Langness inspires me to write long reviews of his short books. He is incredibly on target. This is a collection of 18 essays. My hope in writing one paragraph summaries is to inspire people to buy the book (or get it free! Langness is far more interested in acquiring followers than great fortune) and be inspired. My second objective is to introduce readers to relevant books from earlier periods that attempted to raise the alarm decades ago.

Part I: Reality

One - Just How Bad Are Sweden's Demographics?

Sweden's days as a predominantly white country appear to be numbered. Among males in their 20s ethnic Swedes are already approaching minority status. The immigrants are vastly outbreeding ethnic Swedes, and the immigrants keep coming. The welcome banner is still out. The Swedes resolutely close their eyes to the fact they have the highest rape rate in the world outside of Africa.

The Swedish mindset with regard to race was largely established in the 1930s by two socialist politicians, Alva and Gunnar Myrdal. Gunnar wrote the single book which most strongly undergirded the American civil rights movement, [[ASIN:1560008563 An American Dilemma: The Negro Problem and Modern Democracy, Volume 1 (Contemporary Austrian Studies)]]]. He was selected by America's liberal powers-that-be of the 1940s, and succeeded beyond all measure. It is worth reading today (or at least my review of same) to assess how it has all worked out. Two - Spotlights In Heroism: Eric Zemmour On The Horror Of The Coming Civil War

This is a review of a book by a North African explaining very clearly what is happening in France. The French, of course, do not want to hear it. It is important for having been well considered, well written, and so absolutely on target that ignoring it takes a supreme act of will.

Three - Desired Storms: Guillaume Faye's The Colonisation Of Europe

Guillaume Faye is one of France's leading intellectuals on the right. He takes a darker view of Europe's future than most. This is a review of his book "The Colonization of Europe" which appeared in the early 2000's. I am well disposed to this author, having favorably reviewed [[ASIN:1907166467 Convergence of Catastrophes]].

Four - How Europe's War Of Liberation Could Begin

Langness writes frequently about fourth generation war. He included this description in his previous book, "Fistfights with Muslims."

"This is one of the antecedents to what military theorist William S. Lind calls "4th Generation Warfare" – or, 4GW. 4GW arises as a result of and also hastens the nation states' loss of legitimacy, and therefore the loss of their near universal monopoly on warfare and geopolitical power.

"According to Lind, 1st Generation Warfare began after the Peace of Westphalia ended the Thirty Years' War in 1648, establishing the state's need to organize and conduct war. 2nd Generation Warfare continued the reign of warfare between nation-states, and was characterized by the strict adherence to drill and discipline seen in the trench warfare of World War One. 3rd Generation Warfare evolved as state armies learned methods to bypass the enemy using speed and surprise—as the German's did with the Blitzkrieg in World War Two. 4th Generation Warfare—the paradigm we are currently transitioning into—involves one or both sides of a conflict being non-state actors, as the forces of technology, globalization, modernization, secularism, and religion further evolve conflict throughout the world."

Langness starts with the observation that the developed countries of Western Europe are becoming failed states. They selectively enforce the law only against their own people, letting the immigrants, Africans and Muslims, run riot and make their own law. This is untenable. What happens when it collapses?

He draws on the examples of other failed states: Lebanon, Yugoslavia, Afghanistan... He notes their commonalities, and observes how the same factors are becoming visible throughout Europe.

His scenario is Sweden falling apart in a 20-some step process sometime within the next decade. His scenario ends with troops from neighboring European countries coming in to attempt to enforce peace, but there is nothing like a resolution.

Langness projects that there will be an influx of people from the rest of Europe battling to protect European culture and patrimony. One can only hope he is right, that reservoirs of our traditional culture and some sense of honor remain.

Five - Hasta La Vista Europe (A Review)

This is a review of a book by a group of individuals who chose to publish under the name (or pen name) of one of their members, Col. Walter T Richmond. Richmond is an American soldier who has appeared on certain alt right websites such as Red Ice Radio.

The authors of the book noted a vast discrepancy between the official version of events concerning refugees, that supported by the mainstream media and the governments of European nations, and the fact that they could discern with a little bit of digging. The book is divided into three sections. The first is a background about Europe and about the authors' experiences. The second is about the realities of the "migrant crisis." They are not refugees fleeing war – the majority is military-age males. The widespread negative impact on their European host countries is vastly underreported. The third part of the book is a country by country assessment, as he writes, "from Albania and Andorra to Liechtenstein and Lithuania."

The magnitude of the disaster is extensively described by a few authors, decidedly out of the mainstream, but present in every European country. All of them go into detail about the rapes in particular. Rape is a traumatic crime, and a highly symbolic one. Their lack of will to defend their women is a graphic demonstration of modern Europe's lack of will to defend its values. The Muslims seem to relish shoving their faces and it; the sissy boys avert their eyes and ignore it. Among the books I have reviewed are:

Part II: Commentary

Six - Why Today's Turbulence Is Different Than The 1960's

Langness says that the revolution the 60s grew out of a sense of abundance, the notion that it was possible to have it all it was unfair if not everybody shared. I lived through that era. My experience beginning in 1959 at two radical universities, Reed College and University of California Berkeley, leads me to believe that there was something more sinister afoot. There is substance to the arguments that the cultural Marxists spearheaded by the Frankfurt school, Gramsci, et. al. had a plan, however well or poorly articulated, to radically change American society.

The kids themselves – and I perceive a sharp generational break between my Silent Generation, born up to 1945, and the Baby Boomers – were aching to break free of parental restraints. The universities were in wholehearted agreement. In the two years I was there, Reed College abandoned responsibility for the chastity of their women students in giving up "in loco parentis" and introducing intervisitation between men's and women's dorms. It was an invitation to sex. The students and young faculty at Berkeley stuffed the Free Speech movement down the throat of a spineless administration. As academic David Gelernter writes in "America Lite," they were clueless bureaucrats whose heart was definitely not in defending the middle-class values of the students' parents.

Even as a high school student in Berkeley I would say we were quite politically naïve, and we were certainly being force-fed clues by popular culture. The comedians Mort Sahl and Lenny Bruce, folksingers Joan Baez, Bob Dylan, Woody Guthrie and others were all creatures of the left. It took only about half a decade for them to eclipse more traditional popular singers such as Anita Bryant, Perry, and Pat Boone, who came to be regarded as hopelessly square. Being square entailed believing in marriage, treating women like ladies, answering the draft call, and fulfilling other civic duties. It was probably not a conspiracy, but the notion that it was an unarticulated evolutionary strategy seems to have some merit – today as well. Langness contends that the problems of the 60s were to a large extent one-time affairs, during the turbulent youth of the baby boomer generation, and that they went away as those boomers got jobs, married, and raised kids. On the other hand, the chaos of the 2010s will be never ending. "Nothing makes sense." I would caveat this to say that the baby boomers' values have not changed much at all, and those globalist, diversity seeking, nonjudgmental values have allowed society to become more and more fragmented ever since. Black Lives Matter did not spring out of a vacuum. Tom Wolfe wrote about the same phenomenon in his essay "Mau Mauing the Flak Catchers" 50 years ago. And the same kind of

radicals were pouring gasoline on the fire then as now. If the fire is bigger today, is because it has been burning longer.

Seven - Mormons And Jihadis: Parallel Revolts Against The Modern World

The insight is that Jihadis and Mormons value real manliness. They are physically brave, loyal to one another, and spiritual in a very secular age. The Muslims represent an existential threat to us. At the same time we reject the threat, and the values the Muslims embrace, we should examine ourselves. The parts that are missing are the parts it would be essential to turn back their assault.

The Mormons and other Christians are relentlessly assaulted by the "rationalists" in modern society. These supposedly rational people ignore the fact that pure logic provides no rationale for continuing to exist. One needs an irrational belief, such as religion. What the progressives also ignore is that they too harbor a number of irrational beliefs. The problem is that theirs are destructive of the cultures they spring from.

Eight - Identitarians In The Sandbox

Nothing unites us anymore. Langness writes about a "shared honor group," a group that embraces a mutually agreed set of values and objectives." Policeman and lawyers cannot be everywhere. A society simply cannot manage its affairs strictly according to a legal code. The interpretations are too vague, the instances far too numerous, and the participants too disparate. There has to be a common culture.

Langness could use a couple of quotes to this regard. These are not the best I have seen, but the best I could find perusing Bartlett:

Burke: "it is not what a lawyer tells me I may do; but what humanity, reason, and justice tell me I ought to do."

Carrie Chapman Catt: "No written law has ever been more binding than unwritten custom supported by popular opinion"

Charles Kingsley: "tell us not that the world is governed by universal law; the news is not comfortable but simply horrible, unless you tell us... That there is a loving giver, and adjust administrator of that law."

I offer a couple of my own aphorisms:

- o Tolerance is the virtue of working through recognized differences. Multiculturalism is the sin of failing to recognize that they exist in the first place.
- o People who feel a God-given right to be angry seldom have the God-given wit to know when.

Langness goes on about the admiration that Americans have for Russia. Putin's Russia is recognizably the same as Russia was 50 years ago under the Soviets. The people are the same. They have a sense of themselves as a nation. Americans, on the other hand, are at sea in a miasma of diversity that was impossible to imagine in my own youth 50 years ago, as much as people were celebrating it even then.

Nine - Anarcho-Tyranny And The Logistical Class

Anarcho-tyranny is a term that was coined by Sam Francis, a race realist and alt right character two decades before the alt right concept even evolved. Modern governments tyrannize the respectable

members of their societies, the honest burghers, the descendants of the founding populations, with an endless number of taxes, restrictive ordinances, denial of the right to arm and defend themselves, and abridgment to their right of speech and assembly. At the same time they refuse to enforce the law against Third World immigrant groups and native-born minorities. Violent crimes such as rape and homicide, property crimes such as shoplifting and robbery, and disorderly conduct are routinely ignored. The police do not go into "no go" zones in Europe.

The logistical class is that middle stratum of society that makes things work. They are sandwiched between the unproductive welfare recipient s class on the bottom and the college-educated elites on the top. The logistical class is getting fed up. Manifestations in the week I write this review are the brouhaha over NFL players protesting supposed police shootings of black people and the rise of the Alternative for Deutschland party in the German elections.

Langness' observation is that the powers that be don't understand the people of the logistical class and do not understand the significance of their finally getting fed up. They increasingly realize the extent to which the government is lying to them. The police, which the government depends on to enforce its will, are likewise getting fed up. They know the truth, and are increasingly willing to put their paychecks on the line. Their lives and honor are already on the line, and they have had enough.

Ten - Ginny Weasley In Rotherham, Dementors And Police Officers

Harry Potter, per Langness, consists of a series of morality tales in which the social justice warriors always triumph over the evil fascist, nationalist, patriarchal villains. In real life, epitomized by the Rotherham child abuse cases in England it is the "progressive" establishment which is rotten, complicit, and corrupt, enabling Muslim malefactors to abuse 1400 white girls. Moreover, the evils continue to this day, and the establishment continues to hide them to this day.

Eleven - Predictions For The Coming Year

Note: this essay appeared on October 26, 2016. The coming year, therefore, would extend up to the time of the writing of this review.

As background, Langness mentions Trump's unprecedented brashness and willingness to call things as they are. The case in point is a willingness to call the electoral process corrupt when evidence of democratic voter fraud was increasingly evident. A second incident he mentions is the widespread press coverage of an Arab murder of a German teenager; the press could not avoid the story. The third is the increasingly loud rumbling about a coming recession in the US and Europe.

The predictions cover a coming recession (not here yet, but the manipulations and lies that hold it off are becoming increasingly untenable), setbacks for ISIS, more public awareness of how bad the situation is, but not a thorough unraveling and fourth-generation Civil War.

The most interesting prediction to me is a greater and greater exodus to the Viasgrad nations. These include Hungary, the Czech Republic, Poland and Slovakia. This so far has not been visible. As a resident of Ukraine I keep expecting an influx of expatriates to appear once they understand the danger in their native countries, but they do not: the boiling frog syndrome.

Part III: Resistance

Twelve - Violence And Vanguardism

The most frightening thing about the atrocities that the Muslims continue to commit – terror bombings, rapes, trashing their host countries – is the apathy with which the Europeans react. It only invites more, and more is coming.

Even without Islam arriving as a destroyer, Western European society is so sick, with its video games, homosexuality, drugs and so on, that it would eventually collapse of its own weight. Islam, however, is vastly hastening its demise. But it may also be serving to bring the problems into clearer focus. One can hope against hope.

Thirteen - Fourth Generation Warfare & White Preservationism

War is no longer fought between states. For all the saber rattling concerning the Russians, there are precious few state to state battles. The closest thing on today's radar is Russia's proxy invasion of my country, Ukraine. Russia has cannily, carefully disguised it to look like a 4GW situation, a spontaneous uprising by disgruntled Russophones in Ukraine's East.

The Muslim invaders are fighting a 4GW to conquer Europe. It appears they are winning; Muslims account for almost half of the twentysomething males in Europe. They are certainly more energized, more sure of themselves, than the natives they are displacing.

It is becoming increasingly clear that the governments of the United States and Western Europe are incapable of "preserving our lives, blood, culture, and heritage," to use Langness' words. It calls for a 4GW response on our part if we are to be successful.

The war will be fought for hearts and minds. Dylan Roof and Anders Behring Breivik got a lot of notoriety, but they were not sympathetic characters. It would be far better to be like Bernard Goetz (remember him?), who shot four young thugs who were accosting him on the New York subway three decades ago. It would be better to be a Swede or Norwegian going amok among immigrants in revenge for the rape of a wife or daughter.

Fourteen - Ten Everyday Things You Can Do To Help The War In Europe

The last few of these 10 recommendations are somewhat predictable: how to donate, what to join, how to prepare yourself physically. The first two are the most striking. Get control of your financial life. This is important for two reasons. First, Langness' whole argument is about the importance of being a man, and a man is in control of his life. He is not driven by his appetites. In modern America, this means he is not driven by consumption. Secondly, perhaps more importantly, the establishment uses financial levers to suppress dissent. You are vulnerable if you depend on your job. You are vulnerable if you're in debt.

One more I would add: raise your children to be like yourself. Without a next generation, what's the point? Ironically, this step, which used to be the most natural in the world, is just about the most difficult in today's world.

Fifteen - The "One Thing" That Will Save Europe

Talk about it! Let people know! Don't be afraid to take a stand. Don't let the SJWs on Facebook intimidate you.

Sixteen - Mindset & Reconquest: What Identitarians Can Take From Mike Cernovich's MAGA Mindset: Making YOU And America Great Again

This is a celebration of one short book on how Trump wound up on top. Langness writes: "The text is split up into three sections: "Culture," "Media," and "Mindset." Each delves into a different aspect of Trump's rise and the significance of his campaign, with the latter of the three attempting to provide lessons to readers on how to apply the same mindset "principles" Trump uses."

The most important is mindset. The resolve to win, and to keep trying until you do.

Seventeen – What Would Enoch Powell Do?

Enoch Powell was prophetic in his 1968 "Rivers of Blood" speech. The evils he foresaw have come into being, and the traditional Anglo-Saxons are becoming a minority in their own country.

It is worth remembering other prophets before their time. Theodore Bilbo is still reviled today as an unrepentant racist hick from Louisiana. He saw what was coming in the United States and spoke out against it. Educated, sophisticated man that he was, he must have known that what he advocated was out of keeping with the American character and inconsistent with the Constitution – which at that time was still recognized as having some authority. The Finnish concept of "sisu," an all-inclusive virtue combining courage, grit, perseverance and will is what will be required. We must refind our manhood.

In summary, a powerful collection of essays. Europe is in dire peril. Americans should be concerned – it represents our heritage. Moreover, its future could presage that of America itself.
