions were heard in Sumy and the suburbs of Dnipro.

- Previously, a hypersonic "Zircon" was struck at Sumy.

8:50 AM: Approximate route of missiles and Drone during today's attack.



9:06 AM: Air Defense forces shot down/suppressed 577 aerial targets.

- In total, the Russians attacked with 614 means of air attack:
- 574 impact Drones of the Shahed type and simulator drones of various types;

- 4 Kh-47M2 "Kinzhal" aeroballistic missiles;
- 2 Iskander-M/KN-23 ballistic missiles;
- 19 Kh-101 cruise missiles;
- 14 Kalibr cruise missiles;
- 1 missile of an unknown type.
- Missiles and impact drones were hit at 11 locations, and debris (debris) fell at 3 locations.

10:36 AM: Volodymyr Zelenskyy expects increased sanctions from the US if Putin does not agree to a bilateral meeting.

- "We hope that America will respond. Because they themselves say: "Okay. Then bilateral, and then trilateral, and Putin will agree to it." It must agree, because if one of the parties does not want to end this war, then America will react. We want an end to this war and we clearly demonstrate it. So, now there must be a step from the Russian side," said Zelensky.
- According to him, Ukraine and its European allies are considering holding such a meeting in "neutral" Europe, in particular in Switzerland or Austria.

10:55 AM: Tonight, the Russian army set one of its crazy anti-records. They beat civil infrastructure enterprises, residential buildings, our people, — Volodymyr Zelenskyi.

- "And the Russians struck this blow as if nothing had changed at all. It seems that there is no world effort to stop this war," the president noted.

11:07 AM: Ukraine successfully tested the Flamingo missile, — Volodymyr Zelenskyi.

- The FP-5 missile is created by the Ukrainian company Fire Point. Its range is up to 3 thousand km, accuracy is 14 meters, payload is 1150 kg.
- Now they make one rocket a day, but by October they plan to start producing seven.

12:21 PM: There is only one state language in Ukraine - Ukrainian. the Russian Federation can claim and demand anything, Volodymyr Zelenskyi said.

1:09 PM: the Russian Federation attacked with drones an object of the gas transport infrastructure of Ukraine, the Ministry of Energy.

- It was possible to localize the damage, and the assessment of the damage is ongoing.

1:20 PM: From next year, all students will have free meals from 1st to 11th grade.

- This was announced by Prime Minister Yulia Svyridenko.
- According to her, additional resources will be sought in the budget for this.

2:09 PM: The SBU exposed an officer - the commander of a platoon of unmanned aircraft complexes of one of the marine corps brigades, who worked for the FSB.

- He transmitted the coordinates of his units to the enemy to adjust enemy fire and struck command posts and ammunition depots.
- He also tried to recruit other military personnel to work for the Russian special service.
- A flash drive with secret data and phones for communication with the curator were taken from him.
- It was found out that the soldier was recruited through his relatives in the occupied Luhansk region.
- The detainee was informed of suspicion of treason. He is being held without bail. The perpetrator faces life imprisonment with confiscation of property.

2:36 PM: The Verkhovna Rada adopted a draft law that restricts access to data on the location of real estate and cadastral numbers of land plots of legal entities for the period of martial law and a year after it, — CPC.

- This will make it much more difficult to expose corruption schemes and concealment of wealth through controlled firms, and for ordinary citizens will increase the risk of fraud when buying real estate.
- The author of the document is People's Deputy from "Servant of the People" Ihor Fries, whose relatives BIHUS.Info journalists found numerous properties. Who exactly supported the law will become known later.

2:55 PM: In Ukraine, 44% of children have symptoms of PTSD, reported First Lady Olena Zelenska.

- Post-traumatic stress disorder occurs after experiencing traumatic events. Its symptoms include intrusive memories or nightmares, anxiety, irritability, trouble sleeping and concentrating, avoidance of situations reminiscent of the trauma, and emotional detachment.
- Experts point out that almost every Ukrainian is faced with the manifestations of PTSD due to the war.

5:10 PM: The VRU supported payments of UAH 50,000 to a separate group of soldiers.

- Military personnel who, after returning from Russian captivity, require inpatient treatment for more than 30 days, will receive UAH 50,000 per month during the first three months of treatment.
- The document still has to pass the second reading in the Council.

6:59 PM: As a result of operation "Guardian", another 37 people were suspected of evading service in the Armed Forces due to fake medical certificates, the National Police.

- Law enforcement officers exposed a scheme with forged documents about "diseases" or care for relatives. Among the suspects are men of mobilization age and military personnel. They face up to 10 years in prison.

7:09 PM: Volodymyr Zelensky signed the law on guaranteed vacations for the military.

- Military personnel received the right to 15 out of 30 days of annual leave guaranteed, the rest - at the discretion of the unit. Combatants will have an additional 14 days, and contract workers aged 18-24 will have leave to take exams at universities.
- The law will enter into force one month after its publication.

7:55 PM: Putin can be forced to peace only by pressure, Zelensky said.

- The President emphasized that Ukraine is doing everything possible to protect the state and people.
- Zelensky emphasized that new elements of the future security architecture of Ukraine are being added every day - weapons, funding and support of allies.

9:30 PM: The Council adopted the law on the state policy of national memory — 273 deputies voted "for".

- The document establishes the concept of "racism", defines the principles and tasks of the policy of memory, and regulates the status of the Ukrainian Institute of National Memory.
- Rules for renaming, mandatory removal of symbols of Russian imperial policy, and recognition of UNR and UGVR awards as state awards are also established.

11:59 PM: Defense forces repelled 78 attacks by Russians in the Pokrovsky and Novopavlovsky directions - General Staff

Details: On the North-Slobozhansk and Kursk directions last day, Ukrainian soldiers repelled four attacks by invaders. The enemy also carried out nine airstrikes, using 17 guided air bombs, and launched 252 attacks, six of which were from rocket salvo systems.

On the Yuzhno-Slobozhansk direction the enemy tried ten times in vain to advance near the settlements of Synelnikove, Vovchansk, Khatne, Ambarne, Zapadne and in the direction of Kolodyazny.

On the Kupyansk direction yesterday there were five attacks by the occupiers. The defense forces repelled enemy assaults in the areas of Golubivka and Kupiansk.

On the Lymansky direction there were 24 combat clashes. The enemy tried to advance near the settlements of Karpivka, Zelena Dolyna, Kolodyazi, Dibrova, Zarichne, Torske and towards Yampol.

On the Seversky direction our troops repelled five enemy attacks in the areas of Serebryanka, Vyimka, Hryhorivka, Siversk and Fedorivka.

On the Kramatorsk direction the enemy launched six attacks, in the area of White Mountain and in the direction of Predtechyny.

Last day **in the Toretsk direction** the enemy attacked Ukrainian units of defenders six times in the Oleksandro-Kalynovoy, Pleshchiivka, Sofiivka, Poltavka, and Toretsk districts.

In the Pokrovsky direction during the past day, our defenders stopped 43 assault actions of the aggressor near the settlements of Nikanorivka, Novoeconomichne, Mykolaivka, Rodynske, Sukhetske, Horikhove, Myrolyubivka, Chervyn Liman, Pomin, Pokrovsk, Zvirove, Novopavlivka, Muravka, Novoukrainka, Zatyshok, Kotlyne, Udachne, Lysivka, Dachne.

On the Novopavlovsk direction Rayon defenders repelled 35 attacks by invaders in the areas of Voskresenka, Zaporizhia, Temyrivka, Zelene Pole, Tolstoy, Lisne, Olhivske and in the direction of the settlements of Komyshevakh and Filia.

On the Gulyaipil and Orihiv directions the enemy did not carry out offensive actions.

In the Dnieper direction enemy units twice tried to move forward - they did not succeed.

- The plant is one of the largest suppliers of petroleum products in the south of the Russian Federation.
- He is involved in the provision of the Russian armed forces. The total volume of tanks is over 210,000 cubic meters.
