

Patriots Not Welcome by Britney Sellner.

Britney Sellner is an American YouTube personality who was attracted to the Trump campaign in 2016. She was very active, for which she suffered being on blacklisted thrown off just about every imaginable social media platform. She was delighted when Trump won.

Prior to that she had focused on women's issues. She is a conservative Catholic who believes in traditional family values. I previously reviewed her 2018 book [What Makes Us Girls: And Why It's All Worth It](#). In Patriots she dismisses it as a fairly simple book, but I was absolutely enthralled. Somebody needs to tell women that there is a lot of value, a lot of satisfaction we had in being a traditional woman married to a man and taking care of his children. So that's what she advocated in the 20

My only quibble with the 2018 book was the naïveté she showed in interviewing Russian political figures, especially Alexander Dugin, author of [The Fourth Political Theory](#). But – she was young and conservative, the kind of person unlikely to get useful guidance from anybody in authority.

Britney was well known on YouTube on by the time she met Martin Sellner. Seeing her video and her conservative politics, he invited her to come to Austria. It was an email that she never saw. However, she did get to Austria on another invitation and they met. In 2017

Martin Sellner had been captivated by the disciplined, non-violent resistance to the Islamic takeover advocated by the French. See my review of Marcus Willinger's with the title [Generation Identity](#). He founded the Austrian analog to Willinger's organization. Other European countries did as well.

As Britney went to Europe with another conservative blogger, Lauren Southern, to blog about the Generation Identity cruise on the defendant Europe mission. Sellner's group chartered a boat and went on the Mediterranean to publicize the enormous number of his Islamic immigrants arriving by boat and raise awareness of the danger that they pose to Europe.

The book describes the systematic prejudice and mistreatment conservatives get from the government and the media everywhere in the world. She talks about the specifics of the mistreatment that she and her husband experienced from the Austrian authorities but also the British authorities.

They were harassed strictly by customs and immigration every time they attempted to cross borders. She compares the shooting Christchurch, NZ shooting of Muslims by Brenton Tarrant with the Bataclan massacre by Islamic militants in Paris, and numerous other atrocities committed by Muslims. The Christchurch massacre caused them immense grief solely on account of having received a donation from Tarrant long before the massacre.

Britney raises the question of whether or not political involvement, which has involved great sacrifices for her and her husband, as well as being uncomfortable for their families, is worth it. Nevertheless, their families have supported them wholeheartedly. It is notable that both families appear to be very solid, intelligent, substantially upper-middle-class, and supportive.

One of the questions never addressed in the book is how these two activists fund their travel

to various demonstrations and meetings. The money simply seems to have been there for them, although they don't talk about elaborate schemes to raise it. One would not think that there YouTube activity would generate enough money to support what they do.

It is about the mechanisms that might be employed to get Muslim immigrants to re-migrate back where they came from. It is well thought-out, examining several categories of immigrants: illegal, legal and naturalized citizens. It also assesses different levels of assimilation – language, culture, employment and such. The conclusion is that it might be possible to motivate a substantial fraction of them to leave on their own.

This book is worth reading for just what the title claims. Patriots are not welcome. Anywhere. Conservative voices are shut down, shot down, deplatformed and debanked everywhere. We have to admire people like the Sellners who have the courage to persevere in any case.
