

Prime Minister Modi's Recent Visit to Ukraine

When he was in Kyiv last August 23rd Indian Prime Minister Modi did not visit the Memorial Wall to Ukraine's Fallen Heroes, nor did he visit Bucha. Perhaps he was worried if he was seen by Putin paying his respects at the Memorial Wall, or visiting the site of one of Russia's many atrocities, that Putin might cut off the spigot of cheap oil that India is receiving.

Pasha Update

Pasha is my wife's brother's son-in-law. Just recently, Ukraine successfully tested a ballistic missile, probably similar to Russia's Iskander that has wreaked havoc on Ukraine's cities and infrastructure.

What Is Palianytsia?

Before it became Ukraine's latest wonder weapon, announced by Pres. Zelanskyy on Ukraine's Independence Day, and fired in anger against a Russian air base near Voronezh that, thanks to restrictions by the Biden Administration on use of ACACMS against Russian targets, had been previously off limits to Ukraine, Palianytsia was, and is, Ukraine's traditional hearth-baked bread that, among other things, plays a significant role in Ukrainian weddings, including mine. It is also a word that Russians cannot pronounce, which is probably one reason that Ukraine's new weapon was dubbed Palianytsia.

"Reporting From Ukraine" contains a detailed description of the capabilities of the Palianytsia. It is designed to maximize the effectiveness of cluster munitions by using air bursts. Like a drone, it can be guided to its target. Unlike ATACMS it can be produced in large quantities.

Palianytsia and the new ballistic missile make a mockery of the policy of the United States of restricting Ukraine's use of long-range weapons provided by the U.S., such as ATACMS, to hit Russian military targets inside Russian territory. Jake Sullivan, John Kirby and Sabrina Singh can now all go a sit in a corner and watch the show.

The Latest Russian Missile Assault

200 of the 239 missiles launched by Russia in yesterday's attack were shot down. It was the largest Russian assault of the war. Of the missiles that got through, one of them hit the generating station of the hydro-electric dam on the Dnipro River, upstream from Kyiv. My wife's brother, mentioned earlier, works there. The dam itself was undamaged. Had the dam itself been breached, the resulting flood would kill thousands of people in Kyiv, mostly in a low-lying neighborhood called Podil where we used to live. As the "Latest Denys" reports, starting at 4:15 into his video, two Russian missiles missed their target and landed in the reservoir behind the dam, known as the "Kyiv Sea." At 5:35 into his video, Denys shows the trajectories of the missiles and their launch sites, and the number and type of the missiles launched, and those shot down.

A New Front in Belgorod?

There are reports of another Russian incursion in the Belgorod Region, southeast of Kursk and opposite Kharkiv. We've predicted that the Kursk

incursion is a precursor to something else. Is Belgorod the "something else?" Apparently, the number Ukrainian troops involved is relatively small but, then again, the number of Ukrainian troops involved in Kursk were relatively small. Stryker armored vehicles seem to be an effective force multiplier. There are also reports that Ukraine is sending reinforcements in the direction of Pokrovsk. Will it be to cut off the Russian salient and trap a large number of Russians? The pundits have continuously understated Ukraine's capabilities.

<u>Ukraine uses Kursk success to press Biden on lifting weapons</u> <u>restrictions</u>/Politico

This is mostly old news, but there is a section, in the 4th paragraph from the bottom, that isn't – "Officials in certain corners of the administration have told the Ukrainians that the U.S. will eventually want to reset relations with Moscow and lifting the restrictions could upend those efforts." If true, the Biden Administration appears to be effectively stabbing its ally, Ukraine, in the back.

"Ukraine in Kursk: a lesson in strategic audacity"/By Gen. Mick Ryan in "Engelsburg Ideas"

This is a <u>brilliant article</u>. Some excerpts:

- "Ukraine has shown that, fortunately, strategic audacity is not entirely dead in democratic nations."
- "Russian forces in the region were quickly overwhelmed. Ukrainian forces poured across the border through gaps created in the breaches and captured nearly <u>1,500 square kilometers</u> of Russian territory. By comparison, Russian forces have captured less than half this amount of territory in Ukraine this year – at a cost of nearly 200,000 casualties."
- 'Importantly, using a defensive operation in Sumy as a cover story, they denied the Russians the knowledge that Ukrainian offensive operations were even under consideration. Ukraine also used very experienced formations for the initial phases of the operation, unlike in their 2023 counteroffensive. They maximised the use of drones and snuffed out the Russian drone forces across a huge swathe of Kursk in the lead up to and in the early hours of their operation. This denied Russia crucial and timely intelligence.'

- "By not using their reserves to reinforce troops in the Donbas, and instead using them in Kursk, Ukraine has taken a major risk, but an informed risk. No outside observer of the war has all the data available to the Ukrainian general staff that is making such decisions."
- "Appreciating that NATO strategy for supporting Ukraine is unlikely to shift beyond its 'defend Ukraine' approach; that no significant shift in US policy is likely before next year; and that Putin retains his aspiration to exterminate its sovereignty and culture, Ukraine knew that it was the only actor that could change the status quo in the war. The surprise attack into Kursk, with its political, strategic and military objectives, is the result."
- "Lulled into a false sense of security by those who peddle the nonsense of a <u>transparent battlefield</u>, and by their (the Pundits') assumptions about Ukrainian capacity, almost none imagined that such an operation was possible." This is exactly what happened during the dual Ukrainian offensives in 2022.
- "Another factor that partially explains Ukraine's strategic and battlefield surprise is that Western politicians and bureaucrats (collectively, along with the media, the Pundits), having assumed a posture of 'strategic slumber' since the end of the Cold War, can no longer imagine such battlefield and strategic audacity."
- "Western governments assumed the Ukrainians think like them.
 Fortunately, they do not."
- "In the most recent display of strategic indecision and risk aversion, Biden administration officials <u>have apparently admitted</u> that they continue to deny Ukraine's pleas for the full use of US weapon systems inside Russia because of a desire to 'reset relations with Moscow' at some point in the future. This strategic risk aversion and a lack of audacity will only prolong the war and lead to greater humanitarian suffering in Ukraine." **Disgusting if true.**
- "US officials <u>recently noted</u> that many of the Russian aircraft that
 Ukraine wants to target with American long-range weapons have now
 moved out of range. This justification drips with irony; had Ukraine
 been able to use the weapons when it originally asked months ago,
 these aircraft would not have moved, they would have been

destroyed. Aid to Ukraine has been too slow and too little to prevent the war becoming a forever war in which Ukrainians die, Russians slowly take territory, and 'war-weary' Westerners can go back to their comfortable lives and ignore (for a fleeting time) aggressive authoritarian regimes."

• "The West's strategic timidity prevents it from imagining, let alone conducting, the kind of audacious, high risk and high reward actions that Ukraine is taking in Kursk."

All we see from the Pundits is the handwringing. If the Pundits were running the show back in 1950, the Inchon Landings would likely never have taken place, and the entire Korean Peninsula would've been lost to the Communists. Or George Washington's audacious crossing of the Delaware River on Christmas Eve 1776, routing Great Britain's Hessian mercenaries in their beds.

12:04 AM: Durov was detained on charges that Telegram promotes drug trafficking and crimes against children, LCI channel reports.

- He will remain in custody pending trial, where he may also be charged with money laundering and supporting terrorism. Pavlo Durov faces up to 20 years in prison, and he will stand trial as a French citizen.
- French authorities are concerned that encrypted messages have made Telegram a major platform for organized crime.

12:16 AM: Durov's cryptocurrency TON has already fallen by almost 12%.

8:01 AM: The US military killed the leader of a group linked to al-Qaeda in Syria.

8:01 AM: Hezbollah is preparing a large-scale attack on Israel, the IDF.

8:01 AM: Hungarian Foreign Minister Peter Szijjarto believes that the European Commission is trying to cut off energy supplies to the country amid the issue of stopping Lukoil oil transit due to sanctions from Ukraine.

10:01 AM: Night shelling of Israel by Hezbollah fighters.

• They claim that more than 320 rockets were fired at Israel and that 11 military bases were hit.

10:47 AM: China will continue diplomacy and make efforts to promote a political settlement in Ukraine.

 This was reported by the head of the US and Oceania Department of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of China.

8:20 PM: "The Church cannot be touched," the Pope expressed concern over the law against the UOC MP.

- He stated that such a decision seems to forbid people to pray "in the church they consider their own."
- Francis urged not to abolish "directly or indirectly" any Christian church.

10:38 PM: The Telegram team spoke about the detention of Pavel Durov in France.

- "Telegram complies with EU laws, including the Digital Services Act.
 Platform moderation meets industry standards and is constantly being improved," the statement said.
- It was also noted that "it is absurd to claim that the platform or its owner is responsible for abuses that occur on it."

11:55 PM: The United States and Great Britain provided Ukraine with satellite images and intelligence about the Kursk region after the start of the offensive by the armed forces, The New York Times reports.

• This data helped track the movement of Russian reinforcements and prevent their attacks on Ukrainian forces.

Monday, August 26

12:41 PM: Instructors who have gained knowledge and experience in Ukraine will teach: a FPV drone pilot school is opening in Lithuania.

 The school will teach first-person view (FPV) drone control to representatives of specialized institutions such as the armed forces, the police, the Lithuanian Rifle Association and others, as well as companies and private individuals. According to the report, studies at this school should begin in September of this year in Vilnius, and in the future will be held throughout Lithuania.

2:39 PM: In Moldova, interruptions in the energy system were recorded after massive Russian strikes on Ukraine, — Moldelectrica.

• There are currently no risks of disconnection of consumers in Moldova.

4:44 PM: During the Russian missile attack, a drone, RMF24, flew from Ukraine to Poland.

- The movement of the drone was recorded by 3 radar stations it flew as far as 25 km deep into Poland and disappeared from radars.
- The commander of the Polish army did not give the order to shoot down because of "bad weather conditions". The object is probably still on the territory of the Republic of Poland.

5:04 PM: Poland will build the country's first nuclear power plant for about €1 billion.

5:04 PM: Ukraine receives "tens of thousands" rounds of ammunition every month as part of the Czech initiative, - Prime Minister Fiala.

 He noted that since the beginning of the full-scale war, thanks to the Czech initiative, it was possible to supply Kyiv with 2 million units of large-caliber ammunition, as well as 22 million units of medium caliber.

9:38 PM: The French prosecutor's office brought 12 charges against Pavlo Durov; complicity in the possession of child pornography.

- Other charges include drug distribution, cybercrime, fraud and money laundering.
- President Macron noted that the detention is part of a judicial investigation and not a political decision.

10:42 PM: The Reporters Without Borders organization is preparing a lawsuit over the attack on a hotel with journalists in Kramatorsk.

 Reporters Without Borders condemns the death of Reuters security consultant Ryan Evans and is concerned about the health of two of his fellow journalists who were injured in a Russian missile strike. One of them is in hospital in serious condition.

- said the head of the Eastern Europe and Central Asia department of this international human rights organization, Zhanna Cavelier.
- She emphasized that now the organization cannot claim that the hotel became a target precisely because media representatives lived there, but "one thing can be said for sure - since the beginning of the war, journalists and their teams have become a target for the Russian army because of their work."

11:18 PM: The US will continue private negotiations with Ukraine to lift restrictions on long-range strikes against Russia.

 America understands President Zelenskyi's calls, but further negotiations will remain closed, White House National Security Adviser John Kirby said.

7:58 AM: Air defense system forces shot down 8 out of 9 Shaheds this night.

 In addition, the enemy launched the winged "Iskander-K", the ballistic "Iskander-M" and 6 KAR Kh-59/Kh-69. As a result of the active opposition of the Defense Forces of Ukraine, most of the missiles did not reach their targets.

9:17 AM: Volodymyr Zelenskyy for the first time showed the Ukrainian missile-drone "Palyanytsia".

 According to him, the development of the rocket lasted one and a half years, it is cheaper than analogues. Two dozen Russian airfields are within the range of "Palyanytsia". The Ukrainian missile is launched from a ground-based installation.

7:32 PM: The Prosecutor General's Office has started criminal proceedings on the possible illegal crossing of the border by People's Deputy Dmytruk.

• This was stated by the spokeswoman of the Office of General Prosecutor Maksymets in a comment to "Suspilno".

8:07 PM: Urgent investigative actions are underway to find out how the deputy crossed the border - SBI.

 Searches have already taken place on civilians and employees of the state border service, who probably helped the deputy to illegally cross the border.

9:39 PM: Zelensky condemned the Russian attack on Kramatorsk, where Reuters journalists from Ukraine, the United States and Great Britain were injured.

- "The world must not stop putting pressure on the terrorist state for missile strikes, anti-aircraft missiles, assaults and this whole war.
 Russia must be forced to seek peace," Zelensky emphasized.
- He also reported that the Armed Forces advanced in the Kursk region by 1-3 km, taking control of two more settlements.

10:03 PM: Zelensky convenes a meeting regarding traitors who fled Ukraine.

- The meeting will be with the heads of the Security Service of Ukraine, the Ministry of Internal Affairs, the Security Intelligence Service, the NABU, the SAP, the State Security Service, the Prosecutor General, and representatives of intelligence.
- "Our state needs clear answers regarding such persons. Clear responsibility. So that all these "comrades" get what they deserve," the president said.

11:32 PM: Summary of the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine as of the evening of August 25:

- Since the beginning of the day, 136 combat clashes took place at the front.
- Russian forces launched one missile strike with three missiles and carried out 58 airstrikes using 95 gliding aerial bomb(s).
- the invaders used 436 kamikaze drones and conducted more than 3,160 attacks on the positions of our troops and populated areas.
- The hottest direction is Pokrovsky. Our soldiers neutralized 254 occupiers in this direction, 121 of them irreversibly.

8:05 AM: Explosions were heard in Kryvyi Rih, Vinnytsia, Kremenchuk and Kharkiv. We are waiting for information.

8:41 AM: In some areas of Kyiv and Odesa, the light went out.

8:41 AM: Outages in Kyiv are related to problems in the all-Ukrainian energy network, the mayor of the capital reported.

9:06 AM: Repeated explosions rang out in Ternopil and Zaporizhzhia regions, Kryvyi Rih, and Lviv.

9:10 AM: Ukrenergo issued an order to introduce emergency blackouts.

• During emergency shutdowns, schedules that can be predicted in advance do not work.

9:22 AM: There are several blackouts in different regions, reserve diesel locomotives have been withdrawn, all long-distance trains will continue to run, - Ukrzaliznytsia.

• City Express in Kyiv - on schedule.

10:23 AM: "Shahedy" is still in Kherson. Mykolaiv, Kharkiv. Poltava, Sumy, Chernihiv. Kyiv. Cherkasy, Vinnytsia, Khmelnytskyi, Ternopil regions!

10:41 AM: 15 regions affected today due to massive Russian attack.

- This was announced by Prime Minister Denys Shmyhal.
- The enemy used various types of weapons: drone(s), cruise missiles, "Daggers". Energy infrastructure became the target again. There is damage in a number of regions.

11:58 AM: On August 16, the Cabinet of Ministers adopted Resolution No. 936 on providing the population with gas masks in case of use of nuclear weapons or other weapons of mass destruction against Ukraine.

 According to the resolution, local administrations should provide gas masks to the unemployed population, using communal reserves.
 Workers in business entities of the civil protection category must be provided with protective equipment at the expense of the enterprises.
 Public servants will be provided by the authorities at the expense of the state budget. • Each business entity must have a gas mask for each employee and an additional 2% of supply. The means of protection will be issued free of charge and are not subject to return.

12:42 PM: Russia launched one of the largest combined strikes against Ukraine, using more than a hundred missiles and "shaheeds" targeting critical civilian infrastructure in many regions, Zelenskyi.

- There are dead and wounded, liquidation of the consequences continues, in the energy sector. Repair crews are working around the clock to restore power.
- Putin continues his terror, and Ukraine needs strong decisions from its partners to end the war.

2:57 PM: Umerov said that Ukraine is preparing its responses to the attacks of the Russian Federation.

- The head of the Ministry of Defense emphasized that today's mass attack by the Russian Federation proves that Ukraine needs permission to carry out long-range strikes on military facilities on the territory of Russia.
- He also added that "Ukraine is preparing its answers. With weapons of its own production."

4:47 PM: Ukraine will have to adjust the winter preparation plan after the Russian attack on August 26 - Shmyhal's adviser.

5:13 PM: A clear picture of the state of the Ukrainian energy system is expected by the end of the day. The changes will be negative, Yuriy Boyko, a member of the supervisory board of "Ukrenergo".

 The attack could affect plans to restore the power system and supply electricity between September and October. Adjustment of preparation for winter is expected.

5:30 PM: Heroes of Ukraine will receive housing from the state.

- The corresponding decree was signed by President Volodymyr Zelenskyi.
- "Persons who have been awarded the title of Hero of Ukraine with the awarding of the Gold Star order can be provided with one-time

address assistance in the form of residential premises for permanent residence," says the new statute.

6:08 PM: The official exchange rate of the euro exceeded 46 hryvnias for the first time, according to data on the regulator's website.

6:32 PM: The activity of reconnaissance drone(s) is observed in the north of Donetsk region, Mykolayiv region, as well as in Zaporizhzhia.

6:39 PM: During today's attack, Russia used at least 127 missiles and 109 drones, according to Zelensky.

 Regarding the front: a decision was made at Stavka to further strengthen the Pokrovsky direction.

6:51 PM: The most massive air attack: 102 missiles and 99 attack drone(s) were shot down, according to the Armed Forces.

 "Several units of drone(s) have been lost in location on the territory of Ukraine, two more have crossed the state border with the Republic of Belarus," writes Oleschuk.

7:25 PM: Ex-deputy Ruslan Solvar was sentenced to prison for the second time for housing scams, — SAP.

- He is accused of receiving compensation from the state for renting a room in the "Kyiv" hotel as a people's deputy, although he had an apartment in the capital. For four years, he was paid more than 360 thousand hryvnias.
- The prosecutor's office does not specify the name of the person involved in the case, but it is clear from its details that it is about Solvar.

7:56 PM: Internal audits showed that the Ukrainian military did not receive humanitarian aid worth more than UAH 170 million, — Ministry of Defense.

- In particular:
 - o 424 vehicles.
 - more than 476 tons of goods of various names without specifying the value.
 - o more than 6 tons of food and plastic pellets.

8:14 PM: Zelensky said that Ukraine is preparing a response to Russia: it is about the use of F-16 and the operation in the Kursk region.

 "And regarding the operation in the Kursk region, we continue our actions in the designated areas exactly as Ukraine needs. During this day, we have more control, there is another replenishment of the exchange fund," the president noted.

8:46 PM: According to information from Ukrenergo, stabilization outages are possible in Kyiv, Kyiv, Odesa, Dnipropetrovsk and Donetsk regions on August 27:

- The President gave a two-week task to develop and present a clear plan for solving these issues, stressing that specific actions are needed.

9:58 PM: After the mass attack in the morning, 7 people died, 2 of them died in the hospital, and 47 were injured, including 4 children, according to the State Emergency Service.

• Rescuers completed work at all locations, extinguishing 22 fires.

10:50 PM: The Ukrainian Armed Forces put into operation the BoarTAC unmanned transporter.

• This multi-purpose robot can deliver ammunition, evacuate the wounded, clear mines and install mine barriers. It can also be used as a kamikaze drone.

11:40 PM: Summary of the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine as of the evening of August 26:

- Since the beginning of the day, 148 combat clashes took place at the front.
- The enemy made one missile strike using 127 missiles and carried out 59 airstrikes using 81 gliding aerial bomb(s).
- 649 kamikaze drones were used and more than 3,200 shots were fired at the positions of our troops and populated areas.
- The main efforts of the enemy are concentrated in the Pokrovsky direction. the occupiers lost almost 200 people in this direction.
